The Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (20.7)

A judge officiating at a trial under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (3.6.1)

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. If entering the same dog in conformation, obedience or exhibition only please use a separate entry form for each class.
2. An **INCOMPLETE ENTRY FORM WILL BE RETURNED.** Please ensure that your postal code is included.
4. Exhibitors must abide by the errors made when making the entry, regardless how or who made the entry.
5. An entry will not be accepted unless accompanied by the required fees.
6. The Cobequid Dog Club reserves the right to reject any entry subject to CKC rules.
7. Only dogs, which are eligible for registration or are registered by the CKC, may be entered in these Show & Trials.
8. Overpayment of entry fees up to a maximum of \$5.00 will be considered a donation to CDC Trophy Fund.
9. The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Dog Show Rules of the CKC.
10. **There will be no prong or spike collars permitted at this venue.**
11. Obedience & Rally Trial – Move Up A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has fulfilled the requirements for a title, in accordance with Section 6.9.1 of the Obedience Rules, may be moved to the next level of Obedience & Rally competition providing the transfer was submitted to the Trial secretary, **IN WRITING** by the owner or handler, thirty minutes prior to the opening of the first trial, trial schedule permitting.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - * Effective March 2, 2020

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN number simply does the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, cardholders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

GENERAL INFORMATION

THE PRECINCTS OF THE TRIAL WILL BE THE SHOW BUILDING AND ENTRANCE. The show premises will be **opening at 7:30 am each day. The Trial Judging will start at 9:00am** unless entries warrant an earlier start. Judging schedule and identification will be emailed as soon as possible after the entry closing date. The Cobequid Dog Club will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons. Judging will not be delayed to accommodate an exhibitor or handler who fails to have his/her dog in the ring when required. The Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the trials. Exercise pens will be restricted at the discretion of the Trial Superintendent. **Only dogs entered in the show are permitted within the show precincts please.** If because of; an act of God, riot, civil disturbance, extreme weather event, governmental orders, regulations, or decree, or other acts or circumstances beyond the control of the CDC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.

CLASSES

OBEDIENCE TRIAL OFFICIAL CLASSES: The following CKC official classes will be provided: Novice A, Novice B, Open A (H & 18), Open B (H & 18), Utility A, Utility B, Pre-Novice, Novice C, Novice Intermediate.

Please ensure Obedience jump heights are indicated on entry form for Open & Utility.

RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIAL OFFICIAL CLASSES: The following CKC official classes will be provided: Novice A, Novice B, Intermediate, Advanced A, Advanced B, Excellent A, Excellent B Master

Please ensure Rally jump heights are indicated on entry form for Advanced & Excellent.

EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG SHOWS, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS. BOOKLETS ON DOG SHOW, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIAL RULES ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE C.K.C. or on the C.K.C. website

Exhibitors entering both Obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. IMPORTANT REMINDER:

All exhibitors will be responsible for the clean up of their own dogs or dogs they are handling anywhere on the show site and surrounding areas.

The Cobequid Dog Club acknowledges that the NS Government is lifting all COVID restrictions. During the COVID Pandemic, the Cobequid Dog Club has always strived to provide a safe & secure environment for exhibitors (both human & canine), judges & volunteers. To continue in this way we are asking that you continue to properly wear your mask (covering your nose & mouth) during all Walk-Throughs & at all times within the building when Social Distancing cannot be maintained.

Cobequid Dog Club – COVID-19 Protocols

Competitor Trial Checklist (beyond the Usual)

- Face Mask - all Competitors must provide, & use, their own
- Hand Sanitizer

Prior to the Trial

- Socialize dog to people in Face Mask & the scent of Hand Sanitizer
- All entries are to be done electronically, as much as possible.

Upon Arrival at the Trial

- No more than 2 competitors will be allowed inside the Lobby at a time.
- In the Lobby area, the Show Secretary will be masked, may be gloved & will be behind a barrier
- Scheduling will be done to ensure that there will be no more than the government-mandated limit number of people on the show site at any time. To that end, there should only be **one person per dog on site**. Please inform us if you would like to have a spectator with you or your run recorded.
- Competitors have the option of receiving either an electronic or hard copy of their scoresheet - please inform the Trial Secretary when you arrive at the event which you would prefer and provide an email.
- While on-site, Competitors will remain in & work out of their vehicles; limited indoor crating will be available for exhibitors just prior to their class times.
- Hand Sanitizer is to be used on entering & exiting the building in addition to when necessary, on the show site.

Within the Building

- There will be multiple hand sanitizer stations on-site. Although hand washing is preferable, hand sanitizer can be used if hands are not visually dirty. Hand sanitizer will be at the entrance to the building and at the ring table. It will be

expected that whenever entering or exiting the building, people will hand sanitize as per facility protocols.

When entering the ring

1. The stewards may be masked.
2. The judge may be masked.
3. Any judges briefing will be done with social distancing enforced.
4. For Walk-throughs in Rally, competitors will be required to wear a face mask as social distancing cannot be guaranteed. It must be worn properly covering both nose and mouth. Walk-throughs may also be split depending on class size. If split, the order will be based on ring order.
5. You will be placing your leash and dumbbell on a table beside the ring.
6. For Open and CDX competitors, you will be responsible for getting your dumbbell during your time in the ring. We have asked judges to keep dumbbell exercises sequentially.
7. When leaving the ring, please be aware of the next exhibitor & maintain social distancing.

Prizes, Awards & Announcements

- There will be a private Facebook page where scores will be posted as soon as they are available & other announcements will be made.

This is a self-clean show. Please pick up after your dog! Poop bags and Garbage cans will be provided.

Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their class (allowing for absentees). The club requests that the competitor vacate the trial grounds when the class is complete and awards are presented. Competitors can opt to leave as soon as finished if they prefer. If they earned a monetary award, it may be eTransferred to them. Ribbons will not be mailed out.

Masks **should** be worn correctly when social distancing cannot be maintained. This will be at a minimum during walk-throughs and potentially during ribbon presentation. All participants are to provide their own face masks, the Cobequid Dog Club **will not** have masks available for participants.

The Cobequid Dog Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and participants, but will not be responsible, or assume liability, in the event of an accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs or participants

Anyone who is not following the Covid 19 protocols as laid out, and is unwilling to follow those rules, even after being reminded, can be asked to leave the premises without refund. The Cobequid Dog Club is trying to be responsible and ensure individuals' safety and those risking others health will not be tolerated.
