

#### CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;



A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, <u>SHALL NOT</u> be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

Since then I have judged in every province in Canada, over 20 states in USA, Hong Kong, China, Australia, NZ, South Africa, Ireland, Columbia. My judging experience includes All Breed shows, Specialties in MANY different breeds incl Afghans in every country I have judged in. I also judged OZZ DOG of the year in Sydney Australia. Have been invited to speak at two World Congress's.

**RALLY NOVICE A:** Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

**RALLY NOVICE B:** Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

**RALLY ADVANCED A:** This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

**RALLY ADVANCED B:** This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

**RALLY EXCELLENT A:** This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R. E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

**RALLY EXCELLENT B:** This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash except the Honour Exercise. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

#### **Transition Obedience Classes**

**PRE-NOVICE** - This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

**NOVICE "C"** - This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice 'C' and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

#### **EKARAT SANGKUNAKUP**

Mr. Ekarat Sangkunakup of Thailand, began his involvement with American show dogs in 1982. Perhaps best known here in the States for his top winning Chow Chows and Dobermans, he has also had top winning Shih Tzu, Pomeranians, Smooth Fox Terrier, Am.Cocker and Golden Retrievers in the past, all proudly exhibited under United prefix and has garnered numerous Championships across the world. The United Chow Chows were the first Thai bred dogs to be shown competitively in the US, and to this day remain the premiere representative of Thailand for their excellent quality, not only in America, but abroad.

Dogs bred or owned my Mr. Sangunakup have amassed over 250 All-Breed Best in Shows and over 400 All-Breed Best Baby in Shows worldwide. In the last fifteen years, United Kennels has had more than twenty different dogs hold the #1 position both in the US and Thailand. The United Chows have ranked #1 Chow Chow in the breed more than ten times in Thailand, including 2009, and have been extremely successful across Asia, having become the #1 Chow in various other countries. At the core of his philosophy as a breeder/judge, is the belief that the preservation of the breed standard and type, ultimately depends upon the collaboration and education of Chow breeders worldwide. Breeding and judging according to the Chow standard is of utmost importance in order to maintain the integrity of this historic and beloved breed. Recognized throughout the world for his in depth knowledge of dogs.

Mr. Sangkunakup is one of very few individuals licensed to judge All-Breeds everywhere dogs are exhibited. He is routinely the guest of fanciers in U.S.A, Canada, South America, Russia, Scandinavian, Australia, New Zealand, Japan, China, South East Asia as well as his native Thailand. While looking forward to actively pursuing his judging career domestically and abroad, he continues to campaign his outstanding Thai bred dogs in the United States.

#### **BETTY-ANNE STENMARK**

She was born in North Vancouver, B.C. and grew up with an English Cocker pet. She married an American in 1975 and moved to the San Francisco Bay Area. Betty-Anne began in dogs with a Victoria B.C. bred Saint Bernard in 1967 and took her to the Nanaimo KC obedience classes. As a wedding present she received a Saluki dog from Richard & Barbara Webster of "Urray" Salukis in Aldergrove, thus began her love of the breed. In 1975 she began breeding Dandie Dinmont Terriers under the King's Mtn. prefix, and continues breeding to this day. A King's Mtn. dog and bitch won Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex at the 2011 DDT of America National Specialty. Betty-Anne is the author of six breed books, Bassets, Beagles, Saint Bernards, Airedales, Dandies, Pembrokes, and a new book entitled Mastering the Breed Standards ~ Terriers, the first of a series, is in the works. She has been the show chairman of the Del Valle Dog Club of Livermore since 1981, one of the largest all breed shows on the West Coast. Betty-Anne is approved for all Sporting, all Hounds, all Terriers, Saint Bernards, both Corgis and Best in Show. Professionally she is the volunteer coordinator at Palo Alto Animal Services Shelter.



#### **EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011**

#### Non-member participation fee

a) An annual <u>non-member participation fee for awards and</u> titles will be charged to a Canadian <u>non-member of CKC</u>. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the <u>non</u>-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the <u>non</u>-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by <u>non</u>-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

#### REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & NOVICE "B" AT SAME TRIAL NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & OPEN "B" AT SAME TRIAL

**NOVICE "A"** - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD" in ANY COUNTRY. The dog does not have to be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class. One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor MUST BE THE OWNER or A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL **EXERCISES.** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but MUST COMPETE IN THE NOVICE "B" CLASS **NOVICE "B"** - This class is open to all dogs that have not earned the title of "CD" in Canada. Dogs in this class may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog does not have to be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class OPEN "A" - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor MUST BE THE OWNER OF A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but MUST COMPETE IN THE OPEN "B" CLASS. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class **OPEN "B"** - This class is open to all dogs that have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog **MAY** ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

<u>UTILITY CLASS 'A'</u>- This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class. This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

<u>UTILITY CLASS 'B'</u> - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approx. 30 mins. Prior to the start of the class.

#### **CONFORMATION CLASSES**

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered <u>BABY PUPPY CLASS-</u> This class shall be for any dog 3months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. (This class will be held on completion of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group, Best Puppy in Show)

<u>JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

<u>SENIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

<u>12 to 18 MONTH CLASS</u>- This class shall be for any dog **12 months but** under 18 months of age on the day of the show

<u>CANADIAN BRED CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS** - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring by owner/breeder. The handler <u>MUST</u> be the owner/co-owner <u>AND</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards <u>OPEN CLASS</u> - This class shall be for all dogs

<u>SPECIALS ONLY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog that has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. <u>Note</u>: A Listed dog <u>MAY</u> be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class <u>MUST</u> be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees <u>WILL NOT</u> be refunded

**EXHIBITION ONLY** - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class **MAY NOT COMPETE** in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY
