New CKC Rule

Section 24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.
- In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

CHAPTER 20

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Included the dog awarded Winners.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the Dogs in the competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best Breed of Best of Opposite Sex and then consult schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded Winners also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited five points Inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

IN NO CASE MAY A DOG EARN MORE THAN FIVE POINTS AT ANY SINGLE SHOW.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate the dog must

- A: earn at least 10 Championship points under 3 different judges.
- B: be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an ERN number.
- C: have earned at least one 2 point win at either the breed or group level.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

DOG SHOW RULES. CHAPTER 13, SECTION 13, of the dog show rules has been amended to allow a dog which has been assigned and "individually C.K.C. OR ERN REGISTRATION NUMBER AT THE TIME OF CLOSING" By the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of a championship, after the date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW, by the Owner or Handler

CLASSIFICATIONS

In all breeds recognized by C.K.C. the following classes will be provided for, divided by sex.

- JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months and under 9 months
- SENIOR PUPPY - 9 months and under 12 months
- CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada
- BRED BY EXHIBITOR - dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.
- 12-18 MONTHS -dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.
- OPEN - for all dogs
- SPECIALS ONLY - for Canadian Champions.
- EXHIBITION ONLY - For all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with The Canadian Kennel Club.

NOTE: In breeds where classes are divided by colour, weight, or coat, indicate clearly in the class division (champions of any country excluded) on the entry form.

JUNIOR HANDLING

ALL THREE DAYS

Junior handlers must compete in their age classification until they are old enough to move up to the next level. No entry fee will be charged but all dogs handled must be entered in the all breed show in one of the official classes or for Exhibition

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign born & foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. Dogs may be entered as LISTED; however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 DAYS of the first event will result in the CANCELLATION of any wins, awards or scores. Any points or scores earned prior to January 1, 1992 are not subject to cancellation due to the lack of an ERN number. Due to the newer location for the show at Grandview Arena, exhibitors should be aware we have 2000 sq ft less space than at the Norwest.

I will be doing a walk through with arena staff to locate all available power sources, but **everyone wishing power must bring their own long extension cord as none will be provided by the club.** As stated in the premium, those wishing more than 2 reserved spaces should consider a room to ensure space/power.

Exhibitors are asked to leave extras at home, chairs will need to be collapsed, no mats extending spaces and please stack crates where possible. Space will become an issue if entries rise about last year and we want to welcome all exhibitors.

Also note, there will be no bathing/washing dogs at the arena.

Morning coffee will be arranged by club members for all exhibitors. The canteen may be open, I will not find out till August.

Parking will only be allowed in the north parking lot, respect the church parking area on Sunday when services are going on. Vehicles may drop off equipment at the door during setup, but must move immediately as the roadway is public access.

Please remember not to exercise your dogs along the building walls and pick up after your dogs as this is a self-clean show inside and out.

Discard your cigarette butts appropriately, so dogs will not be injured.
