TEST SITE

The draft test site is located on private property. We have been graciously invited to use it for this test. There is ample parking and if required, day tents may be erected near your vehicle for shade, should the weather dictate their usage. There will be washroom facilities available to entrants. You will be required to provide your own lunch and water. Please respect the facilities and keep to the areas as marked and pick up after your dogs. Dogs are to be always under control.

Rules and General Information

Eligibility: This test is open to all dogs of sufficient height and weight that are physically capable of performing all of the exercises in a particular class, and that are eighteen months of age or older on the day of the test. Brace Draft Dog entries must have previously earned D.D. titles in order to enter the B.D.D. class. Re-qualifications will be accepted only after all untitled entries are included. Re-qualifications shall be judged as the last team in the section for which they are entered. Judges may excuse a dog at any time during a test for lack of physical capacity.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Every foreign born and owned dog that is entered in a Canadian Kennel Club event must obtain an [Event Registration Number](#) (ERN) within 30 days of that event. An Event Registration Number Application must be completed and submitted along with a copy of registration documents from a CKC recognized foreign kennel club and the required fee. Download the Event Registration Number Application from the online forms section under CKC Services or contact the CKC Order Desk at 1-800-250-8040.

PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER

A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows an unregistrable dog of a CKC recognized or listed breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. In order for a dog to be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following criteria must be met:

- 1) The dog must be of a CKC recognized or listed breed.
- 2) The dog, for one reason or another, must not be eligible for CKC registration.
- 3) The dog must be spayed or neutered.
- 4) The dog must be properly identified with a CKC approved microchip (this requirement is not necessary for ILP dogs).
- 5) In the case of a foreign-born dog residing in the USA, in addition to the above, the dog must have been issued an AKC PAL number.

CANINE COMPANION NUMBER (for Mixed or Unrecognized Breed Entries)

Amendments have been made to the Draft Dog Test Rules so that mixed or unrecognized breed dogs are permitted to participate. A Canine Companion Number allows these dogs to participate and earn Draft titles. The Canine Companion Number (CCN) must be applied for

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members. Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, <http://www.ckc.ca> under Events and then Event forms on the drop down menu.

GROUP EXERCISES

Draft Dog and Brace Draft Dog Field Work, Exercises may be performed using the Group Option as stated in Section 11.2 of the CKC Draft Dog Rules and Regulations, using the recommended methodology as stated in Appendix A.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY

After the closing date, all entrants and alternates will be notified by e-mail, post, or telephone of their placement. A map and directions to the test site will be provided with this confirmation. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

Entry Information

ENTRY FEE

\$75.00 (Canadian or US funds) per entry. A Brace is one entry – please fill out two entry forms for a brace and attach. Total entries in this test will be limited to seven hours of judging.

Due to possible COVID restrictions, there will be no food services for entrants.

TCN

*TCN (LISTING FEE) PER DOG PER DAY (dogs without registration numbers) * \$10.50*

** All owners of unregistered, CKC-recognized breeds entering events are required to obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). TCNs allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while pursuing permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN) if foreign.*

All unregistered recognized breeds must obtain a TCN before entering an event. While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called listing fees) when entering events using this number. The process of obtaining a TCN is self-serve; exhibitors are directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion. Only 1 TCN is required for each dog and must be used for all event entries until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN. You do not need to be a CKC member to apply for a TCN.

CLOSING DATE

6:00 p.m. M. D. T., July 7, 2022 or when the total limits for both tests reach seven hours of judging, even if the official closing date for entries has not arrived. If the limit is reached prior to the closing date, a list of alternates will be kept to fill any vacancies created up to and including the day of the test. Entry fees will be refunded following the test to all withdrawals replaced by an alternate and to all alternates who did not participate in the test. Re-qualifications are accepted pending "space available". Re-qualifications shall be judged as the last team in the level for which they are entered.

There is no drop off facility for entries. When entering in the Brace class, please fill out a separate entry form for each dog and attach the entries together.

REFUNDS

It is the option of the exhibitor to request a refund for a bitch that has come into season, should they so desire. A veterinarian's certificate will be required for the refund to be issued. Otherwise, bitches in season may compete, but will be judged after all other entrants have been tested. Bitches in season must be kept away from the test site prior to being tested. Day of test entries will NOT be accepted for bitches in season.

AWARDS

- Each dog receiving a qualifying score will earn a red rosette, per judge, to a maximum of three rosettes; and all dogs achieving a title will receive an award.
- A special prize, donated by the Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Canada, will be awarded to any Bernese Mountain Dog achieving a new draft title.
- A special prize, donated by the Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Canada, will be awarded to the oldest Bernese Mountain Dog achieving a draft title.
- A special prize, donated by Leanne Tucker, will be awarded to any Golden Retriever achieving a new draft title
- A special prize, donated by The Giant Schnauzer Club of Canada, will be awarded to any Giant Schnauzer achieving a new draft title



A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or Interac for payment.

EQUIPMENT

Each entrant is to supply their own equipment. The freight load will be supplied by the test committee.

TEST REGULATIONS

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the level in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Draft Test Regulations are available through the Canadian Kennel Club. Telephone: (416) 675 - 5511. All dogs entered in the Draft Dog level must perform the control exercises, regardless of obedience titles held.

Section 19.7 of the CKC Draft Dog Rules and Regulations states:

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge is not subject to indignities. The Draft Dog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
