## Important notes for exhibitors:

**THIS IS A SELF-CLEAN SHOW** All exhibitors are expected to clean up after their dogs whether in or outside the event facility, as dictated by City regulations. Cleaning products will be available at ringside. If your dog soils the ring throughout judging, our ring stewards will gladly hold your dog while you clean up. Poop Bags will be available at ringside and at the show/trial secretary table as well as the entrance table near the front door. All exhibitors are also expected to clean up after your dog outside to ensure the grounds are left in proper condition for those who use the arena after our shows and trials have concluded. Failure to comply jeopardizes any dog related events having access to the facility.

**Silicone based products.** Use of these on dog coats is discouraged and they are <u>only</u> to be used when the floor is covered (see below) to prevent the product damaging the floor by being sprayed directly on it. Such products also create serious safety hazards over several days of use. In the past this has required professional cleaning to restore the floor surface after shows. The show sponsoring club does not take responsibility for the cost of such restoration work on the floor surface. **Exhibitors using these products who have not properly covered the floor damaging the floor under their set up area will be required to cover the cost of cleaning following the shows if required by the landlord.** 

Floor covering: Exhibitors may use plastic, paper or material covering on the floor; and secure it with Painter's tape. Duct tape is NOT permitted.

Bring your own chairs if desired for your personal set up area. The club tries to provide a limited number for ringside use by exhibitors. They are to be left there.

**ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS** Please note that fees are payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par". The banks will not clear them. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds.

#### EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering a CKC event requires an Event Registration Number (ERN). The (ERN) does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes but enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. To obtain an (ERN) do the following:

- Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting the current ownership with a written request for an ERN.
- Include payment of \$59.40 in Canadian funds. Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, VISA or Mastercard. For non-members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates
- Provide your full return address
- Faxed requests are accepted. Please ensure you VISA or Mastercard number is legible and you have included your expiry date and signature.

An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30-day extension. ### ENTRY INFORMATION

- ▶ No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.
- > The show/trial secretary is unable to accept or cancel entries after the specified closing date/time.
- Tendering of a NSF cheque as payment of entry fees shall be considered to be a non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.
- Entrants must abide by any errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made except as outlined in the Conformation/Obedience and Rally Show Rules. The show/trial secretary will not be responsible for checking the accuracy of entries. Errors should be brought to the attention of the show/trial secretary.
- Substitution or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving class dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.
- > The show/trial committee reserves the right to refuse entries subject to CKC rules.
- In the case of non-acceptance of an entry, the fee shall be returned with the reason for non-acceptance.
- Telephone, facsimile and e-mail entries are prohibited except in such circumstances as the CKC may otherwise authorize.
- Please use separate entry forms for conformation and obedience. If copying the entry forms, they must be the same size as the original.
- The address section of the entry forms should be completed for every entry to facilitate the speedy mailing of the judging schedule and receipts.
- > If you wish your entry to be acknowledged, please include your email address.
- The entry form must be completed in full. An incomplete entry form must be rejected by the showgiving club and returned to the designated owner or agent.
- Every dog entered in a championship show or trial, except those breeds designated by the board, as being eligible to compete in the miscellaneous class, must be registered or eligible for registration in the studbook of the CKC.
- No dog under the age of six (6) months is permitted within the precincts of the show/trial, except, pre-registered puppies 3-6 months of age that are with the owner who has other dog (s) entered in regular classes of the show/trial. These puppies <u>will not</u> be listed in the catalogue but must be pre-registered by the owner at or before the closing date and time of entries. <u>There is also a Baby Puppy competition at these shows. Baby Puppies must be entered by entry form and will be listed in Catalogue. No listing fee apply to the Baby Puppy entry.</u>
- The authorities of the shows/trials may decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show/trial building on account of viciousness or disease.

### No one shall have any claim or recourse against the organization holding the show/trial or any official connected therewith for the refusal of an entry

### MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the closing date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only" providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the show secretary **<u>in writing</u>** at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. Every day of a 2 or 3 day show is a separate show. Please note that this rule is effective up to one hour prior to the opening of the breed.

Non-Member Participation Fee Effective January 1, 2011

#### Policy: FORMS AVAILABLE AT SHOW SECRETARY'S DESK

a) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.

The fee will match the ERN fee. b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within

30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled.

c) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fees apply only to dogs wholly owned

by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members.

#### Information:

➢ A non-member resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with a CKC member are exempt.

> There are 2 options for non-members:

a) Join the CKC

b) Pay the Non-Member Participation Fee

> Dogs co-owned by two or more individuals; the first person listed in the CKC dog records will be considered the caregiver of the dog and all communication will be sent to this person.

