ADDITIONAL CKC RULES

8.2.5 – An error in the class, date of birth or sex of the dog may be amended on the entry form up to ONE hour PRIOR to the start of the show.

8.5.8 – In the case of a judge change (substitute or overload) an exhibitor may enter a dog under the replacement judge providing that the dog is entered in one of the regular classes within the show being held at the same venue by the same club and has been assigned a competition (armband) number. A new entry, along with accompanying entry fees and listing fees (if applicable), will be accepted by the Show Secretary up to ONE hour PRIOR to the opening of the show (see section 3.32, 3.51 & 8.5.4)

8.9.3 – When one or more all-breed and/or Specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving class dogs to specials MUST be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the all-breed or Specialty show.

12.3.1 – A Puppy awarded Best Puppy in Group is NOT required to stay for Best Puppy in Show.

MR STEPHEN J DAINARD

Steve Dainard comes from a second generation dog show family. He began showing dogs in his early teens in the late seventies. His family started with Flat Coated Retrievers and later found their breed of choice to be English Springer Spaniels.

Steve and his wife Kelly, breed English Springer Spaniels under the 'KAS' prefix. He has shown Springers to the top winning male in Canadian history, as well number one all breed status. 'KAS' bred and showed the top winning female in the history of the breed as well, attaining number four all breed status. He also owned at the time of his showing, the top winning/producing sire in the history of the breed in the U.S.A.

Steve was an all breed handler specializing in Sporting and Herding dogs. He has also owned top winning Australian Shepherds.

Steve has served terms on the executive of the Canadian Dog Judges Association managing programs and education and Treasurer. He holds a Bachelor of Commerce degree.

He is licensed for the Sporting, Working, Toy, Non-Sporting and Herding groups as well as Best in Show and has judged in Canada, the U.S.A., Australia, and Colombia.

In his professional life he is a retired Manager with the Toronto Transit Commission in Administration and Financial Control and started his next career as a Mortgage Professional in 2014 with the professional designation of Accredited Mortgage Professional. In his personal life, Steve and his wife Kelly have three children and live in Niagara Falls, Ontario.

Also active in the Hound Group for the past twenty-five years showing Irish Wolfhounds, Whippets and for the past fourteen years PBGV's. Achieving my first PBGV BIS in 2002 and ranked in the top 5 Hounds in Canada numerous times. We finished our first English Champion in 2007 in five shows and now have 5 English Champions. In 2010 we won the American PBGV Nationals with MBIS, MBISS Soletrader Bjorn Borg, home-bred Winners Dog and the litter sister was Best of Winners. In 2012 our co-owned English CH. Soletrader Peek A Boo was # 1 dog in the U.K. and BIS at the 2013 Cruft's show.

I have been judging since 1981, and the Canadian Kennel Club granted me All Breed Judging status in 2002.

I have judged numerous breed boosters and specialties including OES, German Shorthairs, Vizsla, Flat - Coated Retrievers, PBGV's, Rhodesian Ridgeback's, Irish Wolfhounds, Siberian Huskys and Australian Cattle Dogs to name a few. I have officiated in Ireland, Australia, Puerto Rico, Finland, Thailand, Columbia, Argentina New Zealand, Chile, Germany, Mexico, Japan and numerous American States, and all Canadian Provinces.

MS V CHERIE HOLMES

Cherie Holmes has been active in breeding & exhibiting dogs since 1971. Under the prefix, Holmrn, she has produced over 100 champion Dobermans in 7 countries. Holmrn has produced many BIS/BISS winners, including the #1 Doberman in the U.S. She commenced judging in 2008, and has judged in Australia, Mexico, Brazil, and the U.S. Other breeds she has been involved with are Boxers, Smooth Fox Terriers, Irish Setters, and American Cockers. She has judged National Specialties in the U.S., Australia, Brazil and Canada, and is licensed of the working group, and ½ of the sporting group.

I have been breeding Standard Smooth Dachshunds since the early seventies with a fair amount of Success.
We also had Mini Wire Dachshund who produced a couple of nice litters for us.

In addition to Canada, I have judged in Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, Taiwan, and USA.

MRS MAVIS McCLINTOCK

I was born and raised in Winnipeg and got my first show dog, a Samoyed, in 1969. Ch, OTCh Fiala Regina was the first of many Samoyeds and Labradors who filled my home. Under the kennel name of *Samador*, which I registered in 1972, they were all extensively exhibited in Conformation and Obedience with many show champions and obedience titled dogs, including two UD's.

In 1990, while living in the British Virgin Islands, I met and fell hopelessly in love with the Portuguese Water Dog and in 1992 Ch Neocles Lord Nelson CD came into my life. Nelson was one of the first PWDs in Canada to achieve a championship and obedience title and was the first of many PWDs and handful of Lowchens to share our home - all of which achieved conformation and obedience and/or water trial titles. I now breed only PWDs and have been fortunate to breed Best In Show, multiple BPIS, Specialty BOS and Puppy winners, many group and puppy group winners as well as rally, agility, obedience and water trial winners.

For more 45 years I have been dedicated to working in my Provincial and National breed clubs and I am proud of being the first PWD breeder/judge in Canada. I have been fortunate to travel to Europe and Finland for numerous World Shows and attended the first World Congress on the Portuguese Water Dog in Portugal in 2013.

