**ZERO TOLERANCE** – Any individual initiating bullying tactics at the Ontario Breeders Association Club Events will be asked to leave the Event grounds premises immediately and for the remainder of the event (no refunds). A report will be filed with CKC and the Disciplinary Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit.

**Definition of Bullying**: Refers to a range of behaviors in which targeted individuals are repeatedly, and over time, treated in a mean, insulting or abusive way. Bullying can be initiated deliberately or unconsciously. The affected person may feel upset, afraid, isolated, or humiliated. The bully sometimes acts alone and sometimes as part of a group of people.

- insulting a person's skills, looks, or habits
- spreading false or malicious rumors, gossip, or innuendo
- berating/belittling an individual
- unwarranted criticizing or ridiculing, especially in the presence of others
- giving insulting nicknames
- engaging in practical jokes that humiliate
- undermining or deliberately impeding a person's work
- physical gesturing that intimidates, offends, degrades, or humiliates
- mocking a person's accent, abilities or mannerisms
- yelling or shouting which intimidates, coerces, or belittles

#### **CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

<u>SECTION 1:</u> A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship Event held under these Dog Event Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

A class dog awarded Best in Event at an all-breed championship Event will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case, may a dog earn more than five points at any single Event.

#### ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

#### To obtain an **ERN** simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN. Include full payment in the amount of \$62.40. 
- The Club and Diana Edwards Event Services will not be responsible of cash sent through the mail.
- Returned cheques do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee of \$35.00
  will be added by Kars Dog Club in addition to any bank charges for each returned
  cheque.
- There is no refund for duplicate entries. Every effort will be made to find all
  duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the
  official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, excused by a
  Veterinarian or Judge, disqualified or barred from competition by action of the
  bench Committee.
- If because of riot, civil disturbance or acts of God, it is impossible to open or complete the Event, no refund of entries shall be made.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Change or cancellation of any entry after closing time is prohibited.
- The Club reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of Judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners/Agents are responsible to have their dogs present when their classes are called to be judged.
- Exhibitors are requested to keep their grooming and crating areas clean and tidy.
   If space is at a premium, exhibitors must remove exercise pens if requested by the Event Superintendent.
- 10. It shall be the duty and obligation of the Event giving club to ensure that a judge is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Event Committee shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- 11. The Kars Dog Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes to dogs, exhibitors or patrons
- 12. The Event Superintendent will be in complete charge of the Event, which will be governed by CKC rules.

#### NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to <a href="https://www.ckc.ca">www.ckc.ca</a> under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THESE EVENTS

The Ontario Breeders Association (OBA) is pleased to welcome you to our 2021 Conformation Events, redefined for the circumstances that we presently face as a community.

#### THIS INFORMATION WILL BE AMENDED AS DIRECTIVES ARE RECEIVED FROM ONTARIO HEALTH SERVICES.

Updates will be included in the Judging Schedule - Annex A of the Premium List

By entering the OBA Events you are agreeing to the regulations that have been designed to keep us safe while together.

THE REQUIREMENTS ARE NON-NEGOTIABLE AND WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. If you have personal objections to our restrictions which are based on the most current guidelines from Ontario Public Health Services, then please do not enter these events. Any breach of the requirements will result in dismissal from the events with no right of entry fee refund.

There will be a PHOTOGRAPHER at these events; they will have their own COVID-19 Protocols in place.

#### COVID-19 WAIVER/DISCLAIMER

- 2020 COVID-19 response legally obligates any person who the following core symptoms of cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose, or sore throat (that is not related to a pre-existing illness or health condition) to be in isolation for 14 days from the start of symptoms, or until symptoms resolve, whichever takes longer, or they receive a negative COVID19 test.
- If you are exhibiting any of these symptoms, it is suggested you complete the COVID-19 Self-Assessment online tool to determine if you should be tested.
- If you exhibit any of these symptoms or the symptoms on the COVID-19 Assessment Tool, you will NOT be allowed to attend the event. If you feel unwell at all, you must not attend the event.
- The OBA COVID-19 waiver/disclaimer must be signed and presented on your first day at the event. The daily health screening questionnaire found in this Premium List will be required <u>EACH DAY</u> you are entered in the event.
- When you arrive for the first time, please fill out the WAIVER/DISCLAIMER, in this Premium List and bring it to the
  Screening Station. Do not wait until just before you need to be in the ring with your dog, to be screened and get your
  wristband for the day. The OBA volunteers are not responsible for poor timing on your part and the COVID-19 Screening
  will take priority over everything else. Abusive language or behavior will not be tolerated.
- Waiver/Disclaimer must be signed by Club Members, Judges, Ring Stewards, Exhibitors, Owners, Handlers, Breeders, Assistants, Volunteers, Vendors, Family Members, etc.

#### PRIOR TO THE EVENT

All Judges, exhibitors, handlers, volunteers and stewards, etc will be required to have a printed copy of risk assessment
and waiver form to bring to the show and to be filled out and signed accordingly for contact tracing purposes.