> The fee is a yearly charge based on the calendar year January 01 to December 31 in which the awards, legs, points, titles, etc were achieved. It is not based on the number of dogs or titles or awards earned, and is assessed against the owner(s).

➢ Non members will receive a letter from CKC Head Office informing them that they have 30 days to join the Club or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee.

> Payment of the Non-Member Participation Fee or becoming a CKC member will protect all awards, points, titles and legs in the calendar year in which they were earned.

➤ Failure to pay the fee within 30 days of the notice will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. Once cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog.

➢ Once cancellation takes place, any subsequent awards, titles, legs etc earned will automatically be cancelled without further notice.

➢ The Non-Member Participation Fee is applicable starting at the first event in which the dog earns awards, points, titles, legs and is not prorated. \*\*\*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

- On the day of the show/trial, the show/trial superintendent will be in complete charge of the show/trial which is to be governed by CKC Rules and Regulations
- > Only dogs properly entered in the show/trial will be admitted.
- > The building will be opened 1 (one) hour before the start of the show/trial.
- > Dogs may be removed from the building when not required for further judging.
- > Dogs <u>must not</u> be left in the building overnight.
- Dogs and their handlers should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused from each show when not required for further judging.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitors/handlers to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs is not possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict. Judging will proceed without any dog not present when called by the ring steward.
- The show/trial committee and the Avalon Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and the exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of an accident or other misfortunes to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- There is no security services provided at the venue, therefore, property left at the show/trial grounds is done so at the owner's risk.
- If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show/trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- We regret that trailer hook ups <u>will not</u> be available at the show/trial site. If you wish to enquire of hotels that host dogs, please contact the Show/Trials Secretary for assistance.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation. The Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- The show/trial grounds are defined as the confines of The St. John's Recreation Centre, Buckmaster's Circle, St. John's, NL

#### CHAMPIONSHIP POINT RATINGS

In no case may a dog earn more than 5 (five) points at a single show. In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

#### CONFORMATION

#### Regular official classes at the CKC championship show shall be as described below:

#### Non-Regular Classes at the CKC championship show shall be as described below:

**\*\*Baby Puppy Class** Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered to compete in this class. An entry form and entry fee is required for this class. These competing puppies will be listed with their respective breeds in the catalogue. There is no listing fee applicable for these puppies who do not have their registration #, but if a registration number has been obtained from CKC it must be indicated on the entry form.

**NOTE** Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show/trial may be entered in Exhibition Only, provided that the owner of the puppy has also entered a dog in one of the regular classes in the show/trials on that day (these puppies are not entered in any competition and there is no fee, however an entry form must be provided on the date of closing of the entries). These non-competing puppies will not be listed in the catalogue.

A separate entry form is required for each class in an obedience trial. To facilitate setting up jumps for open and utility, please state the height jumped on each entry form.

A bitch in season <u>may not</u> compete in an obedience trial. Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch comes in season after the entries close when a veterinarian's certificate to this effect is presented to the show/trial secretary prior to the start of the first trial.

Dogs in obedience must wear a well-fitted plain buckle or slip collar. Slip collars of any appropriate single length of leather, fabric or chain with two rings, one at each end are acceptable. There shall be nothing hanging from the collar.

# Avalon Kennel Club - Junior Handling Competition

**Conformation** will be held <u>on Saturday, May 21, 2016</u>. **Obedience** will be held <u>on Sunday,</u> <u>May 22, 2016</u>. Entry forms will be available at the show/trial secretary's desk and must be submitted at least one hour before the start of the junior handling competition. All dogs used for junior handling must be entered in a regular official class (can be exhibition only) at the show or trial on Saturday. The dog must be entered in the show/trial by entry close date May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2016. The scheduled time for the competition will be listed in the Judging Schedule. The fee is \$5.00 for each day of competition.

#### Notice for Junior Handlers:

**Effective January 1, 2016,** in accordance with Junior Handling Rules and Regulation, Junior Handlers will be required to apply to the CKC Head Office for a Junior Handling Number. "Junior Handlers, with the exception of PeeWees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within **30 days** of competing in their first Junior Handling event. The Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."

The application can be mailed, faxed, or e-mailed to CKC Head Office. There is no fee.

It is the responsibility of every exhibitor to be familiar with the CKC rules governing these events. Copies of the Rules and regulations are available online from ckc.ca

It is your responsibility to double-check your entries for accuracy and ensure that all necessary information is provided. Incomplete entries will not be accepted.
