From the North: QE Hwy #2 South to Stoney Trial Hwy #201. Follow Stoney Trial East to the Country Hills Blvd Exit (exit 68) Go East on Country Hills Blvd (Hwy # 564) for 17.2 km to Hwy #9. South on Hwy #9 3.2 km (2 miles) to Dalroy Road (Twp Rd 252). East 1.6 km (1 mile) to Rge Rd 271. Right turn South to first acreage.

From the South: QE Hwy #2 North to Stoney Trail Exit 234A. Exit East (right) on Stoney Trail and follow to Hwy #22X East Exit 96. Take Hwy #22X East to Langdon Corner (Rge Rd 272). Signage for The Track Golf Course. North on Rge Rd 272 to 4-way Stop at Langdon. Continue North (now on Hwy 797) to Hwy #1. Cross Hwy #1 onto Hwy #9. North on Hwy #9 for 9.6 km (6 miles) to Dalroy Road (Twp Rd 252). At this point, follow directions from North.

From the West: Trans Canada Hwy (#1) to Stoney Trial Hwy #201. Follow Stoney Trial to the Country Hills Blvd Exit (exit 68). At this point, follow directions from North.

From the East: Trans Canada Hwy (#1) to Hwy #9. Turn Right on Hwy #9 and go North on Hwy #9 for 9.6 km (6 miles) to Dalroy Road (Twp Rd 252). At this point, follow directions from North.

If your GPS wants you to take Twp Rd 250. Ignore it and take Twp Rd 252.

Eligible Entries-Open to any Afghan, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Greyhound, Ibizan, Italian Greyhound, Pharaoh Hound, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, Whippet, Irish Wolfhound or CKC Miscellaneous Sighthound that is one year or older the day of the trial. All entrants must be registered or eligible for registration, with the Canadian Kennel Club, have ERN # or PEN #. Hounds presently disqualified under CKC, ASFA, CSFA OR AKC rules cannot compete. Hounds with breed standard disqualifications or altered/neutered are eligible to enter the lure field trial. Hounds must pre-qualify prior to entering their first trial in Canada. Additional Information for Field Trial

- Overnight parking permitted on field. Please Park in the designated areas. Port-a-potty on site. **Bruce's Bistro will be open for breakfast and lunch.**
- Stakes will be split if the entry is 20 or more hounds at roll call.
- Hounds will be run twice, in braces or trios (except single dog entries) unless excused, dismissed, or declared ineligible.
- Lame hounds or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call.
- Hounds not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds. No Exceptions.
- All handlers must use a slip lead when releasing a hound. A Standing Start will be used on Tally-Ho.
- Leg wrappings must be of a neutral colour to comply with CKC rules. Muzzles & catch collars may be used at the handler's discretion. **No Flexi-leads or shock collars allowed.**
- A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after Best in Field.
- Bring your own water and shade.
- No catalogue will be published. Score sheets will be available.
- A veterinary clinic is within easy access from the field.
- Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Do not stuff plastic bags down holes or in port-a-poties. Please use the trash receptacles provided.
- Please come early to help fill gopher holes as they have been very busy.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee (24-12-3)

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is \$170.00 + 5% GST.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, <http://www.ckc.ca> under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved. This fee does not have to be paid before entering this event.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$64.00 + 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC website: <http://www.ckc.ca>

Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada.

- **Please check the Canada Border Services website for current travel requirements to enter Canada.**
- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens aged 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog, unless under the age of three months.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR	Dogs <i>owned and handled in the ring by the breeder</i> for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	For all dogs
VETERANS CLASS	For all dogs over 7 years of age on the day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed or neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	For dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number, ERN or MSC Number must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.
ALTERED	Dogs 12 months of age or older. Dogs in this class must be spayed or neutered.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

To participate in the show a hound must have achieved a qualifying score in the Open or Mixed Stakes in the proceeding field trial without having been excused, dismissed, or declared ineligible. You must PRE-ENTER both events prior to September 13, 2023.

Veterans may be spayed or neutered.

Please complete both a show entry and a trial entry as they are separate events.

Exhibitors Please Note: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to any indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Show precincts shall be within 50 feet of the designated show ring

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these dog show rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0-5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder:

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points Awarded	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the number of championship points by a dog awarded WINNERS, total of all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex, and then consult the schedule set forth above. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered

from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at a breed or group level.

15.2 Grand Champion (GCh) (47-06-12)

Section 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

Section 15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

Section 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(a) Grand Champion Point System

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

*Dogs Competing	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10-12	13 & more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

(b) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points

15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) (48-06-12)

Section 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC grand championship title.

Section 15.3.2 Points for this title may be accumulated at any time after the completion of the CKC grand championship but does not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship or the grand championship.

Section 15.3.3 A minimum of 100 points, which must include one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) plus three (3) Group 1st or three (3) breed specialty wins.

Grand Champion Excellent point system

Win	Points
First in Group or Best in Specialty Show	5
Second in Group or Best of Opposite Single-Breed Specialty Show	4
Third in Group	3
Fourth in Group (Note: No points are acquired if no other dog is present in the group.)	2
Best of Breed (To earn the breed point, at least five (5) dogs must be shown at breed level.)	1
Best in Show or Best in National Specialty Show	10

Section 15.3.4 Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. For example, a dog that wins first in group and then wins Best in Show, earns 10 points, not 15.

Section 15.3.5 The title of Grand Champion Excellent shall not be awarded retroactively. However, dogs that have been awarded the Grand Champion title prior to January 1, 2013, will be awarded the Grand Champion Excellent title on application to the CKC.

Section 15.3.6 Additional Requirements

To attain a Grand Champion Excellent title, a dog must have been awarded a CKC performance title from any CKC event. A CGN, Herding Tested certificate or Chase Ability Program title are not considered performance titles for the awarding of this title.

- **Grand Champion Bronze:** Awarded after an additional 50 points are earned after completing a Grand Championship and other qualifiers.
- **Grand Champion Silver:** Awarded after an additional 100 points are earned after completing a Grand Championship Bronze and other qualifiers.
- **Grand Champion Gold:** Awarded after an additional 200 points are earned after completing a Grand Championship Silver and other qualifiers.

Competitors can begin to earn points for these new titles after July 1st, 2021.

Have you already earned additional Grand Champion Points? Those can be used towards your Grand Champion Bronze title; however, you must earn a minimum of 5 points towards this title after July 1st, 2021.

c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

This fee does not have to be paid before entering this show.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS (applies to both events)

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$62.40 + 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- **Please check the Canada Border Services website for current travel requirements to enter Canada.**
- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog, unless under the age of three months.



A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or Interac for payment.
