REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Pre-Novice for dogs that have not earned the title of PCD (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada, and have not earned a CD in Canada or elsewhere. More than one dog may be entered in this class by any one person or owner. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice

class

Novice A for dogs that have not earned the title of CD (Companion Dog) in Canada or any other country. Must be handled by owner or immediate family member. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises.

Novice B for dogs that have not earned the title of CD in Canada. For trainers, multiple entries, or dogs who have earned titles in another country. Dogs in this class

may be handled by any person and more than one dog may be entered.

Novice C for any dog that has earned the title of CD or higher in Canada. Scores earned

from this class are not eligible for High in Trial.

Novice Intermediate for dogs that have earned the title of CD or higher in Canada. More than one dog may be entered in this class by any one person or owner. The CDI (Companion Dog Intermediate) is an elective class and earning a title is not a

(Companion Dog Intermediate) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Open class. Scores earned from this class are not

eligible for High in Trial.

Open A for dogs that have earned the title CD in Canada, but have not earned the title of

CDX (Companion Dog Excellent). Must be handled by owner or immediate family member. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, that person must handle the dog in all exercises. No professional trainer or person who has

obtained a UD title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

Open B for dogs that have earned the title CD in Canada. Dogs in this class may be

handled by the owner or any other person. More than one dog may be entered in

this class by any one person or owner.

Utility A for dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. in Canada but has not earned the

title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in

all exercises.

Utility B for dogs which has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. Dogs in this class may be

handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may

be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial.

Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- As of June 1, 2009, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document to enter and return to the US.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER FOR FOREIGN DOGS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN, AT THE LATEST, MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC website: http://www.ckc.ca

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. More information, and application forms can be downloaded from the CKC website: http://www.ckc.ca

A judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at this event must not be subjected to indignities.