My passion for dogs and the conformation ring is boundless and the opportunity to judge is a great joy. I am licensed for the entire working group and the first half of the non sporting breeds and on permit for the second half. I have judged PWD specialties in the USA and Canada.

MS KIMBERLY ANNE MEREDITH-CAVANNA

Kim has been continuously involved in the sport of purebred dogs since 1972. A breeder-exhibitor of Alaskan Malamutes, she has bred over 60 champions, in a limited breeding program; including multiple All-Breed Best in Show winners as well as multiple National Specialty winners. She owner handled the youngest Working Group winner in the history of the breed, a record that still stands to this day. In addition to exhibiting Alaskan Malamutes, she has owned and exhibited Akitas, Bernese Mtn. Dogs, Doberman Pinschers, Lhasa Apsos, a Clumber Spaniel and Whippets.

She is currently approved to judge Best in Show, Junior Showmanship, the Working, Sporting, Herding and Hound groups. She has judged abroad in France, Italy, Spain, Holland, Belgium, New Zealand, Germany and Finland. She has judged National specialties for Akitas, Alaskan Malamutes, Portuguese Water Dogs, Siberian Husky, Newfoundlands, Golden Retrievers, Border Collies and the Cane Corso. She has been honored with judging at the Westminster Kennel Club five times including judging the Working Group in 2010 and judged the AKC/Eukanuba show in 2011. Kim shares her home with an Alaskan Malamute, a Doberman Pinscher and a Whippet.

DR TERILL S UDENBERG

Dr. Udenberg has been involved in the sport of exhibiting dogs for nearly thirty years, starting with Dobermans. After a short hiatus, returned with Standard Poodles and eventually included toy Poodles. He has been breeding Standard Poodles for over twenty years with the prefix "Tees" and also of Tees Blue Skies. He has had multiple Best In Show, and Best In Specialty winners, but loves exhibiting the young specimens of his breed best.

Dr. Udenberg has judged in Canada, USA, New Zealand and Australia and frequently does seminars in many subjects including, Conformation and Movement, Canine Reproduction, and in Brachycephalic Airway Syndrome. He is a member of the Health Committee for the Pekingese Club of America. Dr. Udenberg was invited to speak at the National Pekingese Club of Great Britain(on airway research) at their meeting with the Kennel Club of Great Britain ,in regard to their impending changes in the Pekingese standard. It included many other short nosed breeds. He is also a member of the Poodle Club of America.

JUDGE'S BIOS' (cont'd)

He has had the honor of judging many specialties in both the USA, Canada, New Zealand and Australia, including: the Tibetan Terriers, Poodles, Boston Terriers, Pekingese, Pomeranians, Miniature Pinschers, Lowchen, Australian shepherds and others.

He is an avid volunteer in world disasters including Katrina, Guyana, Peru earthquakes, and in spay and neuter rather than strychnine poisoning of dogs in Fiji.

Dr. Udenberg, as a Veterinarian has special interest in genetically inherited diseases, and does critical care including Cardiology, Ultrasound, and Acupuncture. He is an avid outdoors man including biking, hiking , kayaking and extensive travel for diving along with his partner.

He is currently approved for all of group 3 working , all 5 toys, all 6 non-sporting, and half of group 1 sporting and on permit for the second half of sporting.

MR BRENTON T WRIGHT

I exhibited a Boxer at my first show in 1963 when I was a youngster. Later, competing in Junior Handling I became the top Senior Boy Handler in B.C. in 1966. In 1967 I purchased a Bedlington Terrier from the U.S. and finished his Canadian and American championships myself.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

GRAND CHAMPION

(synopsis only – full details posted on CKC website)

Points towards a Grand Championship cannot be gained until a dog completes its Canadian Championship. The accumulation of points began January 1, 2013. The dog must compete in the Specials Only class. Twenty points are needed for the title (the forms are available for download from the CKC website and it is the responsibility of the owner to keep track and when they reach the 20 points, submit the form to CKC who will verify the wins, and if correct will issue a certificate). In the 20 points there needs to be a minimum of 1 Best of Breed and at least 2 – 2 point wins. The scale of points is the same as for regular championships. A judge will select Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog, Select Bitch (the latter 2 will be chosen from the remaining Specials dogs competing, if any in competition). The points are based on the total number of dogs defeated

7. DOGS TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, NOT IN VICINITY OF RINGS
8. ALL RECREATIONAL UNITS WILL HAVE BUCKETS UNDERNEATH FOR THEIR SINK DRAINS. ANYONE FOUND DISCHARGING WATER ON THE GROUNDS WILL BE REMOVED BY ORDER OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FINE.
9. IF, BECAUSE OF CIVIL DISTURBANCE OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE SHOW, NO REFUND OF ENTRY.
10. DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR WITHIN THE SHOW BUILDING WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE OBEDIENCE RINGS.

ALL EXHIBITORS, HANDLERS AND PATRONS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE CKC DOG SHOW RULES.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The point system provides for additional points if a class dog awarded Best of Breed also places in the group as listed below;

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, **SHALL NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)
