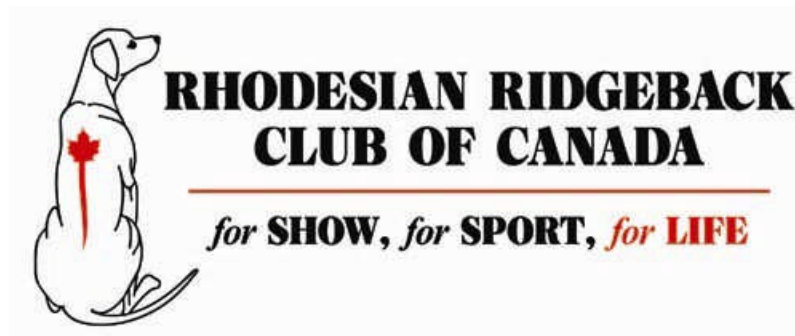

**REGULAR
CLASSES**

The following CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Junior Puppy for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age
Senior Puppy for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age
12 – 18 months for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age

Canadian Bred for dogs born in Canada; Champions in any country excluded

Bred by Exhibitor for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

Veteran for any dog, 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. These dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. **DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED.**

Specials Only for any dog who is a Canadian Champion. A CKC Registration or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing. The entry of a "Listed" dog in Specials Only is not allowed.

Exhibition Only dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular Class, but may enter and compete in Non-Regular Classes and/or Parades, if provided for in this Premium List.

Exhibition Only puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only, **3-6 Months** 3-6 Months Regular provided the owner(s) have entered a dog in an Official Class. These puppies may not participate in any Regular, Non-Regular or Unofficial Classes or Parades.

Altered Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered by Veterinary procedure. Classes divided by sex only.

**NON-REGULAR
CLASSES**

All dogs must be entered in the Regular Classes, Veterans Class, Specials Only or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following Non-Regular Classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

Sweepstakes

Juvenile To compete in Juvenile Sweepstakes Class, dogs must be entered in a Regular Class or for Specials Only. Entry in Juvenile Sweepstakes from the Exhibition Only Class is not allowed.

Classes will be divided by age only as follows:

6-9 months 9-12 months 12-18 months

Veteran Classes will be divided by age only as follows:

7-9 years 9-11 years 11 years and older

SWEEPSTAKES PRIZES: (PUPPY AND VETERAN)

All sweepstake prize money is allocated by percentage within each class.

Prize money is dependent on the entries within each class and paid as follows:

Best In Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes will divide 5% equally

First Place in each class 25% and rosette

Second Place in each class 20% and rosette

Third Place in each class 15% and rosette

Fourth Place in each class 10% and rosette

Balance of 25% will be retained by the club to defray costs.

Brace Two dogs of one breed (either sex or mixed) not necessarily owned by the same owner, shown by one handler on one lead.

**Stud Dog
And Get** Stud Dog and 2 or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

**Brood Bitch
and Progeny** Brood Bitch and 2 or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

PARADE OF VETERANS Dogs must be 7 years of age or older (not necessarily champions). Dogs must be entered in a Regular Class or for Exhibition Only.

JUNIOR HANDLER Judge: TBA Time: TBA

Following Specialty Classes. All Juniors should register with the Show Secretary one hour before competition. Competition will be before the Best Ridge contest. **Flats for 1st – 4th in each Class** and a **Rosette and a Prize** for Best Junior Handler overall. All Juniors must show a Rhodesian Ridgeback.

BEST RIDGE To start after the RRCC BISS and Junior Handling is completed. Please register on the day of the show. Fee for entry is \$10.00 **Prize and Rosette** awarded for Best Overall Ridge, Best Ridge Male and Best Ridge Female. Best Ridge is open to all Ridgebacks. You do not need to be entered in Regular Classes.

**GENERAL
INFORMATION**

Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club.

The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules. All Rules and Regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club Premium List, will also apply to this Specialty.

Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving Club to see that a Judge, Club Official, Volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities – CKC Rule Book, Section 19.7

Please Note: An Exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the Premium List. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show. Cheques post-dated up until closing date of entries will be accepted. Cheques dated after close of entries will not be accepted. Returned cheques and declined credit cards will be assessed a \$25.00 service charge (Chapter 8.8, CKC Dog Show Rules).

Please do not send entries by Registered Mail. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date. **Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.**

Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of Entry Fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his/her dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

There will be no refunds on overpayments or duplicate entries.

**CHAMPIONS &
CHAMPIONSHIP
POINTS**

Section 1 A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under the Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points be accredited to a dog awarded Winners shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated:	0	1	2	3	4	5

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, Dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded Winners also places in the GROUP as listed below:

No. of Breeds	1 st	2 nd	3 rd	4 th
13 or more	5	4	3	2
10-12	4	3	2	1
6-9	3	2	1	1

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and it's owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must:

- (a) Earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges, and
- (b) Be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number.
- (c) Have earned at least one (1) 2 point win either at the breed or group level

**BEST PUPPY
IN BREED**

Where a dog awarded Best of Breed is not a puppy, those puppies which have not been defeated either directly or indirectly by another puppy in the breed will compete for this award. Judging follows the award for Best of Breed. A puppy awarded Best Puppy in Breed is NOT required to stay to compete for Best Puppy in Group.

**MOVING CLASS
DOGS TO
SPECIALS**

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing of entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of the Dog Show Rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

Effective January, 1994: If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration BEFORE the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes as a LISTED dog. Listing fees, however, WILL NOT be refunded. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Rule (8.2.5) EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG SHOWS, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS. BOOKLETS ON DOG SHOW, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIAL RULES ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE C.K.C. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and it's owner provided with a **Championship Certificate**, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges and
- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number
- (c) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level

**U.S.
EXHIBITORS**

**FOREIGN
EXHIBITORS**

Effective January 1992, all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC Registration Number but will require an ERN – Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dogs foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholders name and signature) to the CKC. Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$57.75 + GST (5%).** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING AN EVENT.
