NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a "non-member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to Canadian Kennel Club members.

NO POST-DATED CHEQUES ACCEPTED. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of \$50.00 **N.S.F.** cheques are considered **Non-Payment of entry fees** and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the shows/trials.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds", they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. **NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the calculation of Championship Points.**

CONFORMATION MOVING UP TO SPECIALS

A dog individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirement for a Championship in accordance with CKC Rules, after the closing date and time for the show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "specials Only", providing the request is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING and on the appropriate form at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. When one or more Championship shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving a Class dog to Specials must be made a minimum one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (TCN)-* Effective March 2, 2020

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number. Dogs may still enter CKC events until without a registration number or ERN until March 2, 2020 by marking TCN on the entry form (or Listed if it is an older entry form). An email address is required on the entry form in this case. Before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account. * If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. The CKC will update its records accordingly.

Junior Handling will be held Saturday Aug 21 & Sunday Aug 22, at the noon break. All Classes will be offered. To sign up to participate please register at the Show Secretary desk prior to 11:00 am each day

GENERAL INFORMATON

- 1. The Show Superintendent (Jim Arsenault) will be in complete charge of these events, which are governed by CKC rules.
- 2. The precincts of the show will start inside the Gate beside the Lorneville Community Centre to the farthest fence of the ball field.
- 3. A tent will be provided near the ring entrances. No cover will be provided for individuals in case of inclement weather.
- 4. Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging.
- 5. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule.
- 6. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.

- 7. All exhibitors will be held responsible for CLEAN-UP on the show grounds and surrounding areas, for their own dogs or dogs they are handling.
- 8. Additionally, CLEAN-UP after your dog(s) at your motel or campground. PLEASE FOLLOW THIS RULE SO THAT OUR SITE AND MOTEL PRIVILEDGES ARE NOT REVOKED.
- 9. NBKC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. The NBKC will not be responsible for equipment left behind at the site or on site overnight.

COVID-19 - Please Read!

Note: These are subject to change depending on restrictions at the time of the shows and trials.

- We will be observing provincial and regional guidelines regarding travel into and out of our zone, as well as safety protocols with regards to COVID.
- Every person entering the property will be screened and will be refused entry if you are violating any provincial guideline regarding travel or if you display symptoms with no refund of entries given.
- If you are in doubt, check with the province by calling 1-833-948-2800
- If the New Brunswick border remains closed the weekend of our shows "the show will go on".

REFUND POLICY

- If, due to COVID, these Shows are not able to be held; refunds will be issued to exhibitors MINUS 20%. While all efforts will be taken to expedite refunds, they may take up to 14 days (depending on volume & other work commitments).
- If because of; an act of God, riot, civil disturbance, extreme weather event, governmental orders, regulations, or decree, or other acts or circumstances beyond the control of the CDC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.

THERE WILL BE A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY ON COVID-19 VIOLATIONS, INCLUDING NOT WEARING A MASK OR NOT SOCIAL DISTANCING.

- A Waiver will be emailed out along with the judging schedule. You will be required to print off enough waivers so that every individual traveling with you has their own waiver (including minors).
- The waiver must be signed by all Club Members, Judges, Ring Stewards, Exhibitors, Owners, Handlers, Breeders, Assistants, Volunteers, Commissionaire, and Family Members, Friends etc.
- Contact tracing information must be provided for all who are on site including minors (name & phone number).
- Once you have handed in the Waiver(s) at check in on the show grounds a bracelet will be issued to you. If you misplace the bracelet you will need to fill out a separate waiver in order to receive another bracelet. **A bracelet must be worn at all times when on the show grounds. If you do not have a bracelet on, you will be asked to leave the show grounds.
- Everyone must wear masks correctly over mouth and nose in the rings during judging (Exhibitors, Judges, Stewards). They will also be required anywhere on the property where social distancing (2 meters) cannot be maintained. Social Distancing (2 meters) is mandatory in the rings, under the tents, adjacent ring areas, at the Show Secretary Table/Set-up, at the Photographers booth.
- Each ring will have an Entrance, and an Exit and Social Distancing Markers. Exhibitors will pick up their placement ribbons as they exit the ring, **NO RECYCLING** of ribbons.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to return to their set up after they have exhibited their dog. Parking will be directed, and space is not an issue. Generators are permitted in the parking area, as are personal ex-pens, grooming tables, pop-up tents, portable picnic tables etc.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The Dog Show may not be open to the General Public depending on the rules/regulations at the time of the show.
- The Club will provide hand sanitizing stations and there will be a "limited" supply of masks available.
- Grooming tables used in the ring will be cleaned frequently.
- There will be no indoor grooming area, and power <u>is not</u> supplied. You must be self-sufficient (portable generators).
- No grooming tables, crates or trolleys or chairs under the large tent. No public ex pens.
- Please bring sanitizer, and extra personal use masks. Do not leave personal belongings at ringside. Do not leave masks, gloves, water bottles, litter, etc. behind, dispose of these items in the garbage bins.

Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact. **Avoid** touching dogs that are not your responsibility.

NBKC MEMBERS WIL BE MONITORING PROTOCOL VIOLATIONS. IF YOU OBSERVE ACTIVITY WHICH CAUSES YOU CONCERN, PLEASE REPORT IT TO THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT (IIM ARSENAULT).WE TAKE THIS VERY SERIOUSLY AND WANT TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF EVERYONE ATTENDING OUR SHOWS AS WELL AS THE PEOPLE IN THEIR COMMUNITIES TO WHICH THEY WILL BE RETURNING.WE ALSO RECOGNIZE OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO THE DOG SHOW COMMUNITY TO AVOID ANY PERCEIVED OR ACTUAL VIOLATIONS TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH PROTOCOLS PUT IN PLACE BY OUR PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT SO THAT DOG SHOW EVENTS CAN CONTINUE.
