



## **OUR 2013 JUDGING PANEL**



In the late 1960's, Dana Cline's parents gave him his first Great Dane and from that moment he knew that he would have a lifetime of involvement with this breed and with dogs.

As a young child he exhibited in 4H, training in both obedience and conformation. He found the dog show world in his teenage years, spending nearly every weekend traveling to shows, helping professional handlers and handling dogs for friends with other breeds. While his main interest was always in Great Danes, he worked hard to learn about other breeds and to become more active in all breeds. All of his weekends spent at dogs shows eventually led him to a career as a professional handler, where he specialized in Danes and sight hounds, but also handling various other breeds along the way.

Breeding has always been a favorite aspect of this sport for Mr. Cline. He has bred nearly 80 champions in a number of breeds, primarily Great Danes, but also Borzoi, German Wirehaired Pointers, Miniature Bull Terriers and Beagles. He was a long time member of the Great Dane Club of America.

He is licensed to judge the Sporting Group, the Hound Group and the Working Group, and various breeds within four of the other groups. He has judged in a number of foreign countries and at the Great Dane Club of America National Specialty, as well as many of the top shows in the US.

#### MICHAEL GUY RN, MN, BA, Certification Bioethics Brockville, Ontario

Michael parents bred Chow Chows in England. It was at the end of the leash of Chow Chow puppies that Michael learned to handle dogs at age 7. Growing up Michael had the opportunity to learn about other breeds and assisted in their kennels; learning to critique puppies from a breeder's perspective. Activities growing up, in England, Nova Scotia and Ontario Canada, included handling of Golden Retrievers, Samoyeds, Irish Wolfhounds, Yorkshire Terriers, Chihuahuas, Pomeranians, Papillion, Pugs, and, of course, Chow Chows

Michael's first Pekingese was a rescue, followed shortly by Michael co-owning, and whelping, his first litter of Pekingese in 1987. Leahcim Kennels was established in 1989. Michael had owned and bred many Canadian and American champion Pekingese. He received the Canadian Pedigree Breeders' award twice and then received a Register of Merit Breeder award from The Pekingese Club of America in 2006. Michael continues to breed Pekingese.

#### PETER GREEN


Pennsylvania, USA

Born in Neath, Wales, I started showing Welsh and Wire Fox Terriers at the famous kennel of my uncle Mr. Emlyn Snow. At a very early age I decided that dogs and dog shows would become my life's work. I think this was a great choice and I have met some wonderful people, been to more countries than I ever imagined possible, and met many great people who I consider friends.

I immigrated to the US in 1958, was homesick and returned to Wales after attending Westminster in 1960. After having a good handling career in the UK I returned to the US in 1963 to work privately at Pool Forge Kennels. Here my career really took off. In 1967 I set up business in Lancaster County, PA as a public handler. I was fortunate over the years to have clients who allowed me to purchase dogs and help with their breeding programs.

During my career I handled dogs who were lucky enough to win Best In Show at four Westminster Kennel Club shows, six times dog of the year, eight times Best in Shows at Montgomery County Kennel Club. I have handled dogs to win Best in Shows at most of the major dog shows in the United States. I am honored to be one of only two people to win Best in Show at both Cruft's and Westminster.

Since 1976 I have judged dog shows at the highest level throughout the world. I am now an AKC approved judge. Since that time I have judged many times at British Championship Shows and am approved to award challenge certificates in 28 breeds. I have judged in Australia, Ireland, Denmark, Sweden, Finland, Holland, Italy, Germany, Estonia, China, Mexico, and South Africa. In



2009 I judged BIS at the famous Cruft's Dog Show, the Terrier Group at Westminster, and Best in Show at Montgomery County Kennel Club.

