#### JUNIOR HANDLING TIME: on completion of the Specialty

COMPETITION IS OPEN TO ALL JUNIORS BETWEEN THE AGE OF 4 AND 18 YEARS. DOGS HANDLED BY THE JUNIORS MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY WITHIN THE SPECIALTY. DOGS NEED NOT BE OWNED BY THE JUNIOR.

THE CLASSES WILL BE DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS: PEE WEE (non competitive) 4 TO 6 years JUNIOR NOVICE - 7 TO 10 years JUNIOR OPEN - 7 TO 10 years INTERMEDIATE NOVICE - 11 TO 14 years INTERMEDIATE OPEN - 11 TO 14 years SENIOR NOVICE - 15 UP TO AND INCLUDING 18 years SENIOR OPEN - 15 UP TO AND INCLUDING 18 years NOTE: PEE WEES DO NOT COMPETE FOR BEST OVERALL.

### JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

This event is open to all dogs 6 months of age and under 18 months on the day of this event. All dogs MUST be entered in one of the regular classes on the day of the Specialty.

CLASSES: For judging purposes, the classes will be divided by sex as follows:

6 months & under 9 months Males/Females 9 months & under 12 months Males/Females 12 months & under 18 months Males/Females

All first place winners will compete together for the award of Best in Sweepstakes

PRIZES: A rosette, suitable prize and 75% of total fees collected will be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette and prize will be awarded to first in each class. Balance of 25% will be retained by the club to defray costs.

# **VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES**

For judging purposes, the classes will be divided by sex as follows:

7 to 9 years Male/Female, 10 years and over Male/Female Rosettes and suitable prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> in all classes. PRIZES: Best Veteran in Sweepstakes – Rosette, suitable prize and 75% of total fees collected

Balance of 25% will be retained by the club to defray costs.

All dogs MUST be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition only on the day of this Specialty. Spayed or neutered veterans may compete provided they are also entered in the Veterans (competitive) regular class or for Exhibition Only.

The following official regular/non-regular classes (divided by sex) will be provided at this Specialty.

<u>JUNIOR PUPPY</u> - dogs 6 months & under 9 months on day of this Show <u>SENIOR PUPPY</u> - dogs 9 months & under 12 months on day of this Show <u>12 to 18 MONTH CLASS</u> - dogs 12 mths & under 18 mths on day of Show <u>CANADIAN BRED</u> - dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded <u>BRED BY EXHIBITOR</u> - For dogs owned and handled in the ring by Breeder <u>OPEN CLASS</u> - For all dogs (Note: Divided by colour)

**SPECIALS ONLY** - For dogs that have earned all the Championship Points required for CKC Championship status at the time of closing of entries **VETERANS CLASS** - For dogs 7 years of age and older on the day of this Show. Dogs entered in this class DO NOT COMPETE FOR POINTS but rather the winner of the Veteran Male & Veteran Female Class go directly onto the Best of Breed competition. (Note: Spayed or neutered dogs may be entered in this class)

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES

ALL DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN ONE OF THE REGULAR CLASSES OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY.

**EXHIBITION ONLY:** All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular Classes and/or Parades if provided for in the premium list.
