JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES IS OPEN TO ALL PUPPIES SIX MONTHS AND UNDER EIGHTEEN MONTHS OF AGE REGARDLESS OF PLACE OF BIRTH. ALL PUPPIES <u>MUST</u> BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS IN THE SHOW ON THE SAME DAY. PUPPIES WILL BE JUDGED IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING THREE CLASSES (divided by sex):

JUNIOR PUPPY MALE/FEMALE - 6 MONTHS AND UNDER 9 MONTHS
SENIOR MALE/FEMALE - 9 MONTHS AND UNDER 12 MONTHS
12 to 18 MONTH MALE/FEMALE - 12 MONTHS AND UNDER 18 MONTHS

Open to all Juniors 18 Years or under. \$2.00 fee will be donated to Provincial Junior Kennel Club. Dogs handled by the Juniors must be entered in an Official class or for Exhibition Only. The dog need not be owned by the Junior Handler.

## **CLASSES WILL BE DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS:**

Pee Wee – 4 to 6 Years (non-competitive)
Junior Novice - 7 to 10 Years, Junior Open 7 to 10 years,
Intermediate Novice – 11 to 14 years, Intermediate Open – 11 to 14 years
Senior Novice - 12 to 18 Years, Senior Open - 12 to 18 years.

"While the club encourages participants and family members to take photos of their own dogs, we must insist that ALL persons, other that the official photographer and their employees, taking photographs of any dog other than their own, or one belonging to a member of their immediate family, have permission from both the club (show chairman) and the official photographer.

Any individual observed taking photos of official wins, other than as described above, will be asked to leave the grounds."

#### **CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

DOGS COMPETING\* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more POINTS AWARDED 0 1 2 3 4 5

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The point system provides for additional points if a class dog awarded Best of Breed also places in the group as listed below;

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall not be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and (2) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

#### **PAYMENT OF FEES**

(Foreign Born/Foreign Owned Dog)

For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain Championship status and Obedience Titles and Degrees, individual registration is no longer required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of entering first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of dogs' foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee (\$59.40 Canadian Funds) along with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering CKC events ONLY.)

<u>SENIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog **9 months of age and under 12 months of age** on the day of the show **12 to 18 MONTH CLASS** – This class shall be for any dog **12 months of age and under 18 months of age** on the day of the show **CANADIAN BRED CLASS** - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada.

## (Champions of any country excluded)

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS** - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

**OPEN CLASS** - This class shall be for all dogs

Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

<u>SPECIALS ONLY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. <u>Note</u>: A <u>Listed dog <u>MAY</u> be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class <u>MUST</u> be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. <u>Listing Fees <u>WILL NOT</u> be refunded <u>EXHIBITION ONLY</u> - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class <u>MAY NOT COMPETE</u> in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-</u></u>

## **NON-REGULAR CLASSES**

NOTE: Any dog entered in a Non-Regular class MUST also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only on the same day

BRACE CLASS - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex)

<u>BABY PUPPY CLASS-</u> This class shall be for any dog **3months of age and under 6 months of age** on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male, Best Baby Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Group, Best Baby Puppy in Show (**This class will be held on completion of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and PRIOR to Best in Show)** 

<u>VETERANS CLASS</u> – Dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. Awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran, Best Female Veteran, Best Veteran in Breed, Best Veteran in Group, Best Veteran in Show (*This class will be held on completion of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and PRIOR to Best in Show*)

- 4. DOGS MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 1 HOUR PRIOR TO THE JUDGING OF THEIR BREED.
- 5. THE OWNER OF A DOG ENTERED IN THESE SHOWS IS ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERROR IN ENTERING HIS/HER DOG REGARDLESS OF HOW OR BY WHOM THE ENTRY WAS MADE
- 6. EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DOGS AND EQUIPMENT LEFT AT THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- 7. DOGS TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. NOT IN VICINITY OF RINGS
- 8. ALL RECREATIONAL UNITS WILL HAVE BUCKETS UNDERNEATH FOR THEIR SINK DRAINS. ANYONE FOUND DISCHARGING GREY OR BLACK WATER ON THE GROUNDS WILL BE REMOVED BY ORDER OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, AND DENIED FUTURE ENTRY TO THE SHOWS.
- 9. IF, BECAUSE OF CIVIL DISTURBANCE OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE SHOW, THERE IS NO REFUND OF ENTRY.
- 10. DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS

ALL EXHIBITORS, HANDLERS AND PATRONS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE CKC DOG SHOW RULES

## **EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS**

#### CHAPTER 4.1.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

#### CHAPTER 8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES

#### Section 8.3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

- (a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed
- (b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration
- (c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered. A listing fee of \$8.92 must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

#### Section 8.2:

## **INCOMPLETE ENTRIES**

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being cancelled.

## **Section 8.6.2:**

#### **DISHONORED CHEQUES**

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitor who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order, cash or certified cheque.

#### **CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION**

#### **Section 14.1.4**

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 14, Section 3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations

#### CHAPTER 5 - SHOW OFFICIALS

#### Section 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

**GRAND CHAMPION** (synopsis only – full details posted on CKC website Points towards a Grand Championship cannot be gained until a dog completes its Canadian Championship. The accumulation of points began January 1, 2013. The dog must compete in the Specials Only class. Twenty points are needed for the title (the forms are available for download from the CKC website and it is the responsibility of the owner to keep track and when they reach the 20 points, submit the form to CKC who will verify the wins, and if correct will issue a certificate). In the 20 points there needs to be a minimum of 1 Best of Breed and at least 2 – 2 point wins. The scale of points is the same as for regular championships. A judge will select Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog, Select Bitch (the latter 2 will be chosen from the remaining Specials dogs competing, if any in competition). The points are based on the total number of dogs defeated
