The SKOC takes no responsibility for omissions or errors made on the entry forms. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to the CKC rules.
- ♦ BITCHES IN SEASON: Obedience entry fees WILL be gladly refunded to exhibitors whose females are in season during the trials (and must be withdrawn) IF: a dated veterinarian's certificate is produced prior to the trial.
- ◆ THE PRECINCTS of these trials shall be the Manhattan building & grounds. No dog will be allowed in the building unless entered in the Trials or Exhibition Only.

Major Class changes:

<u>Pre-Novice</u> – Deleted: Circle Left and Circle Right. Added: Figure 8. Posts to be 12 feet apart.

<u>Novice A</u> – No person who has previously exhibited a dog that has earned a <u>CDX</u> title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. <u>Stand for examination</u> will be done <u>off</u> leash. Only one dog may be entered in this class. Any dog entered in this class must be the owner of the dog or a member of the immediate family.

<u>Novice Intermediate</u> – Drop from heel has been moved to follow Stand for Examination. Both a command and signal are allowed for the drop. Honor Exercise: removed. Replaced with Recall over the High Jump holding the Dumbbell.

<u>Open A</u> – Exercises will be performed in the usual order. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog in Utility may not handle a dog in this class.

Open B – Exercises will be done in random order. Order will be posted approx 30 minutes prior to judging. Dogs entered in this class do not need to be owner handled. Utility A – For dogs which have not earned the title of U.D. No person who has earned a MOTCH title may handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Exercises will be performed in the usual order.

<u>Utility B</u> – Exercises will be done in random order. Order will be posted approx 30 minutes prior to judging. Dogs entered in this class do not need to be owner handled. <u>VETERAN DOGS</u>: At the option of the handler, may jump ³/₄ of the height required for their breeds. Veteran dogs must be 7 years of age or older on the day of the trial.

NON MEMBER PARTICIPANT FEE

(April 20, 2011)

This fee applies to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

- A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC.
- The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee.
 Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.

NEW ** CANINE COMPANION NUMBER (CCN)**

Mixed breeds are now welcome to participate in CKC Licensed Performance Events.

A CCN allows mixed breeds and unrecognized breed dogs to participate in the CKC Performance Events: Agility, Obedience & Rally O. To enter any Trial, the dog MUST have a CC Number. Handler draws out of a Hat three exercises from the list of exercises that he and his dog have to perform at their titled level. The Handler and dog will be judged by a competent evaluator but not a licensed judge. Entry fee is \$20.00. Winner takes half the pot and SKOC the other half.
