- 2. If entering the same dog in conformation, obedience or exhibition only please use a separate entry form for

- 4. Exhibitors must abide by the errors made when making the entry, regardless how or who made the entry.
- 5. An entry will not be accepted unless accompanied by the required fees.
- **6.** The CBKC Club reserves the right to reject any entry subject to CKC rules.
- 7. Only dogs, which are eligible for registration or are registered by the CKC, may be entered in these Trials.
- 8. Overpayment of entry fees up to a maximum of \$5.00 will be considered a donation to CDC Trophy Fund.
- 9. The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Dog Show Rules of the CKC.
- 10. There will be no prong or spike collars permitted at this venue.

Rally Obedience Trial Move Up A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has fulfilled the requirements for a title, in accordance with Section 9.4.2 and 10.4.2 of the Rally Obedience Rules, may be moved to the next level of Rally Obedience competition providing the transfer was submitted to the Trial secretary, IN WRITING by the owner or handler, one hour prior to the opening of the first trial, trial schedule permitting.

GENERAL INFORMATION

THE PRECINCTS OF THE TRIAL WILL BE THE MAIN ARENA AREA.

The ring is 40x50 **FULLY MATTED**

The Trial Judging will start at 4:00pm Unless entries warrant an earlier start. Judging schedule and identification will be mailed/emailed as soon as possible after the entry closing date. The CBKC will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons. Judging will not be delayed to accommodate an exhibitor or handler who fails to have his/her dog in the ring when required. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the trials. Only dogs entered in the trial are permitted within the trial precincts please.

CLASSES

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. More information, and application forms can be downloaded from the CKC website: http://www.ckc.ca.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - Effective January 1, 2023

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) number will be eligible to apply for a TCN.

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) from the Canadian Kennel Club. **Effective** January 1, 2023, the policy has been changed to allow Listed Breeds registered with a different Canadian registry to also apply for an ERN. Canadian Born dogs that are registrable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an ERN.

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN. Include full payment in the amount of \$62.40 plus tax. Accounts may be paid with a personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates. Provide us with your full return address. - Faxed requests will be accepted. Please include your VISA/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30-day extension.
