

Classifications: Regular Classes

Junior Puppy:	Dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age on day of show.
Senior Puppy:	Dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age on day of show.
12- 18 months:	Dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age on day of show.
Canadian Bred:	For dogs born in Canada - Champions in any country excluded.
Bred by Exhibitor:	For dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.
Open:	All dogs
Veterans Class:	For dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs compete for regular placements, and the 1st place dog and bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans class will not compete for the points but must go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Veterans may be altered.
Specials Only:	Dogs which are registered individually in the records of the C.K.C. and have attained championship status may be entered in this class. Entry of a dog in Specials Only is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the C.K.C. but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be canceled. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is not allowed.
Exhibition Only:	For dogs 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the C.K.C.
Exhibition Only Puppy:	CKC Rule 12.2.2 Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only Puppy providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. These puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades
Sexually Altered	For dogs/bitches 6 months of age and over who have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. The breed standard for each breed shall be followed; all disqualifications shall apply. Judges shall judge this class as if judging regular conformation classes. Withholding of awards for lack of merit is encouraged.
<b>Classes and Awards</b>	Winners Altered Male/Female Class. In each breed there may be 1 such award in each sex. Reserve Winners Altered Male/Female. The second place male/female shall be given this award.
<b>Best Altered in Specialty:</b>	The highest award is Altered in Specialty
<b>Sweepstakes:</b>	(Divided by Sex)
Junior Puppy	6-9 months (as above, see Jr. Puppy)
Senior Puppy	9-12 months (as above, see Sr. Puppy)
Open	12-15 months(Dogs 12 months of age but under 15 months on day of show)
Novice	15-18 months (Dogs 15 months of age but under 18 months on day of show)
<b>Non Regular Classes</b>	Dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Specials Only or for Exhibition Only, to be entered in any non regular class. The following classes will be provided
Stud Dog & Get	Stud dog and 2 or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same person. One fee for the class. There is no charge for the Get but they have to be entered in a Regular class or exhibition only.
Dam and Progeny	Brood bitch and 2 or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same person. One Fee for the class. There is no charge for the Progeny but they have to be entered in a Regular Class or for Exhibition only
Brace:	For dogs of the same breed, but not necessarily of the same sex. Both dogs need not have the same owner. Payment is required for the Class not for each dog.
Parade of Honour:	Open to All Dogs which are CKC registered. Dogs need to entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only. You must send a resume for your Honoured Dog to the Show Secretary with your entries (Form in this premium list)

1. Dog Show Rulebooks, Obedience Trial and Agility Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. In Canada call toll free 1-800-250-8040, in the United States call 1-416-675-5511.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Hub City Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this Specialty.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book. 19.7
5. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date and time may be made by telephone but they must be followed up in writing to the Show Secretary so as to be received on or before the closing date of entries.
6. Person accepting telephone entries in the event of a postal strike: Kathy McAra (403) 295-2160. Entries phoned in must be signed and entry fees paid by cash, money order or certified cheque before the dog may enter the ring.
7. The TTCC will not be liable for any loss or injury sustained through the disappearance, loss, theft, injury, and or death of dogs entered in this show under any circumstance.

### **ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS**

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **ERN - Event Registration Number**. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$58.85.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. **Canada-U.S. Border Crossing:** A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog

## Extracts From CKC Dog Show Rules

### Chapter 8 Entries and End of Show

**Section 8.2.5** An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

**Section 8.3.1 Entries: Every dog entered in a Championship show must be one of the following:**

- registered with the CKC,
- have an Event Registration Number,
- be eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- if designated as a Miscellaneous Class breed, it must have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number.

**Section 8.4.1 Listed Dogs: If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:**

- it is not a designated Miscellaneous Class breed;
- that if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration;
- that if not born in Canada, is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC.
- that if it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtain from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

**Section 8.4.2** Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee.

**Section 8.5.1** Acceptance of Entries: If indicated in the premium list, an electronically transmitted entry may be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a credit card charge authorization.

**Section 8.5.3** No entry shall be accepted from or on behalf of any person who is officially known to be expelled, deprived of privileges, debarred or suspended by the CKC or any other registering body for pure bred dogs.

**Section 8.5.4** After entries close, no further entries may be accepted, cancelled or substituted other than as otherwise stated in this section or as provided for in case of a postal strike.

**Section 8.6.1** Refusal of Entries: The authorities of any show may:

- decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or
- refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of disease or viciousness.
- in the case of non-acceptance, refund the fee with the reason for non-acceptance.

**Section 8.8.2** Fees: Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fee shall be considered non-payment of said fee and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

**Section 8.9.1** Moving a Dog to Specials: A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least one hour prior to the opening of the show.

**Section 8.9.2** If it is established that a dog transferred to Specials Only has not completed the Championship requirements, all awards will be canceled and all ribbons and prizes won shall be forfeited. The owner may also be subject to disciplinary action.

**Section 8.9.3** When one or more All-Breed and/or Specialty Shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the moving of class dogs to Specials must be made prior to the scheduled opening of the first show.

**Chapter 4 Judges Section 4.1.3** A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

**Section 4.1.6** No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act.

### Chapter 14 Disqualifying or Excusing Dogs

**Section 14.1.4** Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for information on reinstatement, see Chapter 14 Section 14.3 of the Dog Show Rules.

### Championship Points and Cancellations

**Section 15.1.1** A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

**Section 15.1.2** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13 & more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*Includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

**Section 15.1.3** If a Dog awarded Winners was also awarded Best of Breed then at the show all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included the total.

**Section 15.1.4** If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.

**Section 15.1.5** If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

**Section 15.1.6** If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

**Section 15.1.7** The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

**Clarification:** Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

**Section 15.1.8** In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that the dog was defeated at the Group level.

**Section 15.1.9** A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show:

**Section 15.1.10** A breed or class shall not be allowed more than 2 sets of championship points per sex on any day in the same venue.

**Section 15.1.11** A dog awarded Winners which also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

**Section 15.1.12** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 judges; and, be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number and have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.
