Judge Biographies

James A. Moses

James Moses has been involved with dogs all of his life. His mother bred miniature poodles from which Jim won his very first best in show. His father gave him his first dog, a German shepherd when he was nine years old. Jim finished his first champion by the age of 13 and by 19, handled the number one dog all breeds in Canada. Jim has handled dogs to over 1000 best in shows.

Over the years, Jim has been honored to have won some very notable shows including the AKC Centennial show and the Westminster Kennel Club with CH Covy Tucker Hill's Manhattan. He has handled four dogs in the "100 Club" including the number one dog of all time, CH Altana's Mystique. Jim and Mystique won 275 BIS and 30 BISS.

In 1999, Jim was inducted to the Dog Show Hall of Fame. Jim has handled many other breeds to best in show and specialty wins. In addition to handling, he has been the top herding group winner with several German shepherds he has bred under the Kaleef prefix. The past few years have seen several Kaleef dogs take the Grand Victor honors at the Canadian and US German Shepherd Dog Nationals.

Jim's next chapter in dogs is judging which he is thoroughly enjoying. His love of dogs and the sport has been the focus of his adult life.

Jim is also an avid sportsman and outdoorsman and is enjoying balancing breeding, judging and retirement.

Donna Conod

My mother, Betty Conod, passed her incredible passion for dogs to me making me a second-generation dog person. Our first dog, a Great Dane was acquired in 1953. She earned her championship in 1954 and was our foundation bitch (Ch Delta of Tollhurst). Whisper Hill Kennel, registered in 1962, has produced multiple BIS,BISS, American and Canadian Champions along with the number one Great Dane and number five Working dog in the country, As a handler I have shown across Canada and the US and continue to exhibit both Great Danes and German Shepherds Dogs. Other Breeds I have had an active involvement in include Pharaoh Hounds, Mini-smooth and Standard Smooth Dachshunds, Mini and Toy Poodles, American Cocker Spaniels, Wire Haired Fox Terriers, and Shih Tzus. My two heart breeds though are Great Danes (since a child) and The German Shepherd Dog which I have had an active involvement in all aspects for 30 years. I had the honour of judging bitches at the German Shepherd Dog Club of Canada's National Specialty and then in 2019, I judged both dogs and intersex. In 2018 I judged the top 20 for the Great Dane Club of America and have also judged the Great Dane National in Finland plus many more memorable assignments.

My goal was always to judge and that dream came true for me in 2002. It has been a pleasure to judge in other countries including Australia, Mexico, Finland, China, Japan, Philippines, Jamaica, Argentina, Columbia, the USA, and Canada.

There is nothing more fulfilling than the world of dogs which has consumed my life. It is an honour to be asked to judge your show and I thank you very much for the invitation.

I am a veteran Great Dane breeder with 7+ generations of Cilka Great Danes and have more than 17 years of experience in my breed. My first Great Dane I aquired in 2006 and I have been active in advancing my breed ever since. My life's work so far was campaigning for the Mantle Merle Great Dane to become an accepted colour and in 2018 that became a reality, and I re-wrote our standard to include this colour.

Rules and Regulations

GENERAL INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS

Dogs should be in the building at least one hour prior to ring time. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be aware of the posted schedule and be at ringside at the time of judging. The club will not call individual dogs to ringside. Please remain at ringside until judging is completed. A practice ring will be set up in the benching area. Regular rings must not be used for this purpose. Dogs must be exercised in the areas provided, anyone exercising their dogs on the grounds outside the building and not cleaning up after them, will be excluded from the show or trial.

Exhibitors are reminded to respect hospitality facilities. The Club reserves the right to refuse future entries from any exhibitor who creates excessive destructive or disruption to host facilities (Hotel, motel or campground). The show superintendent is in complete charge of the shows and trials which, are governed by CKC rules. No judge or any other person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under CKC rules shall be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the progress of the show. The Show Committee has a responsibility to see that this rule is enforced. Chapter 19.7, Page 55, CKC Conformation Show Rules and Regulations.

The Dog Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs, exhibitors and spectators, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune. The Club and the specialty club reserves the right to remove from the shows or trials any person or dog for any just cause. Any dog excused by the show superintendent or veterinarian, for any reason, shall not compete in any classes or accept any awards for the duration of the shows or trials. No refund of any fees will be made.

If because of riot, civil disturbance, or any other acts beyond the control of the show committee, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds shall be made!

EXTRACTS FROM THE DOG SHOW RULES - BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES

CONFORMATION CLASSES OFFERED:

12.2.1 Regular official classes at a CKC conformation show shall be as described in (a) to (k) of this section. All classes must be divided by sex (except for Specials Only). Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non-regular, or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

JUNIOR PUPPY: shall be for dogs at least six months of age and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY: shall be for dogs 9 months of age and under twelve (12) months of age on the day of the show.

12-18 MONTH - for dogs over 12 months of age but under 18 months of age. (divided into 12-15 and 15-18 for National)

CANADIAN BRED: shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS: shall be for all dogs.

VETERAN Dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. This class at a specialty MAY be divided by age. The winners of all of the Veteran's classes will come back into the ring to compete for Best of Breed.

SPECIALS ONLY: is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status including at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not

completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

UNOFFICIAL/NON-REGULAR CLASSES OFFERED

(with the exception of Baby Puppy all entries in these classes MUST be entered in a regular Class or as Exhibition Only)

BABY PUPPY Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female Best Baby Puppy in Breed Best Baby Puppy in Group Best Baby Puppy in Show

BRACE At an all-breed or specialty show a club may, but is not required to, offer a Brace Class. This class shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A Brace should be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait, and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead.

STUD DOG Stud dog and 2 or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Get MUST be entered in a Regular Class.

BROOD BITCH Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Progeny MUST be entered in a Regular Class

ALTERED: Eligibility for the Sexually Altered Dog Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered Dog Class judging. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed of the regular classes. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male & Altered Female. Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed. REGIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY

Highest Qualifying Score by a Bullmastiff between Rally and Obedience based on a percentage. Scores from the NACA regular trial on Friday, June 2/23 for the National and Sunday, June 4/23 for the Regional will qualify for this award.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you pay by credit card, bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

Entries sent by <u>Courier must be sent prepaid</u>; To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date.

Entries sent requiring a signature WILL NOT BE accepted.

Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.

Exhibitors Please Note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the show secretary not later than closing date and time. If written or electronic notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.

There will be no refunds on duplicate entries or overpayments.



Extracts From CKC Dog Show Rules

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the conformation, Obedience and Rally Rules set out by the Canadian Kennel Club.

4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action. 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

15.1 Championship Points

- 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.
- 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

- In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.
- 15.1.3 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.4 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing in Specials Only shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.5 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification:

Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Dog shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

- 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.
- 15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.
- 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.
- 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must:
- (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges;
- (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN);
- (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.
- 15.1.13 The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean:
- (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level;
- (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing;

(c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

15.2 Grand Champion (GCh)

- 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.
- 15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.
- 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(a) Grand Champion Point System

Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

(c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

- 15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.
- NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above.

2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022.
