Trophy List

A Rosette will be awarded to placements 1-4 in each class

Equipment will be chosen from the following:

A-Frame 5'6" (Rubber Coat)	Dog Walk (Rubber Coat)
Teeter (Rubber Coat)	Closed Tunnel
Open Tunnel	Panel Jump
Bar Jumps	Tire Jump
Double Bar Jump	Pause Table (to be set at a correct height) (A Sit or Down may be required for 5 sec.)
Triple bar Jump (Not used in Novice Levels)	Ascending Spread Jump (Not used in Novice Levels)
Weave Poles, 6 to 12 (Not Used in Novice Levels, except jumpers with weaves)	

Equipment and course familiarization:

- A warm – up area with a single practice jump will be provided for dogs entered in the trials.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class

Agility Rules and Regulations: (4.1.3.t) It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred

Entry Requirements:

Every dog entered in a CKC Agility Trial must be purebred and must be registered with the CKC, or have an ERN (Event Registration Number), a PEN (Performance Event Number) or be eligible for Registration with the CKC, or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification Number.

The dog must be at least 18 months of age, may be spayed or neutered. The dog may not be lame or compete if it has tape or bandages.

A dog may only be entered in one Standard Class & one Jumpers With Weaves Class at each trial.

There will be Move Ups between Trials 2 & 3 only- no same day move ups

AGILITY CLASSES OFFERED

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The following C.K.C. classes (divided by heights) will be offered:

REGULAR CLASSES

Standard Novice A: For persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country or organization.

Standard Novice B: For agility instructors and judges and for dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice Title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Agility

Intermediate; and for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any agility organization.

Standard Intermediate: Is open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, and to those dogs which have acquired the Agility Intermediate title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent Title.

Standard Excellent A: For dogs that have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title.

Standard Excellent B: For dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title or the AgilityMaster Excellent title.

Jumpers withWeaves: same classes, heights, and conditions as for Standard Regular.

SELECTED CLASSES

The Selected Classes (both Standard & Jumpers with Weaves) follow the Agility Trials Rules & Regulations. The courses will be the same as in the Regular Classes but will

have adjusted height and course times. Novice Select Class is not divided into A and B Divisions. The same rules apply for Excellent A & B as those described for the

Regular Classes. A dog must be entered only in Selected Class or in Regular Classes at the same set of trials. They may move back and forth between the two Classes but

not at the same set of trials offered by a club on the same day or on consecutive days.

VETERANS CLASS

At the option of the handler, a dog 7 years of age or older may be entered in the Veterans Class. Once a dog has been designated as a Veteran and entered in this class,

the dog cannot revert/transfer back to the Regular or Selected Classes. The dog will retain titles and/or Qualifying scores towards titles accumulated. Any new titles

earned will be designated with the letter "V" for Veteran following the title (e.g. AGMXV)

All veterans will compete as if running in the Selected Classes at one or two jump heights lower than regular and with the 10% additional time allocated to the Selected

Class.

Height Divisions - owners are responsible for entering the correct height divisions. The judge may require any dog to be measured.

REGULAR CLASSES: Standard & Jumpers withWeaves

8 inches - for dogs 10 inches and under at the withers

12 inches - for dogs over 10 inches up to and including 14 inches at the withers

16 inches - for dogs over 14 inches up to and including 18 inches at the withers

20 inches - for dogs over 18 inches up to and including 22 inches at the withers

24 inches - for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

SELECTED/VETERANS CLASSES: Standard & Jumpers with Weaves

4 inches - for dogs 10 inches and under at the withers

8 inches - for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers

12 inches - for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers

16 inches - for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers

20 inches - for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

GENERAL INFORMATION

Exhibitors Please Note: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing.

1. Dog Show Rule books, Obedience Trial & Agility Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.00 (plus 5% GST) per copy.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule. Should such acknowledgment not be received one week prior to the show, please contact the Show Secretary at: email mcmurphy@telusplanet.net or 780-532-9969
4. Bitches in Season are not permitted to compete. Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch comes into season after their entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, when a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, reaches the Secretary on or before the start of the trial.
5. Only the dogs officially entered in these Agility Trials are permitted within the precincts of the trial.
6. Before each trial the judges will provide a course design which will be posted before judging begins. Courses will be different for all four trials. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or property.
7. Dogs not entered in the show will not be allowed on the show premises unless In-Transit. An In-Transit area will be provided. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of and will comply with the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations.

At the option of the handler, a dog may wear either a well-fitting plain buckle collar, a quick-release collar, or no collar. Fancy collars, choke collars, pinch collars, or other training collars are prohibited. Collars which are too tight or so large that they hang down unreasonable in front of the dog are not permitted. There shall be nothing hanging from the collar (12.3.1) Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other training devices in the ring or within 10 feet of the course (12.1.1)

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee (24-12-3)

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) ***"these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"***

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, <http://www.ckc.ca> under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBERS: All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events do not require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN, simply mail or fax a copy of the dog's registration certificate with a cheque, money order payable to the Canadian Kennel Club or VISA/MasterCard number including expiry date, cardholder's name and signature. **Cost is \$58.50 + 5% GST.** This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for with 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC Event.
