We have owned a number of breeds in our lives: Golden Retriever, Toy and Miniature Poodles, Irish Setters, cross-breeds, Kuvasz, Bullmastiffs, Pugs, Pekingese, and Boxer. We purchased our first show dogs, Kuvasz, in 1988. These were two kennel dogs from a kennel in Ontario where the owner/breeder had passed away and he had a number of dogs that needed homes. We were so excited for our first show dogs. We socialized these two kids, took them to handling classes and after a tough start we were able to start showing them. We did our thing in the ring and fell in love with showing. Our first show dogs did not get one point ... lol, it was a challenge. My parents were breeding and showing Bullmastiffs at the same time. I had purchased a Toy Poodle from a local "breeder" and the Bullmastiff and Toy Poodle were best friends. I was asked by a prominent breeder to "babysit" her two Pugs while she went to the show.  6 to 9 months (males and females)
 9 to 12 months (males and females)
 12-18 months (males and females)

The club will retain 25% of the total entry fees received for expenses. The remainder will be dispersed as follows:

- 1st in class, 35% of entry fees received for that class
- 2nd in class, 25% of entry fees received for that class

Veteran Sweepstakes

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Junior Puppy	dogs 6 months of age/under 9 months
Senior Puppy	dogs 9 months of age/under 12 months
12- 18 months	dogs 12 months of age/under 18 months
Canadian Bred	dogs born in Canada, champions in any country excluded
Bred by Exhibitor	dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder
Open	for all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC, and will be divided in 6 classes at this specialty show as follows: 1) any colour over 8 lbs 2) any colour under 8 lbs & over 12 mths 3) Sleeve any colour under 6 lbs & over 12 mths 4) Open Black 5) Open Parti-Coloured 6) Open White or Cream
Veterans	for any dog 7 years or older on the day of the show and will be divided in two classes at this specialty show as follows: 1) 7-10 years 2) 10 years & over <i>Note: Veterans dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. Dogs competing in this class may be spayed or neutered.</i>
Specials Only	dogs which are registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have an ERN (Event Registration Number) and have attained championship status may be entered in the "Specials Only" Class. Entry of a dog in "Specials Only" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the C.K.C., but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be cancelled. The entry of a "Listed Dog" in this class is NOT allowed.
Baby Puppy	for dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show
Exhibition Only	for all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC
Exhibition Only (3 – 6 months)	for dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. These puppies cannot compete in any class, sweepstakes or parade.

Stud Dog & Get	Stud dog and two of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner.
Brood Bitch & Progeny	Brood bitch and two of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner.
Brace	For 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily the same sex). A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead (two dogs are considered one entry)

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered.

Two classes will be offered: **Altered Male & Altered Female**

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.