#### THE EVENT GROUNDS

- There will be signs indicating Entrance and Exits of the official Event Grounds.
- · Entrance will have Screening Station.
- There will be hand sanitizing stations provided in all areas.
- Porta-potties will be situated on the grounds with hand sanitizing stations.
- · Each ring will have an Entrance, an Exit and Social Distancing Markers.
- . Judges' tables and other touch surfaces will be sanitized regularly.
- These events are "Show and Go" there will be no Camping, no Grooming Tents, No outdoor x-pens, No Setups or popup shade tents or outside grooming tables. Dogs cannot be groomed outside of your vehicle on show precincts.
- Portable umbrellas are permitted to provide shade for your dog while you wait to enter ring.

- NO GATHERINGS PERMITED You must remain at your vehicle at all times while awaiting to proceed to your Judging ring.
- . No Water or Electricity will be available on the grounds.
- . The OBA will have a cool off station for the dogs.

# MASKS

- Masks are mandatory at all times while in the ring and on the Event precincts. Masks must be worn completely
  covering both mouth and nose.
- Face shields (no mask), neck warmers, masks with exhalation valves, handkerchiefs and any other loose fitting face
  coverings are NOT masks and are not recommended by Ontario Public Health Services. Face Shields are acceptable only
  when the exhibitor has a medical exception letter.
- Anyone unable to wear a mask due to a medical condition will require a medical exception letter from an authorized health professional. You must be able to show and provide a copy of the letter at the Screening Station.
  - o The medical exception letter must come from a nurse practitioner, physician or psychologist.
  - o The medical exception letter may be presented when in a public setting if requested by enforcement officials, or retrospectively in court if a ticket is issued.
- . If you do not bring a mask, one will be provided for you at a cost (limited supply of mask).

#### SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Maintain SOCIAL DISTANCING 2 meters (6 feet) while at the event venue. We are providing extra space in the rings to maintain these distances so you do not encroach upon the person in front of you, be respectful.
- No hugging or handshaking permitted on any of the official grounds of the Event. Avoid touching dogs that are not
  your responsibility.
- There will be a staging area for each group, do NOT encroach on other areas or rings. Space for additional distance to be provided between vehicles.
- Due to COVID-19 protocols, there will be a maximum number of people allowed at each one of the event staging area at one time

#### WRIST BANDS

- Every day, before you can enter the event venue, you will fill out the COVID-19 Assessment Tool located in this
  Premium List and bring it to the Screening Station. At this time, please present your DogShow.ca receipt which confirms
  your entry & arm-band number (on an electronic device or printed by you).
- Upon acceptance, a OBA volunteer will give you a wristband and watch you place the wristband on your wrist. The
  wristband is ONLY GOOD for one day. The COVID-19 Screening can be done at any time throughout the day, at any
  Screening station.
- You will need to show your wristband to the ring steward along with your arm-band before you can enter the event ring with your dog.
- . The OBA will refuse entry into the event precincts and rings to anyone without a wristband.
- Each exhibitor will receive a maximum of ONE wristband only per entry. NO replacement wrist bands will be issued.

#### ARRIVAL AT GROUNDS & EXHIBITING

- Exhibitors should arrive on the grounds NO MORE THEN ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THEIR SCHEDULED JUDGING TIME and allow time for COVID-19 screening. The COVID-19 screening station will be open one hour before judging time.
- Upon arrival at the grounds, you must remain in your vehicle. A Parking marshal will direct you to the screening station
  and thereafter to your staging area. In staging area it is mandatory that you remain within the proximities of your
  vehicle at all times No Gatherings.
- Exhibitors will be lined up according to their ring and will advance to the staging area when instructed by the Parking marshal... NO EXCEPTIONS.
- . Once in your staging area, remain by your vehicle until 5 minutes prior to your breed being called into the ring.
- No X-pens, floor mats or tables will be allowed at ringside or on event grounds. Do not leave personal belongings at ringside.

- Once you have finished exhibiting your breed, you will be required to leave the event grounds promptly if you have no other dogs to exhibit within the next 15 minutes.
- . You may return 45 minutes before your next breed or Group judging, etc. through the main entrance gate.
- If you are unable to attend/exhibit due to COVID-19 or any other ailment, it is your responsibility to find an alternative handler for your dog, if you wish your dog to participate.
- · Exhibitors are asked to show the bite of their dog upon the Judge's request.
- There will be a designated "Drop off parking area" (max 15 min.) for owners that are bringing their dogs to be shown by a handler. Handler will be required to make arrangements to pick up their client's dog from the "Drop off parking area". Owner must remain in their vehicle until pick up and leave the event premises immediately following "drop off".
- No Public Catalogue will be available, know your numbers when picking up armbands.

#### BE SELF-SUFFICIENT

- Bring Portable umbrella to provide shade for your dog while you wait to enter ring.
- . Bring Bottled water, dog cool coats, shade screen to put on your vehicle, etc.
