JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES CLASS

6 to 18 MONTH Sweepstakes

The Sweepstakes classes are open to all Newfoundlands from 6 months to under 18 months regardless of their place of birth. Dogs <u>MUST</u> also be entered in one of the regular classes at this Specialty. (Champions of record are permitted to compete)

- For the purpose of judging, classes (divided by sex ONLY) as listed:
 JUNIOR (Male/Female) 6 months and under 9 months
 SENIOR (Male/Female) 9 months and under 12 months
 JUVENILE (Male/Female) 12 months and under 15 months
 JUVENILE (Male/Female) 15 months and under 18 months
- 2) For final judging, the First place dog only in each class will be brought together for the final placings of Best in Sweepstakes & Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

Prizes:

BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES – 20% of total fees collected/Rosette, and/or prize BEST OPPOSITE SEX IN SWEEPSTAKES – 15% of total fees collected/Rosette and/or prize

1st IN EACH CLASS – 5% of total fees collected/Rosette and/or prize 2nd to 4th IN EACH CLASS – a Rosette

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES CLASS

Open to all Newfoundlands who are seven years of age and older on the day Sweepstakes. Spayed or neutered dogs may compete provided they are entered in the Veterans (competitive) Class or for Exhibition Only.

Classes (divided by sex):

7 years & under 9 years Male/Female 9 years & 11+ years Male/Female

The First place dog in each class will be brought together for the final placings of Best in Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

<u>Prizes</u>

BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES - 25% of total fees collected/Rosette, and/or prize BEST OPPOSITE SEX IN SWEEPSTAKES - 20% of total fees collected/Rosette, and/or prize

1st IN EACH CLASS - 5% of total fees collected/Rosette and/or prize 2nd to 4th IN EACH CLASS – a Rosette

Balance of 25% to be retained by the club to defray costs

Following the judging of Best of Breed and Best Opposite Sex, at the judges' discretion, Awards of Merit rosettes will be presented. (1 Award per 10 dogs competing for Best of Breed.)

Note: The person handling the exhibit in the ring shall be recognized as the owner or agent for the owner, and delivery of any prize won shall constitute full delivery of the prize to the rightful owner. ALL PRIZES MUST BE CLAIMED AT THE SHOW - NO PRIZES WILL BE MAILED

JUNIOR HANDLING

Registration will take place at the Specialty ring

Open to all Juniors 7 years of age and up to but not including 18 years of age as of the date of this competition. The Newfoundland handled by the Junior must be entered in the Specialty in an Official class OR for Exhibition Only. The dog used need **NOT** be owned by the Junior Handler or any member of his/her family.

CLASSES WILL BE DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Junior Novice - 7 to 10 Yrs, Junior Open 7 to 10 yrs, Intermediate Novice - 11 to 14 Yrs, Intermediate Open - 11 to 14 Yrs Senior Novice - 15 to BUT NOT INCLUDING 18 Yrs, Senior Open - 15 to BUT NOT INCLUDING 18 yrs.

A Rosette and/or prize will be offered for first through fourth in each class as well as for Best Overall.

Please note: There will be NO Pee Wee class offered with this Specialty

CONFORMATION CLASSIFICATIONS

The following official regular/non-regular classes (divided by sex) will be provided at this Specialty.

JUNIOR PUPPY - dogs 6 mths & under 9 mths on the day of this Show SENIOR PUPPY - dogs 9 mths & under 12 mths on the day of this Show 12 to 18 MONTH CLASS - dogs 12 mths & under 18 mths on day of Show CANADIAN BRED - dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded BRED BY EXHIBITOR - For dogs owned and handled in the ring by Breeder OPEN CLASS - For all dogs (Note: Divided by colour - Black or Landseer) VETERANS CLASS - For dogs 7 - 9 years of age and 9+ years of age and older on the day of this Show. Dogs entered in this class DO NOT COMPETE FOR POINTS but rather the winners each of the Veteran Male & Veteran Female Class go directly onto the Best of Breed competition. (Note: Spayed or neutered dogs may be entered in this class)

<u>SPECIALS ONLY</u> - For dogs that have earned all the Championship Points required for CKC Championship status at the time of closing of entries <u>EXHIBITION ONLY</u> - For dogs wishing to compete in a non-regular class. No dog entered for Exhibition Only may compete in any of the Regular Classes

NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL CLASSES ALL DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN ONE OF THE REGULAR CLASSES OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY.

