Mixed / Unrecognized Breeds with a Canine Companion Number (CCN) are eligible for entry

Each Trial will be limited to approximately 3 1/2 hours of Judging, for a total of 7 hours of judging for the day.

Entries close: 9:00 p.m. CST, Oct 1st, 2023 or when judging limit per day has been reached, whichever is first. Day of entries will only be accepted if trial has not filled prior to closing.

Trial Rules and General Information

- 1.No entry will be accepted unless completed in full. Please note that the full name and address of all owners must be filled in. Incomplete entries will be returned. The Trial Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry as prescribed by CKC rules.
- 2.No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fees. Telephone and fax entries not accepted.
- 3.Cancellation of entries after the closing date is prohibited, except where allowed according to CKC rules. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick, lame, or excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because it is entered incorrectly.
- 4.If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 5.The Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the trial.
- 6.The Winnipeg Area Shetland Sheepdog Association. will use due care and diligence concerning the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 7.As per CKC obedience rules and regulations, section 20.7, no judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor shall be subject to indignities of any kind.
- 8.Only dogs entered in these trials are allowed in the trial building. Dogs must be removed from the building following the conclusion of the last trial.
- 9.ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.
- 10.There is a designated outdoor exercise area at the trial venue; all exhibitors are asked to use only that area for exercising their dogs, and must clean up after their dogs. PLEASE RESPECT NEIGHBOURING PROPERTIES.
- 11.All exhibitors are expected to be familiar with the CKC OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES & REGULATIONS. Copies are available on the CKC website.

Foreign Exhibitors

Please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in CANADIAN DOLLARS. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they must be payable in U.S. dollars for the full amount of the entry. Please do not send personal cheques marked "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "at par". The banks will not clear them. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Canadian Kennel Club Non-Member Participation Fee

The non-member participation fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC. It is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. For the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

Rally Obedience Classifications

NOTE: The Dimensions of the Rally Ring will be 40 x 54 feet.

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & NOVICE "B" AT SAME TRIAL.

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH ADVANCED "A" & ADVANCED "B" AT SAME TRIAL

RALLY NOVICE A: Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N.) title or any CKC CDX Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, coowner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY NOVICE B: Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE: Is an elective Class.

RALLY ADVANCED A: This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY ADVANCED B: This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT A: This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R. E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY EXCELLENT B: This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this

class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash . All dogs must enter and leave the ring on a leash.

RALLY MASTER: This class will be for dogs that have earned the RE title. A dog completing the RM title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

Obedience Classifications

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & "B" AT SAME TRIAL

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & "B" AT SAME TRIAL

PRE-NOVICE – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. but must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE "A" - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD" in ANY COUNTRY. One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor MUST BE THE OWNER or A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "CDX" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but MUST COMPETE IN NOVICE "B" CLASS

NOVICE "B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have not earned the title of "CD", and may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class

NOVICE "C" – This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial.

The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice 'C' are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS – This class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter the Open Class. This class shall be for any dog of any recognized breed or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned a CD or higher title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

OPEN CLASSES There are four (4) Open classes: The Open HA and Open HB classes, which include the Out of Sight Group Stay Exercises and the

Open 18A and Open 18B classes, which include the Change of Positions and Group Sit - Walk Around exercises.

OPEN "HA" & "18A- This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor MUST BE THE OWNER or A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

OPEN "HB" & "18B"- This class is open to all dogs, which have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

UTILITY CLASS 'A' - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class..This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

UTILITY CLASS 'B' - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises.

No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside approx. 30 minutes prior to the start of the class.