#### DR. ROBERT INDEGLIA

#### Rhode Island, USA

Robert Indeglia is a native New Englander, born and raised in Rhode Island. Schooling included Johns Hopkins University and Georgetown Medical School, with further training in surgery and cardiovascular surgery at the University of Minnesota during the infancy of cardiac surgery, where he also received a PhD in surgery and biomedical engineering. He is currently emeritus at the Miriam Hospital, a major Brown University teaching institution, and is serving as Medical Director of the Wound Care Center. Although he is now less active clinically, he served as chief of cardiac surgery and led one of the most active cardiovascular and thoracic surgery practices in New England. He also served as chief of cardiovascular and thoracic surgery at several private hospitals in Providence. In addition, he served as President of the Rhode Island Heart Association and member of the New England Council of the American Heart Association.

His activities in purebred dogs began in early childhood with his parents' involvement with Cocker Spaniels in the 1930's and 40's. He became involved with Norwegian Elkhounds in 1960 and over the next 37 years bred 40 litters and has shown over 50 champions. He has been active in the Elkhound parent club and served on its board as well as President and AKC delegate in the 1970s and 1980s. He was Chairman of the first standard revision committee in 1972. He bred two boxer litters in the 1960s and has shown and owned Irish Setters, Golden Retrievers and Labrador Retrievers. His wife, Mary, is a Whippet enthusiast, who currently has three group winning Whippets, two of whom are at home decorating their couches and soft chairs, as well as an ever present Yorkie, a Labrador Retriever and two Elkhounds.

He began judging Elkhounds in 1971 and is currently licensed to judge the Sporting, Hound, Working and Non-Sporting Groups and 10 Herding breeds. He has judged the Hound (twice) and Non-Sporting Groups at Westminster KC and reached the pinnacle of judging by doing Best in Show in 2007. He judged the Canadian National in the '80s in Calgary and has judged outside the United States many times. He currently is a member of the new Judge's Review Committee of the AKC and is president of the Providence County Kennel Club. His outside interests include golf, every chance he gets, as well as following all major sports. He has been a season ticket holder for the Boston Bruins hockey team and The New England Patriots football team, but his Achilles heal (except recently) has been the yearly trail of disappointment of the classic Boston Red Sox fanatic.

#### GAEL MORISON

South Africa

My parents were both judges, breeding and exhibiting Rough Collies under the "Clan Campbell" prefix.

A fellow Collie exhibitor showed one of the first Afghans in South Africa. I had a typical "doggy" childhood and was exposed to all facets of dogdom, especially Afghans from an early age. I was fascinated (and still am) by these exotic Hounds. My fate was sealed-I had to own an Afghan. I purchased my first Afghan in 1973 and our "Atlantis" prefix was registered with the Kennel Union of Southern Africa in 1976. Shetland Sheepdogs joined our kennel in 1994.

I first judged Afghans at Championship show level in 1980; my first Championship Hound Group appointment in 1982, and I finally achieved All Breeds status in 1994.

I have judged extensively in Australia and Brazil. I have also judged in Finland, Norway, Austria, the U.K., Indonesia, the Philippines, Chile, Colombia, New Zealand, France, Canada, India and Russia.

I judged Siberians, Ridgebacks, Shar Peis and Chihuahuas at the FCI World Show in Poland in November 2006. In 2009 I judged at the fabulous Golden Collar Dog Show in Moscow; the prize for the Show Champion was a Ford Focus. The group judges were drawn out a hat, so I was very fortunate to draw Hounds and Herding. There was outstanding quality in Borzois and this ensured that a Borzoi made its way into the finals. In 2010 I judged Rhodesian Ridgebacks at the RKF International Eurasia Show. I have represented Kwa Zulu Natal on the South African National Breed Judges Sub Committee. ## NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION

FEE

Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$58.50 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a c) choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents d) of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

#### From Toronto (via 401 and no toll roads):

## ALL SPECIALTY CONFORMATION CLASSES – BOTH SEXES

#### **OFFICIAL CLASSES** (ALL SPECIALTIES)

Baby Puppy – a dog between 3 months and under 6 months on day of show. Baby Puppies do not compete for points.

