Cheques dated after close of entries will not be accepted. Returned cheques & declined credit cards will be assessed a \$50.00 service charge (Conformation Show Rules and Regulations - Section 8.8.2). Please do not send entries by Registered Mail. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date. Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

TRACKING SHEET FOR AGILITY PRIZES

In order to streamline the prizes this year, and to ensure that everyone gets their prize in a timely manner, AKC has decided to have prize tracking sheets for Agility supported entries. To be eligible for these prizes, competitors must obtain a tracking sheet from the Trial Secretary to record the dog's qualifying runs. This form must be completed by the competitor and submitted to the Trial Secretary's desk within 1 hour of the completion of the Agility Competition.

Agility Supported Entry Prizes will be available for pick up after Noon on Sunday. Any supported entry prizes not picked up by the end of the day on Monday will be considered a donation to AKC to be used for future prizes.

The points will be awarded as follows for each Qualifying run earned over the two (Friday and Saturday) days:

For information purposes only – for further details and to enter please see the Alberta Kennel Club Premium List section for ALL Boosters - In the event of a tie within Standard or within JWW, the award will be given to the class of higher difficulty. If the tie within Standard or within JWW is from the same class, the award will be given to the faster time. In the event of a tie between Standard and JWW, the award will be given to the class of higher difficulty. If the tie between Standard and JWW is from the same class, the award will be given to the faster time.

JUVENILE & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Each class will be divided by sex. The Foothills Gazehound Club will retain 25% of each entry fee for expenses. The remaining 75% shall be awarded as follows:

- First in each class 30% of entry fee & rosette
- Second in each class 20% of entry fee & rosette
- Third in each class 15% of entry fee & rosette
- Fourth in each class 10% of entry fee & rosette
- Best in Sweepstakes will receive a prize & rosette.

Juvenile Classes: 4 – 6 Months; 6 – 9 Months; 9 – 12 Months; 12 – 18 Months.

Veteran Classes: 7 – under 10 Years; 10+ Years.

CLASSIFICATIONS

REGULAR CLASSES -The following CKC classes (divided by sex; except Specials Only) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.			
SENIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.			
12 - 18 MONTHS	Dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show.			
CANADIAN BRED	Dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.			
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.			
OPEN CLASS	For all dogs.			
VETERAN CLASS	For all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.			
FIELD CLASS	For breeds that have performance events in the field. Dogs entered in this class must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. This class is to be judged prior to Best of Breed judging with winners of each sex competing for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.			
SPECIALS ONLY	Dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.			

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

BABY PUPPY	Dogs between 4 months and under 6 months on day of show.			
	This class shall be comprised of the stud dog and two (2) or more of his get. Ownership in			
SIRE & GET	this class need not be identical. The stud dog may be neutered and must be entered in a			
	regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a regular class.			
	This class shall be comprised of the brood bitch and two (2) or more of her progeny.			
DAM & PROGENY	Ownership in this class need not be identical. The brood bitch may be spayed and must be			
	entered in a regular class or in Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a regular class.			
BRACE	This class shall be for two (2) dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A			
	Brace should be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait, and same stride. When			
BRACE	viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be			
	handled by one (1) person on one (1) lead.			
EXHIBITION ONLY	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete			
EXHIBITION ONET	in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.			
EXHIBITION ONLY	Puppies 4-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 4-6 Months provided the			
(4-6 MONTHS)	owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. These Puppies may not participate			
(4 0 WOINTIO)	in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades.			

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Conformation Show Rules and Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club or can be viewed online.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All
 rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club Premium List, will also apply to this
 Specialty.
- Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Event Secretary.
- 4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" **Conformation Show Rules and Regulations** Section 19.7.

- 5. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.
- 6. The CKC will not consider a request for any corrections to results if received more than 90 days following the date(s) of the event(s).
- 7. No dog may be brought on the grounds or premises of an event if it:
 - Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases;
 - Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
 - Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable diseases.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS!

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number</u>. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded here.

INFORMATION FOR US EXHIBITORS ON ENTERING CANADA

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however, to enter back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved</u> Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog.

NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*} includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **no**t be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule as set forth above.
