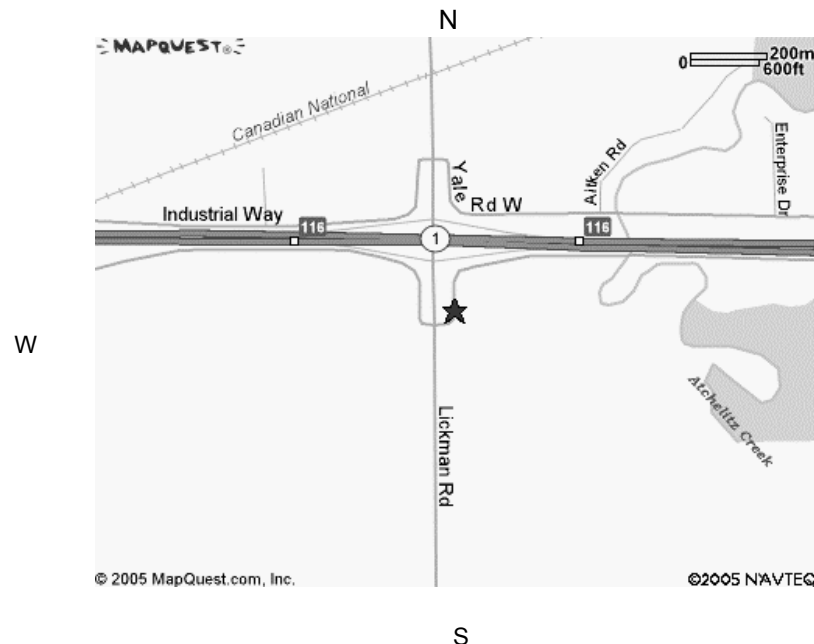

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

DOGS COMPETING*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
POINTS AWARDED	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

JUNIOR HANDLING - Sunday April 20, 2014

JUDGE: Ms. Katherine Stead

TIME: following the judging of the regular classes

Entry Fee: \$2.00

Registration will take place at the Specialty ring for 60 to 90 min. and will close ONE HOUR PRIOR to the competition.

Open to all Juniors 7 years of age and up to but not including 18 years of age as of the date of this competition. The Doberman Pinscher handled by the Junior must be entered in the Specialty in an Official class OR for Exhibition Only. The dog used need **NOT** be owned by the Junior Handler or any member of his/her family

CLASSES WILL BE DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Junior Novice - 7 to 10 Years, Junior Open 7 to 10 years,
Intermediate Novice - 11 to 14 Years, Intermediate Open - 11 to 14 Years
Senior Novice - 15 to BUT NOT INCLUDING 18 Years,
Senior Open - 15 to BUT NOT INCLUDING 18 years.

A rosette will be offered for 1st through 4th in each class and a rosette and prize will be offered for Best Overall.

Please note: There will be NO Pee Wee class offered with this Specialty

Juvenile Sweepstakes

Sweepstakes is open to all dogs six months and under eighteen months on the day of this Specialty. All dogs must be entered in a regular class in the Specialty to compete in sweepstakes. Classes are divided by sex, as follows:

Junior Puppy - open to puppies 6 months and under 9 months
Senior Puppy - open to puppies 9 months and under 12 months
12-18 Month - open to dogs 12 months and under 18 months

Junior Puppy class winners will compete for Best Junior Puppy; Senior Puppy class winners will compete for Best Senior Puppy; 12-18 Month class winners will compete for Best Intermediate. These three winners will compete for Grand Prize Sweepstakes.

Sweepstakes Prizes

Twenty-five (25%) of the total entry fees will be retained by the host club to defray costs. The remaining seventy-five (75%) will be divided as follows:

All 1 st in Class winners (6 classes).....	10%
Best Opposite in Sweepstakes.....	5%
Best In Sweepstakes	10%

In addition, rosettes will be awarded for all placements.

Trophy List

A prize and/or rosette will also be offered for first in class

The Specialty winner will also be awarded the "**Troll Arabesque/Vintage Year Memorial Trophy**", which is offered each year by The Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada. This is a perpetual trophy and the winner's name will be inscribed on the plaque. The Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada will retain this trophy. The High in Trial winner will also be awarded the DPCC High in Trial Obedience Trophy. This is a perpetual trophy and the winner's name will be inscribed on the plaque. The Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada will retain this trophy. The DPCC offers a keeper trophy for Best of Breed and High in Trial. Prizes and/or rosettes will be offered for first in class for all regular and non regular obedience and rally classes

Rosettes ONLY will be awarded for all Transition Obedience Classes

Conformation Classifications

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog **6 months of age and under 9 months of age** on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog **9 months of age and under 12 months of age** on the day of the show

12 TO 18 MONTHS: Shall be for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Specialty.

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada.

(Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs (Note: ***divided by colour***)

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog, which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. **Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded**

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class **MAY NOT COMPETE** in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

Sweepstakes is open to all dogs 7 years and older on the day of this Specialty. All dogs must be entered in a regular class in the Specialty to compete in sweepstakes. Classes are divided by sex and age, as follows:

7 -10 years

10 years & older

Sweepstakes Prizes

Twenty-five (25%) of the total entry fees will be retained by the host club to defray costs. The remaining seventy-five (75%) will be divided as follows:

All 1 st in Class winners (4 classes).....	10%

Rally Obedience Classifications:

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & NOVICE "B" AT THE SAME TRIAL

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & OPEN "B" AT THE SAME TRIAL

RALLY NOVICE A: Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R. N.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY NOVICE B: Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY ADVANCED A: This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY ADVANCED B: This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT A: This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R. E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY EXCELLENT B: This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash except the Honour Exercise. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

Additional Conformation classifications

The following additional regular/non-regular CKC classes (divided by variety/sex) will be offered at this Specialty:

REGULAR CLASSES

VETERANS CLASS: Shall be for all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veteran Male and Female classes will NOT compete for Championship points but goes directly into the Best of Breed competition.

SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR COMPETITION IN THIS CLASS.

NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

Note: Any dog entered in a Unofficial/Non-Regular class **MUST** also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only.

SIRE & GET: Shall be for Sire and three maximum of his Get.

BROOD MATRON & PROGENY: Shall be for Dam and three maximum of her Progeny.

BRACE CLASS: Shall be for two dogs (not necessarily the same sex), identical ownership is NO LONGER required

PARADE OF VETERANS: Shall be for all dogs that are at least 7 years of age on the day of this Specialty. All participants in Parades **MUST** be entered also in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only. *Spayed or neutered dogs are invited to participate **BUT MUST** be entered in the official Veterans Class (conformation) or for Exhibition Only. (Please provide a written resume of your dog (75 words) with your entry.*

PARADE OF TITLEHOLDERS: Shall be for all dogs that hold either a championship or obedience title in Canada. All participants in Parades **MUST** be entered also in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only (Please provide a written resume of your dog (75 words) with your entry.

PARADE OF RESCUE: Shall be for all dogs that have been rescued by a recognized rescue organization. This is a non-competitive class. All participants *must* be entered in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only. **Note:** Spayed or neutered dogs are invited to participate but must be entered in the official Altered Class (conformation) or for Exhibition Only. *Please provide a written resume of your dog (approximately 75 words or less) with your entry.*

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

(Available at Specialties ONLY)

Eligibility for the Altered classes shall be limited to dogs over six months of age, which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed.

Two classes ONLY will be offered:

Altered Male and Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed.

Obedience Classifications noted on following page

Obedience Classifications

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & NOVICE "B" AT THE SAME TRIAL

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & OPEN "B" AT THE SAME TRIAL

NOVICE "A" - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD" in ANY COUNTRY. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER** or **A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY** and **MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES.** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but **MUST COMPETE IN NOVICE "B" CLASS**

NOVICE "B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have not earned the title of "CD", and may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class

OPEN "A" - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER** or **A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY** and **MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES.** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but **MUST COMPETE IN THE OPEN "B" CLASS.** A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

OPEN "B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog **MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS.** A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

UTILITY "A" - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of UD. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCH title may not handle dogs in this class. This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry format time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

UTILITY "B" - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned a title of "CDX" or "UD". Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry from at the time of closing to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approximately 30 minutes prior to the start of class.

NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES

ALL DOGS ENTERED IN A NON-REGULAR CLASS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY ON THE SAME DAY.

BRACE CLASS - This class is open to any two dogs of the same breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. The same person need not own both dogs.

TEAM CLASS - This class is open to any four dogs of the same breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. The same person need not own all four dogs.

VETERANS CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years old prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the "Novice Class".

DOGS ENTERED IN THE VETERANS CLASS MAY NOT BE ENTERED IN ANY REGULAR CLASS, BUT MUST BE ENTERED FOR EXHIBITION ONLY.

Transition Obedience Classes

PRE-NOVICE - This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE "C" - This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial. The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice 'C' are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice - Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice 'C' and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Due to the anticipated large entry, the club is reserving a portion of the building for pre-assigned grooming spaces. Those exhibitors who are LISTED as EITHER THE OWNER OR THE HANDLER/AGENT on 6 or more dogs, or who are co-ordinating a group of individuals setting up together, may request that an area be reserved for them. Once the allotted area has been filled, all further requests will be returned as will any requests received after the close of entries. Requests will be acknowledged via email after the closing date and prior to the beginning of the show.

Please note: Exercise pens may be restricted to 1 pen per 3 entered dogs, depending on the size of the entry.

In addition to the pre-assigned areas, there will also be regular first come, first served grooming space in which equipment/dogs may be left for the duration of the shows. Ex-pens are permitted in this area.

There will also be an area that will be set aside for Day of Show grooming - this will be first come, first served and all equipment MUST BE REMOVED after Best in Show each night. There will be NO exercise pens allowed in this area. Any equipment left after Best In Show will be removed by the club or one of it's delegates.

Grooming areas will be monitored by the club and delegated individuals - and exhibitors who do not keep their areas clean, or abuse the space allotted may be asked to leave the show.
