Carol Gray, Regional Specialty Judge

I acquired my first Great Dane in 1966. Duchess was a fawn puppy that was with me for thirteen years. This began a 32 year association with the Great Dane Breed that included Fawn, Brindle and Harlequin Great Danes. I was "Best In Show " at the Credit Valley Show in 1981 with a Harl. I learned the show world very quickly being mentored for many years by Ray Cataldi (Rojon). I am a life member of The Association of Great Dane Fanciers. In 1978 I founded Thunderally Kennel (Permanent Registered) as my kennel and have been known for breeding dogs of quality conformation and kind temperament. I was involved with Great Dane Rescue with Pat Whetstone for many of my years in the breed. I am proud to

have been the breeder/owner of the first Canadian-bred winner in twenty five years at the American National Specialty in Westchester (1983) with a brindle boy AM & CAN Ch Thunderally's Bold Cheveron (Chevy). Chevy was one of seven Thunderally puppies in a litter that all finished in Canada...three in Canada & America.

I am a Canadian & American All Breed Judge licensed to judge the Working & Terrier breed. I am on permit in Canada for the Hound breeds. I have judged in England, Ireland, Scotland, Wales as well as the Netherlands, Australia and Hawaii I am an International Bull Terrier & Miniature Bull Terrier ROM Judge.

Following my thirty two years in Great Danes I moved on to Bull Terriers & Miniature Bull Terriers. I have owned and bred some of the top Bulls and Minis in Canada including the top Bull Terrier in Canada (2016) MBIS MBISS AM/CAN CH Thunderally's Dapper Dan (Handsome) and the top mini in Canada in 2020 MBISS CH Thunderally's Mischevious Casper.



Shannon Van Norman, National Specialty Sweepstakes Judge

Shannon's lifelong passion for dogs began as a child and has never wavered. She purchased her first Newfoundland in 1991. Over the next few years, she added more Newfoundlands to her home and began her breeding program under the Tricklecreek prefix. She showed and bred Newfoundlands for over 15 years. After showing a Clumber Spaniel, Shannon fell quickly in love with that breed too as there were many similarities to the Newfoundland. Her passion grew to include dog shows and she worked to become an All-Breed professional handler. She specialized in the Working and Sporting groups.

Shannon has shown all over North America and has achieved multiple BIS, BISS, BPIS and over 200 group placements with her dogs. She continues to breed and show the

Clumber Spaniels. Her passion and interest in the preservation of this particular breed fuels her continued work and volunteerism with various organizations and charities. Shannon is currently on the CKC Foundation Board of Directors, past President of the Clumber Spaniel Club of Canada, and member of the CSCC, CSCA, EKC, CKC, NDFA. *All owners of **unregistered**, CKC-recognized breeds entering events are required to obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). TCNs allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while pursuing permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN) (if foreign). **Reminder:** All <u>unregistered</u> recognized breeds must obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) before entering an event. This includes Baby Puppies. While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called listing fees) when entering events using this number. The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion. TCNs replace the previous system of entering dogs into events as "listed". Only 1 TCN is required for each dog and must be used for all event entries until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars ONLY. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made. All particulars called for on the entry form must be complete. No refunds are given due to an error in entries. The club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to

CKC rules. Overpayments and duplicate entries will be considered a donation to our trophy fund. Thank you!

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

4 – 6 Month Puppy	For dogs 4 months of age but under 6 months of age the day of the show		
Junior Puppy Senior Puppy	for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age the day of the show for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age the day of the show		
12-18 Months	for dogs 12 months of age but under 12 months of age the day of the show		
Bred By Exhibitor	for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The owner/breeder of the dog must handle the dog in this class but need not handle the dog for further awards		
Canadian Bred	for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country are excluded		
Open	for all dogs.		
Veteran	for dogs, 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. These dogs do not compete for Winners, but the first place Male/Female of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. DOGS COMPETING IN THIS		
	CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED		
Specials Only	dogs which are <u>registered individually</u> , in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have a CKC ERN number and have attained the required points championship status. Entry of a dog in "Specials Only" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the CKC, but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be cancelled. The entry of a 'listed-TCN' dog in Specials Only is not allowed. Dogs entered in this class shall compete for Best of Breed		
Exhibition Only	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular Class but may enter and complete in Non-Regular Classes or Parades as provided for in this premium list		
Exhibition Only 4-6 mth	For dogs 4-6 mths whose owners also have entered a dog in one of the regular official classes.		

NON-REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES (NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY)

Stud Dog & Get	Stud dog and two or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Stud dog may be neutered and must be entered in a regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get MUST be entered in a regular class.
Brood Bitch & Progeny	Brood bitch and two or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Brood bitch may be spayed and must be entered in a regular class or in Exhibition Only. Progeny MUST be entered in a regular class.
Brace	2 Danes, not necessarily of the same sex nor same owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait and stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. Dogs entered who are spayed or neutered MUST be entered from Exhibition only or Altered Dog Class.
3-Generations Class	This class is offered to all three generation, with a maximum of four generation, families with one exhibit from each generation of a three or more generation pedigree regardless of sex, exhibited from oldest to youngest. All neutered and spayed CKC or AKC registered Great Danes are eligible. Ownership does not need to be identical. Dog #1 = Father or Mother, Dog #2 = Son or Daughter, Dog #3 = Grandson or Granddaughter. There is <u>one entry fee for each generations family</u> . A separate entry form must be submitted for each dog entered. Dogs MUST be entered in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only in order to participate in this class
Parade of Veterans*	Dogs entered in the Parade must be 7 years of age or older.
Parade of Title Holders*	For any dog that has successfully completed all requirements for a CKC Title in any CKC recognized event.

SEXUALLY ALTERED DOG CLASS (NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY)

Altered Class For dogs over six (6) months of age that have been spayed or neutered by veterinary procedure. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed of the regular classes. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.



CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded Winners at a Conformation show shall be credited with a number of Championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of

Championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

*Dogs Competing	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 & more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5
*includes the dog awarded Winners						

All dogs defeated, either directly or indirectly up to the Breed level, are to be including in the count. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge <u>shall be included</u> in the calculation for championship points.

ENTRY AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules" and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the Great Dane Club of Canada and the Great Dane Club of Canada, Western Division, has the right to refuse this entry for just cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of entries made in these specialty shows and of the holding of these shows and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Great Dane Club of Canada and the Great Dane Club of Canada, Western Division, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or show secretaries, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club(s) or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