<u>BRACE CLASS</u> - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex) (Note: effective January 1, 2006– identical ownership NO LONGER applies)

<u>STUD DOG CLASS</u> – This class shall be comprised of the Stud Dog and 2 or more of his get. All dogs comprising the get need not be the property of the same exhibitor. Get must be entered in a regular class.

<u>BROOD BITCH CLASS</u> – This class shall be comprised of the Brood Bitch and 2 or more of her progeny. All dogs comprising the progeny need not be the property of the same exhibitor. Progeny must be entered in a regular class.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility into this class shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed.

Two classes ONLY will be offered as follows:

Altered Male or Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winners from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed

Rosettes and/or prize will also be offered for HQS in all Obedience and Rally trials.



GRAND CHAMPION

(synopsis only – full details posted on CKC website Points towards a Grand Championship cannot be gained until a dog completes its Canadian Championship. The accumulation of points began January 1, 2013. The dog must compete in the Specials Only class. Twenty points are needed for the title (the forms are available for download from the

CKC website and it is the responsibility of the owner to keep track and when they reach the 20 points, submit the form to CKC who will verify the wins, and if correct will issue a certificate). In the 20 points there needs to be a minimum of 1 Best of Breed and at least 2 – 2 point wins. The scale of points is the same as for regular championships. A judge will select Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog, Select Bitch (the latter 2 will be chosen from the remaining Specials dogs competing, if any in competition). The points are based on the total number of dogs defeated

RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

- 1. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON FROM THE SHOW. THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT SHALL HAVE FULL CONTROL OF THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS, WHICH WILL BE GOVERNED BY CKC RULES.
- 2. A DOG EXCUSED BY THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT OR VETERINARIAN FOR ANY REASON SHALL NOT. COMPETE IN ANY CLASS FOR ANY AWARDS FOR BALANCE OF THE SHOW.
- 3. THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL USE DUE CARE AND DILIGENCE FOR THE WELFARE OF DOGS AND EXHIBITORS, BUT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR, OR ASSUME ANY LIABILITY IN THE EVENT OF ACCIDENT OR MISFORTUNE TO EITHER DOGS, EXHIBITORS, SPECTATORS OR VENDORS.
- 4. DOGS MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 1-HOUR PRIOR TO THE JUDGING OF THEIR BREED.
- 5. THE OWNER OF A DOG ENTERED IN THESE SHOWS IS ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERROR IN ENTERING HIS/HER DOG REGARDLESS OF HOW OR BY WHOM ENTRY IS MADE
- 6. EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DOGS AND EQUIPMENT LEFT AT THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- 7. DOGS TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, NOT IN VICINITY OF RINGS
- 8. ALL RECREATIONAL UNITS WILL HAVE BUCKETS UNDERNEATH FOR THEIR SINK DRAINS. ANYONE FOUND DISCHARGING WATER ON THE GROUNDS WILL BE REMOVED BY ORDER OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FINE.
- 9. IF, BECAUSE OF CIVIL DISTURBANCE OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE SHOW, NO REFUND OF ENTRY.

 10. DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR WITHIN THE SHOW BUILDING WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE OBEDIENCE RINGS.

ALL EXHIBITORS, HANDLERS AND PATRONS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE CKC DOG SHOW RULES.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

| DOGS COMPETING* | 1 | 2 | 3 to 5 | 6 to 9 | 10 to 12 | 13 or more |

| POINTS AWARDED | 0 | 1 | 2 | 3 | 4 | 5 |

*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The point system provides for additional points if a class dog awarded Best of Breed also places in the group as listed below;

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, SHALL NOT be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)
