CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION

- This is VERY ROUGH pastureland terrain with hills and rocks. It is **not** recommended for Italian Greyhounds.
- All hounds will be run in trios or braces, twice, unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
- Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched, and their entry fee will NOT be refunded. No exceptions will be made.
- All handlers MUST use a slip lead when releasing their hounds.
- Hounds may wear muzzles and/or catch collars at the owner/agent's discretion.
- Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused and will have their entry fee returned if notice is given to the secretary **prior** to roll call.
- The Chairman may excuse any hound from competition for any reason deemed justifiable.
- A \$5.00 fine, payable to ALCA, will be levied for any hound loose on the field at any time between roll call and the completion of Best in Field.

Attention all Foreign Exhibitors!

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables foreign-born and foreign-owned dogs to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN mail or Fax a copy of the dog's registration certificate with payment in the amount of \$58.85 Canadian funds, payable to the CKC. This ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event to avoid cancellation of Awards. Non Member Participation Fee

The following non-member participation fee now applies and is retroactive to January 1, 2011. The non-member participation fee applies to all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members and a participating non-member can chose to purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member fee.

This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it's important that non-members select one of the two options within 30 days of notification or, unfortunately, CKC will be forced to cancel any awards and titles

Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

a) An **annua**l non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b)In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c)The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

It is in your best interest to acquire a Basic CKC membership at \$50 +GST to cover all your dogs as opposed to the Non-Member Participation Fee of \$55+tax per dog.

DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD

The field is located east of Sherwood Park and 18 km east of Highway 21. Go east on Baseline Road (becomes Twp 530) to Range Road 211. Turn left, then first entrance on the left. From Highway 16, go right at Range Road 211, south to last driveway on the right before Twp 530. This is north of the Sherwood Park Freeway.

ELIGIBLE ENTRIES

To be eligible for this trial, your dog MUST be a purebred of one of these following breeds:

Singles Competition

Is your dog DQ d, declared ineligible or not ready for running in competition, but you would like your dog judged? This is the place to be! Dogs will be run individually and scored by a judge. Hounds will run after the Open stake has completed its preliminary round and then again after the Open stake has completed its final round. A random draw will determine the order of running of dogs in this stake. Dogs must wear a blanket. No points are awarded and all ties will be settled by a coin toss. A ribbon will be awarded to 1st to NBQ. Your dog will be only given TWO opportunities to chase the lure each time it comes to the line. Handlers will not be able to run/walk the course with their hounds.

Puppies and Veterans, run singly (Saturday after completion of regular classes and any Certification runs).

Entry must be received by 11.30 a.m. Saturday, June 11, 2011.

Kennel, Club and Breeder Stakes

Entry must be received by 8.30 a.m. Sunday, June 12, 2011

FIRST TIME ENTERED HOUNDS

As of July 1st, 1998, all hounds competing for the first time must be certified prior to entry in a Field Trial. If this is the Hound's first Trial you must submit the Certificate to the Field Trial Secretary (3, 3.1.2 (a) CKC Field Trial Regulation).

CERTIFICATION RUNS

ALCA will hold Certification runs after the completion of the Regular Trial on Saturday evening. Cost is \$10.00. You are expected to make your own arrangements for a suitable dog to run yours with.

CKC definition:

7.1.1 (a) A hound must be tested with another dog, not a kennelmate, preferably of the same breed, and certified running clean by a licensed judge. Hounds must be a minimum of 11 months old prior to being certified, and must run a normal course of 600 yards (548.4 m) in order to be certified..

ROLL CALL TIMES AND RUNNING ORDERS

Post Entry closes at 9.30 a.m. on **Saturday**. Roll call will be at 10:00 a.m.

Post Entry closes at 8.30~a.m. on Sunday. Roll call will be at 9:00~a.m.

Breeds will be run in alphabetical order on Saturday, and reverse alphabetical order on Sunday.

Puppy Stakes and Veterans will be run AFTER Official Classes on Saturday.

Best in Field will be run on Sunday only. It includes all Best of Breed winners from both Saturday and Sunday.

PRIZES

Rosettes and a Trophy will be awarded to BOB, First through NBQ placements and BIF. A Qualifying ribbon will be offered for each qualifying score earned by a hound which has not previously earned the Novice Courser Title. Please let the Field Trial Secretary know if your hound qualifies.

A ribbon will be awarded to 1st to NBQ for the Singles run.

A ribbon will be offered for the winner of each of the Kennel, Breeder and Club stakes.

Extract from CKC Field Trial Rules and Regulations for Lure Coursing Chapter 9.5 Placements and Awards

9.5.1 Hounds which are not to be scored are not to be added to a course.9.5.2 Championship points in regular stakes shall be awarded on the basis of the following:

First Place:

Four times the number of hounds competing in the stake with a maximum of 40 points.

Three times the number of hounds competing in the stake with a maximum of 30 points. **Third Place:**

Twice the number of hounds competing in the stake with a maximum of 20 points.

Fourth Place:

Points equal to the number of hounds competing in the stake to a maximum of 10 points. Next Best Qualified Dog (NBQ):

No points awarded.

Qualifying Score (QS)

No points awarded.

9.5.3 A hound shall not receive a placement or be awarded points if it does not score at least 50 per cent of the total possible combined scores. Hounds which do not receive placements under this provision will, nevertheless, be considered as having been in competition for the purpose of awarding points. If a hound is excused in the preliminary run, that hound will not count as having been in competition when computing championship points. Hounds that are dismissed or declared ineligible shall count as having been in competition when computing championship points.

ATTENTION



Courses subject to change depending on weather and safety considerations


Saturday
