Prizes: Trophy & Rosette for Best In Sweeps; Rosette for Best of Opposite in Sweeps

 $1^{\rm st}$ in each class – 30% of entries for that class; $2^{\rm nd}$ in class – 20% of entries for that class; $3^{\rm rd}$ in each class – 15% of entries for that class; $4^{\rm th}$ in class – 10% of entries for that class

Classifications

In all breeds, recognized by the C.K.C., the following classes will be provided for, divided by sex.

Junior Puppy 6 Months and under 9 Months
Senior Puppy 9 Months and under 12 Months
12 – 18 Months 12 Months and under 18 Months

Canadian Bred Dogs born in Canada

(Champions of any country excluded)

Bred by Exhibitor Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder

Open For all dogs

Specials Only For Canadian Champions

Exhibition Only

For all dogs over 6 Months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club

Note: In all breeds, where classes are divided by colour, weight, or coat, indicate clearly in the class division on the entry forms.

Baby Puppy Class

The Baby Puppy Class is for dogs 3 months and under 6 months on the day of the show. Dogs entered in the Baby Puppy Class do not compete for points.

Puppies entered in this class will participate & compete for Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Group and Best Baby Puppy in Show.

*****Altered Classes*****

LKC is pleased to offer ALTERED classes each day. Altered classes are for all dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Dogs will be judged exactly the same as in the regular show, with awards for Winners, Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Group placements 1st to 4th, and Best Altered in Show. A rosette is offered for Group placements and Best Altered in Show. (The point system to obtain an Altered Championship is the same as for the regular show.)

Brace (Saturday) both shows

LKC is pleased to offer the Non-Regular Class of BRACE on Saturday. Judging will take place following Breed, Group, and immediately *before* Best In Show. Dogs must be entered in a regular class or exhibition only. Dogs may be neutered/spayed.

Veterans Class

For dogs seven (7) years of age and over on the day of the show. (Dogs entered in this class may be neutered/spayed) Classes further divided by age (7-10 and 11 & over). Best Veteran Male & Female will compete for Best Veteran in Breed. Best Veteran in each breed will compete for Best Veteran in Group, and Best Veteran in Show.

Best Bred By Exhibitor (Sunday only)

A Rosette is offered for Best Bred By Exhibitor Dog in Show. Dogs must be entered in the BBE class, and handled by the breeder/owner at all levels of competition. 1st place male & female in breed shall compete for Best Bred By in Breed, and go on to compete for Best Bred By in Group & Show.

Prize List

Rosettes will be offered EACH Show for Best In Show; Reserve Best in Show, Best Puppy In Show. Best Baby Puppy In Show, Best Altered In Show; Best Brace in Show, Best Veteran in Show. Rosettes will be offered for 1st to 4th in Group (Regular & Altered); Best Puppy In Group; Best Baby Puppy In Group, Best Brace in Group, Best Veteran in Group. The Gwenyth Jessie Ann Pogson Memorial Trophy is offered for Best Puppy In the AM show on Saturday.

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering C.K.C. events will no longer require a C.K.C. registration number, but will require an **Event Registration Number (ERN)**. This ERN does not register a dog with the C.K.C. for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the C.K.C. Each dog must have it's own number. This Event Registration Number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of obtaining points, awards, or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request to the CKC for an extension. To obtain an ERN, forward request along with the fee of \$59.40 to: The Canadian Kennel Club, Shows and Trials Division (address on front cover). Notice To All Canadian Residents Only

Section 24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

Chapter 20: Champions and Championship Points

Section 1. A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Rules shall be accredited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Section 4. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition as provided in Chapter 4, Section 8(j) of these Rules shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

Section 15.1.2 Dog Show Rules:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

General Information

The Show Superintendent shall be in full charge of the Shows and Specialty Shows, which shall be governed by the Canadian Kennel Club Rules.

Print your entries carefully. Include your complete address. Errors made on entries by exhibitors or their agent must stand regardless of how or by whom entries were made.

No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee.

No refund of entry fees will be made if it is impossible to open or complete any show because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of The Lakehead Kennel Club.

Entry fees will not be refunded should the dog be absent, sick, lame, in season, or excused by a Veterinarian, the Judge, or the Show Superintendent.

The Lakehead Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to Canadian Kennel Club Rules

Dogs must be ready for judging; individual dogs will not be called. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a Breed or Dog. **Dogs not entered in the Show are not allowed in the Building.** Exercise areas must be used. The Show Committee will take all precautions and use all methods to keep the Building and surrounding area as clean as possible. Exhibitors are expected to do their part as well. **Private Exercise pens will be permitted ONLY at the discretion of the Show Superintendent.**

Lakehead Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune, to dogs, exhibitors or patrons. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Exhibitors shall exercise control and restraint over their children while attending these shows.

The show premises will be open not later than one hour before the scheduled judging time.

Junior Handling Extravaganza

- (Junior Handling Competition each day - open to ALL juniors)

LKC is pleased to present its 17th Annual Junior Handling Extravaganza! There will be a regular competition each day, with an award for the 3-day Best Overall Aggregate Score; Runner-Up; Best Overall Aggregate Score for a LKC Junior Member and Runner-Up. A perpetual Memorial Trophy for both Top Aggregate Score, and Top Aggregate Score for a LKC Junior Member is offered in memory of Siberian Husky, Champion Kee-Tuk-Ka's Kyana. The following point system is NOT part of the official points awarded by the Canadian Kennel Club in the regular competition being held each day, but are being used ONLY to calculate scores to determine the winners of the Aggregate awards: Best Overall 50 points, 1st in class 100 points plus 10 points for every competitor defeated, 2nd in class 75 points plus 10 points for every competitor defeated, 3rd in class 50 points plus 10 points for every competitor defeated, 4th in class 25 points plus 10 points for every competitor defeated. The classes will be judged as part of the regular show, at various times throughout the day. Presentation of the Top Aggregate Score winners will be just prior to Best In Show on Sunday. There will be a charge of \$1.00 to enter each Junior Handling competition, payable at sign up.
