In payment of entry fees, the tendering of NSF cheques shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$45.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque. **Credit card payment** will be accepted when accompanied by authorized credit card number, expiry date and cardholder's name. 10% of total fee will be added for Credit Card or Debit Card entries. Customers whose charges are declined by the Bank Card Authorization Department will be assessed a service charge of \$50.00 for each transaction declined. Telephone entries are not accepted by the Show Secretary. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. There will be no refund on overpayments or duplicate entries. Please mail entries early to ensure that they are received before the closing date. Please mail entries very early to insure that they will be received in time. The Show Secretary will not accept responsibility for errors that are a result of our inability to interpret your entry form.

## ATTENTION-FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

## TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBERS

All dogs entered in CKC events that are not CKC registered must have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) before entering into the event(s). **Please note that Listed Breeds are not eligible for a TCN (effective July 6, 2021, this includes Baby Puppies).** Listed Breeds must have a Miscellaneous\_Certification Number (MCN) before entering into an event

## ERN (EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN. This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, simply do the following: send to CKC, a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, i.e. AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number. Payment must be included with the application. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you. FAXED requests will be accepted. Please include your VIS A/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholders name and signature. The ERN number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as listed however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in the cancellations of any wins, awards, and scores..

## NON CKC MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE – Canadian Residents Only

Effective Jan.1, 2011, the CKC instituted a Non-Member Participation fee for all Canadian Residents who participate in a CKC event, but are not CKC members. To protect Awards/Titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. This applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members, resident in Canada nor to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member.

## **EXTRACTS FROM CKC SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS**

**4.7.1** A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty, and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out

**19.7** It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

### **SHOW OFFICIALS - 5.1.6**

The officials of a show-giving club will be held responsible for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators during the show. Any person acting in an objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

### **ENTRY FORMS - SECTION 8.2.3**

Entry forms received by the CKC that are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

### **ENTRY FORMS - SECTION 8.2.5**

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

### **REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2**

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

**DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4** Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action. (58-06-17) (58-06-17) (13-09-17) 48 A dog disqualified under Section 14.1.2 (b) is not eligible for reinstatement.

### **Eligibility to Compete in Rally Obedience**

To be eligible to compete in these trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN, CCN or a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked. Only approved CKC approved collars will be allowed in the precincts of the Trials. Correct information on the entry form is the responsibility of the entrant. However, Exhibitors incorrectly entered in the “A” class are permitted to move the dog to the corresponding “B” class up to one hour before the start of the trial. The YKC takes no responsibility for omissions or errors made on the entry forms. The Show Committee and Event Secretary reserve the right to refuse any entry subject to the CKC rules.

**BITCHES IN SEASON** are not allowed to compete in Rally Obedience. Entry fees WILL be gladly refunded to exhibitors IF a dated veterinarian’s certificate stating that the bitch was in season within a 10 day period preceding the trial is provided to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.

### **LIMITED ENTRY (RALLY)**

Entry in each trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to perform 7 hours (420 minutes) of judging at the rate of 8 Novice dogs per hour, 7 Open dogs per hour and 6 Utility dogs per hour. Once a judge has reached their maximum capacity the entries shall be closed but a reserve list will be created. Handlers will be notified of their position on the reserve list and any entries pulled after closing date due to a bitch coming in season. Their spot may be filled by a competitor on the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial.

## RALLY OBEDIENCE

- Rally Ring size will be a minimum **40' x 50'**
- The precincts of these trials are the ring and immediate area surrounding
- Only dogs entered are permitted within the precincts of the trial.
- No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC Obedience CDX title shall be eligible to enter the A class in Rally Novice, Advanced or Excellent.

RALLY NOVICE A - Dogs competing in this class may not have earned the R. N. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY NOVICE B - Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE - The Rally Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced Classes.(CKC rules, 10.1.2) This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class (performed on leash, no jumps, no A or B division) may be entered indefinitely. Judges would ordinarily use the same course for it as for their Advanced Classes, substituting one other exercise for the jump required in Advanced.

RALLY ADVANCED A - This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY ADVANCED B - This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT A - This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R. A. title, but have not earned the R. E. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is also a sit stay exercise after the finish sign. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT B - This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.A. title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is a sit stay exercise after the finish sign.

RALLY MASTER - This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.E. TITLE . A dog completing the R.M. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class.. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

**All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its C.K.C. Obedience CDX title shall be eligible to enter the A class in Rally Novice, Advanced or Excellent.**

## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Trial Chairperson shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. No dog is to be off leash at any time on or near the grounds except when required in the ring. Violation of this rule can lead to dismissal from the competition. No refund shall be given.
3. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Trial Chairperson shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated. YKC has a zero tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with the YKC shows, including spectators.
4. Exhibitors must exercise their dogs in the designated areas provided. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.
5. The welfare of children is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Please exercise control and restraint over the children in your care while on the show precincts.
6. All entries must be complete, including the full name & address of the owner of the dog. The Club reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how and by whom entries were made. Changes or cancellations after closing date are prohibited except according to CKC rules.
7. No refund of entry fee will be made if, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Yukon Kennel Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show.
8. The Yukon Kennel Club will use due care & diligence to ensure the welfare and safety of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors, vendors or spectators.
9. BORDER CROSSINGS (Please make sure you are aware of the requirements for entry into Canada and return to the United States for both you and your dog) Canada requires proof of current rabies vaccination for all dogs coming into Canada. The date of the rabies vaccine must be at least 30 days prior to entry to Canada. Current information on border crossings can be found here:
