**Event Registration Number (ERN) Notice** 

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to the CKC. ## **CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (\*Includes the dog awarded Winners.) Dogs Competing\* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more Points Allocated\* 0 1 2 3 4 5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12 {C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level."

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed hereunder.

A class Dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show. To earn a Canadian Championship, a dog must earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and be individually registered with the Canadian Kennel Club, or have a CKC EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN).

<u>Grand Champion (GCh)</u> The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Conformation Championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Conformation Championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Conformation Championship. All required points are to be earned at the breed level. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points which must include one Best of Breed and a minimum of two wins of at least two points each. a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed Winner and the number of similar sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013. Points earned toward the Grand Champion title are to be recorded by the owner/handler on the form obtained from the Canadian Kennel Club. Once the owner/handler believes that their exhibit has attained the requirements for the Grand Champion title, the form may be submitted to the Canadian Kennel Club for verification and awarding of the title.

<u>Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx)</u> The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship title.

# **CONFORMATION** The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

## REGULAR CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

12-18 MONTH CLASS - for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

**OPEN CLASS** - shall be for all Dogs.

**SPECIALS ONLY** - A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

**VETERAN-** Dogs must be 7 years or older on the day of the show. Classes of 3 separate age groups per sex will be offered: 7 year to under 9 years day of show, 9 years to under 12 years day of show and 12 years plus. Class winners will be included in Best of Breed judging. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

# NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL

**BABY PUPPY:** 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show

**GUN DOG** : for any dog of either sex that has attained at least one leg on any CKC or AKC recognized hunting title or an ESSFTA Working Dog (WD or WDX) title by the close of entries. May be spayed or neutered.

**BRACE-** This class shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead

**STUD DOG & GET** -shall be comprised of the stud dog and 2 or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud dog may be spayed/neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class.

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY- This class shall have the same requirements as Stud dog and get

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes

**GENERATION** - Consists of three or more dogs in a three or more generation DIRECT line (i.e., Mother or Father with son or daughter and grandson or granddaughter or great grandson or great granddaughter). These dogs are shown together (handled separately). To be judged on similarity of type (similar to stud dog or brood bitch). Dogs may be spayed/neutered and breeder(s) owner(s) need not be identical. Each dog must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only



A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online, by fax or post using a credit card or interac for payment.

### OBEDIENCE REGULAR CLASSES

**NOVICE A** - The Novice A Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families, and must be eligible to handle under section No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a C.D.X. title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

**NOVICE B** - The Novice B Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and at any one trial.

**NOVICE C** - The Novice C Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title C.D., C.D.X., U.D. or any Obedience Trial Championship Title prior to the losing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. PRE-NOVICE -The Pre-Novice Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Novice Classes. The Pre-Novice Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of P.C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 5 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercise. Only dogs that have not earned the title of C.D. may enter the Pre-Novice class.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - The Novice Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter the Open Classes. Novice Intermediate Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any Obedience Trial Championship. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises.

**OPEN A** - The Open A Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. . The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class. A dog which has earned its C.D.X. title is not eligible for entry in this class but may be entered in the Open B Class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

**OPEN B** - The Open B Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. must enter in the Open B Class. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such case, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Open A and Open B classes at any one trial. A dog eligible for entry in the Utility Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Open Class B at the same trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ring side, approximately 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six orders of exercises so that each set will be used approximately the same number of times.

**UTILITY A** - The Utility A Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D.X. but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

**UTILITY B** - The Utility B Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at the ring side, approximately 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six orders of exercises so that each will be used approximately the same number of times.

### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES**

**VETERAN:** shall be for dogs that have an obedience title and are seven (7) years old or older on the day of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class.

**BRACE:** Open to any 2 dogs either sex, which have attained not less than a CD title in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person owns both dogs. Exercises same as Novice.

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the nonmember participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

### EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

### JUDGES - SECTION 4.1.3

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively carried out.

### SHOW OFFICIALS - SECTION 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

### **ENTRY FORMS - SECTION 8.2.3**

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

### **ENTRY FORMS - SECTION 8.2.5**

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

### **ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1**

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

a. registered with the CKC

b. have an Event Registration Number

c. eligible for registration with the CKC, or

d. if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous

### Certification Number (MCN)

### **REFUSAL OF ENTRIES - SECTION 8.6.2**

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

### **DISQUALIFICATIONS - SECTION 14.1.4**

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

### **RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS**

1. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON FROM THE SHOW. THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT SHALL HAVE FULL CONTROL OF THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS, WHICH WILL BE GOVERNED BY CKC RULES.

2. A DOG EXCUSED BY THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT OR VETERINARIAN FOR ANY REASON SHALL NOT, COMPETE IN ANY

CLASS FOR ANY AWARDS FOR BALANCE OF THE SHOW.
