General Information

- 1. Location of the Superdog Spectrum is Bay 7, 510 77th Avenue SE Calgary, AB. This is a new location for this facility and parking will be available on the North and West side of the building. The entrance for the show will be on the North side of the building as well.
- 2. NOTE: WITH THE FARMER'S MARKET MOVING INTO THIS AREA EARLIER THIS YEAR, PARKING COULD BE SOMEWHAT LIMITED.
- 3. The show building will be open one hour prior to commencement of judging. Judging starts at **9:00 am.** If you attend the matches on the Saturday night, you will be able to leave your equipment in the building overnight.
- 4. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES. If not in competition, the dog must wear a collar and be on a leash a maximum length of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.
- 5. Benching will take place in the back day care area. There will be NO benching at ringside.
- 6. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: CKC Dog Show Rules (Chapter 3, Section 3.6.1) "A judge officiating at a trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the process of the show". It shall be the duty and the obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
- 7. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how, or by whom, the entry was made.
- 8. The Show Precincts are defined as "SUPERDOG SPECTRUM".
- 9. Dogs must be exercised in designated areas ONLY.
- 10. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
- 11. Cal K 9 Obedience Club of Calgary, its members and volunteers will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, BUT will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 12. The Trial Superintendent has the authority to expel any dogs deemed to be a danger to other dogs or people. There will be no refund for dogs that are expelled.
- 13. Indoor Shoes: The Superdog Spectrum has asked us to remind everyone entered in the trial, to bring indoor shoes, as it is most likely the weather will be wet.
