WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

An Exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, however written or e-mail notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

DAY-OF-TRIAL ENTRIES

Day-of-trial entries will be accepted both February 12 and 13, 2022 if limit not reached. Entries must be made at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial. Day-of-trial entries will be cash only.

BENCHING

Limited Benching Only – Reserved spots for multiple dog competitors are crates only and must be reserved/approved. Sign up by emailing slmogenson@sasktel.net after entries close. No ex-pens allowed.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- ◆ The scoop-up requirements will be strictly enforced.
- ◆ There will be **NO "In Transit"** area provided. No dog will be allowed in the building unless entered in the Trials.
- ◆ There will be no "overnight" kenneling.
- ◆ Only approved CKC collars will be allowed in the precincts of the trials.
- ◆ SHOWING correct information on the entry form is the responsibility of the entrant. However, Exhibitors incorrectly entered in the "A" class are permitted to move the dog to the corresponding "B" class up to 30 minutes before the start of the trial. The SKOC takes no responsibility for omissions or errors made on the entry forms. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to the CKC rules.
- ◆ BITCHES IN SEASON: Obedience entry fees WILL be gladly refunded to exhibitors whose females are in season during the trials (and must be withdrawn) IF: a dated veterinarian's certificate is produced prior to the trial.
- ◆ THE PRECINCTS of these trials shall be the Manhattan Ballroom building & grounds.
- ◆ KNOWLEDGE of the Canadian Kennel Club Rules is the responsibility of the entrant. Rule books may be obtained from the CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB, 200 Ronson Drive, Suite 400, ETOBICOKE ON M9W 5Z9, Telephone: 416-675-5511

◆ The SKOC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune, either to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.

◆ All dogs must be under complete control at all times.

◆ 20.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an obedience or rally trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

PLEASE NOTE:

When entering the same dog in multiple classes a separate entry form MUST be filled out for EACH class.

COVID-19 INFORMATION – SUBJECT TO CHANGE

- ◆ All Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) regulations will be followed.
- ◆ If you are exhibiting ANY symptoms of COVID-19, please do not attend the trials.
- ◆ MASKS will be mandatory for all competitors on the precinct of the trial. New restrictions may be made at time of event according to SHA regulations.
- ◆ Proof of Vaccination/Approved Negative Test will be required.
- ◆ **ALL competitors will be required to sign a waiver form and must turn waiver in at venue upon arrival, before competing. Waiver is available on DogShow.ca**

COVID-19 CKC OBEDIENCE TRIAL ALLOWABLE CHANGES

The following are temporary changes to the Obedience Rules & Regulations that the SKOC has chosen to use during this event in the year 2022 to operate under COVID-19 restrictions:

- ◆ Handler will place their leash, dumbbells etc. in a designated spot and pick up after their run. The ring steward will NOT bring your leash to you. Your dog must leave the ring on-leash and under control.
- ◆ Pylons will be used for Figure 8 posts at all levels
- ◆ Group Stays – dogs will be placed a minimum of 8 feet apart for all levels. To accommodate the distance requirement, there may be more than one group. A dog that fails to qualify in the Individual Exercises will not be eligible to compete in the Group Exercise.

Payment may be made using a credit card (VISA, MasterCard, American Express) or by Interac or E-Transfer. Paper entries cannot be paid using Interac or E-Transfer.