Junior Puppy - a dog between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.

Senior Puppy – a dog between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.

12 – 15 Months – a dog between 12 months and under 15 months on day of show.

15 – 18 Months – a dog between 15 months and under 18 months on day of show.

Canadian Bred – a dog which is born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

**Bred By Exhibitor** – dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/ co-owner <u>and</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The breeder/owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

Open Class – for all dogs.

Veterans – for all dogs over seven years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs to compete for the regular placements and the 1st place Dog and Bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only - dogs who are Canadian Champions only.

Award of Merit – At the judge's discretion, Awards of Merit may be awarded up to one Award for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. Rosettes will be given for the Awards of Merit which will be presented following Best of Breed.

#### SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Limited to dogs and bitches over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinarian procedure.

#### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES**

Exhibition Only – all dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades.

**Brace:** Two dogs of same breed (not necessarily of the same sex) and must be handled by one person on one lead. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

Stud Dog & Get: Entry comprises the Stud Dog and two or more of his Get, ownership in this class need not be identical. Stud Dog may be neutered.

**Brood Bitch & Progeny:** Entry comprises the Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny, ownership in this class need not be identical. Brood Bitch may be spayed.

Each entrant for Brace, Stud Dog, or Brood Bitch must be entered in one of the Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only. All Get and Progeny must be entered in an Official Class.

#### UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

**Parade of Champions, Titleholders or Veterans**: Champion dogs must have completed all requirements for Championship status. Titleholders must have titles recognized by the CKC and AKC. Veteran dogs must be over seven years of age as of the date of the show. Spayed & neutered dogs or dogs in unorthodox trim may be entered.

Field Trial Class: Shall be for dogs having Canadian WC or better (WCI, WCX) title, a CKC licensed Field Trial placement in an official class or a Junior Hunter (JH). Dogs must be at least 6 months of age or older and eligible for registration. Each entrant for Field Trial Class must be entered in one of Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only.

Obedience Trial Class: for dogs and bitches who have earned at least a C.D. degree.

Each entrant for these Unofficial Classes must be entered in one of Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only. Dogs entered in Obedience cannot be used as part of these classes.

#### LES MORISON

South Africa

I was born in Aberdeen, Scotland and in 1950 we moved to Northern Rhodesia (Zambia). I started showing Pyrenean Mountain Dogs in Rhodesia (Zimbabwe) in 1970, and then moved to South Africa in 1974.

I qualified to judge the Working and Herding Groups in 1978 and completed my first appointment in 1979. I was placed on the KUSA panel for Hounds in 1989, Terriers in 2006 and Gundogs in 2009. I have judged in Zimbabwe, Zambia, Norway, the United Kingdom, Canada, New Zealand and Australia.

I have judged huge entries of hounds in different states of Australia, and in 2009 judged Afghans at the Bath Championship Show in the United Kingdom. I have also judged Ridgebacks in Austria and Russia.

In 1968 my children decided that the Shepherd was too big for doll clothes, so they wanted a smaller dog. On our 10th anniversary we purchased a West Highland White Terrier. The following October we drove 350 miles to Rapid City, South Dakota with our six month old puppy to exhibit at our first AKC point show.

My wife and I joined Greeley Kennel Club two weeks after we bought our first Westie. I was elected President of GKC in 1971 and served as president on five occasions for a total of 21 years. In 1982 I was elected to the Board of Directors of the West Highland White Terrier Club of America and served two 3-year terms. 



Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disgualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge

**SHALL NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.8 A Dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show. Number of Breeds

Section 15.1.11 A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

#### MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. Every day of a 2 or 3 day show is a separate show. Please note that this rule is effective up to one hour prior to the opening of the show, NOT one hour prior to the judging of the breed.

#### CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Chapter 4 - Section 4.1.3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
