No post dated cheques will be accepted. A post dated cheque is one that is dated after the receipt of the entry. **All N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a charge of \$20.00.** N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fee and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.

Attention USA Exhibitors: Please note that due to constantly fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, **however**, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not make cheques "Payable In Canadian Funds" or "At Par", they will NOT be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we are suggesting that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You!

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club.

The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.

In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.

The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and is not applicable to Canadian Kennel Club members.

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Champion & Championship Points ~ Chapter 1 Section 1 ~ A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

Section 2:

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded WINNERS also places in the Group.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. **NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition a dog**

that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **NOT** be included in the calculation of Championship points.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA/MasterCard number and expiry date, the card holders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

CONFORMATION MOVING UP TO SPECIALS ONLY

A dog individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirement for a Championship in accordance with CKC Rules, after the closing date and time for the show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "specials Only", providing the request is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING and on the appropriate form at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. When one or more Championship shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving a Class dog to Specials must be made a minimum one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up.

DOG SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

A copy of the CKC rules pertaining to Conformation Shows is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the CKC regarding their event.

The Dog Show Rules Section 4.1.3 states "a Judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out".

The Dog Show Rules Section 4.1.6 states "no person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his entry. Disciplinary action may be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act".

PRECINCTS OF THE SHOW

The precincts of the Shows and Trials will be the entire building. IDC is hosting this event and we will follow their rules for the show.

Driving Instructions to the Show Site will be found on the Judging Schedule.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Maritime Toy Dog Club will use all due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
2. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that the exhibitor will exercise control over their children while they are on the show premises.
3. The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.
4. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The conformation Show Committee chairperson shall promptly report to the Canadian

Kennel Club any infringement of this regulation, and the discipline committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred (Section 19.7 Dog Show Rules).

5. No person may approach a judge directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act (Section 4.1.6, Dog Show Rules).
6. Double handling will not be tolerated. The Supt reserves the right to request those exhibitors doing this to leave the building.
7. The building will close 1 ½ hours after the completion of daily judging.
8. Only dogs entered in the show will be allowed in the building.
9. "Puppy For Sale" and "Dog For Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
10. Maritime Toy Dog Club will not be responsible for any equipment left in the building.
11. **DO NOT PARK IN THE FRONT PARKING LOT OR YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE TOWED AT YOUR OWN EXPENSE**
12. **OVERNIGHT CAMPERS AND RV PARKING IS FORBIDDEN ON CIVIC CENTRE PROPERTY.**

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT YOUR "IN BUILDING" SET UP SITE AND ALSO AT YOUR HOTEL, MOTEL OR CAMPGROUND
