It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under CKC Rules is not subject to indignities. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fair on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

CKC OBEDIENCE RULE 20.7

SHOW PRECINCTS: The Show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials, judges or exhibitors and handlers, and an area of 30 feet outside of the judging rings.

1. Only dogs that are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered.
2. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club entries reaching the Show Secretary after the closing date as published in the Premium List cannot be accepted.
3. Entries cannot be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are filled in. ie. DOB, sex, place of birth etc..
4. Only entries accompanied by the entry fee will be accepted.
5. No telephone entries are allowed.
6. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dog (s) regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Change or cancellation of any entry after the closing day is prohibited.
7. The Bytown Dog Obedience Club has the right to refuse any entry—subject to C.K.C. Dog Show Rules.
8. The TRIAL CHAIR will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by C.K.C. Rules.
9. Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the close of entries.
10. The person accompanying the dog must show the identification card before the dog is allowed in the show. Unless a dog is officially entered, it will not be allowed on the show precincts. (*see PAGE 3*)
11. Dogs need only arrive 15 minutes prior to scheduled judging.
12. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is scheduled for judging.
13. Severn Show Services and the Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune, to either dog, exhibitor or patron.
14. The show premises will open one hour before scheduled judging times.
15. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show no refund of entry fees will be made.
16. To avoid noise and confusion, no individual dogs will be called to the ring by loud speaker. Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.

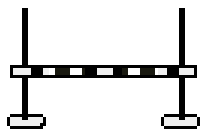

Attention US Exhibitors

Payment of entry fee : Due to the volatility of the current exchange rates, all entries must be paid in Canadian funds. We suggest you purchase a bank draft or money order for entry fee payment. Personally discounted cheques WILL NOT BE HONOURED. DO NOT mark your personal cheque *Payable in Canadian Funds* or *AT PAR* as such items are not readily cleared through the banks.

Non-Member Participation Fee

The non-member *Participation Fee* applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC, it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice of either becoming a CKC member or paying the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within thirty (30) days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up. For a membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Form on -line. The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January—December) in which the dog achieved its title.

Attention all foreign exhibitors

To obtain an ERN do the following: Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN

Include full payment . Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or Mastercard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates

Provide your full return address. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please include your VISA/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature An ERN must be obtained within 30 day of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, send a written request for a 30 day extension.

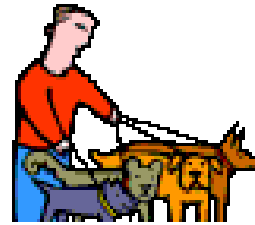
