

Mr Oscar Valverde is a Costa Rican citizen and has a licentiate degree in Business Administration and Public Accounting from the University of Costa Rica. He is presently the Deputy Internal Auditor of the Office of the Financial Entities General Superintendent in Costa Rica. He has been involved in canine activities for more than twenty five years and during the last twenty he has been an active member in the Costa Rican Kennel Club. He has held several positions in the Board of Directors of the Club during several periods: President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. He has also been President, Vice-President and Secretary of the Club's Judges Committee. Mr. Valverde is a well known Dachshund breeder in the three coat varieties. Oscar has judged many national as well as international all breeds dog shows. At the international level, he has judged shows in Argentina, Australia, Bolivia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Finland, Israel, Mexico, Greece, Guatemala, Honduras, El Salvador, Nicaragua, Panamá, Paraguay, Perú, Portugal, Puerto Rico, Russia, Spain, Uruguay and Venezuela. He judged several breeds and group finals at the World Dog Shows in Puerto Rico, Mexico City, Brazil and Argentina. Mr Valverde's ample and active participation in the canine matters in Costa Rica, his performance as a judge in many countries and his participation in many canine events at home as well as abroad, have provided him with a vast experience in the canine field which allows him to perform as one of the F.C.I. ONLY and **MUST BE** removed immediately after, **NO EXCEPTIONS**. 2. There will be an area designated for the exercising of dogs. No dogs will be allowed to exercise elsewhere on the grounds. The Auld Lang Syne Dog Association asks that you pick up after your dogs. Offenders may lose show privileges.

3. Using the building facilities is a privilege, please be considerate. Dogs are not allowed in the washrooms.

4. The Welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that you will exercise control and restraint over the children in your care on the days of these shows.

5. The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen property from exhibitors or vendors/concessions.

6. The Club reserves the right to refuse an individual's entries, for just cause
7. Delays waiting for dogs are not possible and handlers with several breeds
MUST arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their dogs' conflict.
8. The Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and
exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of
accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, spectators or vendors. (See 'AGREEMENT' on the back of the entry form)

The Club reserves the right of restricting exhibitors grooming space
 Heritage Park is a NON SMOKING facility, there are no exceptions. If you wish to smoke, please do it outdoors. Fire Lanes must be kept open everywhere. Please be considerate and think defensively.

11. PLASTIC sheeting MUST be under ALL EXPENS

12. Any tape used in the building has to be easily removable and must be removed after the show is completed. COLORED TAPE IS NOT

ALLOWED. You must leave your setup in the same clean condition you found it in when you first arrived at the show.

13. EXTENSION CORDS, if laid across an aisle MUST be taped down properly – think of the safety of others!

IMPORTANT NOTICES TO ALL EXHIBITORS and VENDORS FROM THE MANAGEMENT OF HERITAGE PARK

1) Due to the ongoing problem in the grooming area with exhibitors continuing to pour buckets of wash water into the garbage barrels, mixed with dog fecal matter and urine, makes it very unpleasant for the custodial staff as the bags are leaking and breaking open when being changed. Our resolution to this problem will be to remove the garbage barrels and place a 4 yard dumpster on the south end of the grooming area for the participants to use.

2) To the vendors – cardboard is not to be left on the floor at anytime. There is a large cardboard recycling bin located on the south end of the building between floor 1 and 2. Please ensure you that you place all cardboard in the recycling bin.

3) Parking is still a continuing problem – There is NO PARKING permitted within 6 meters of the buildings, in front of the fuel tank (east side of building), the North and South side of the storage building behind the main building, in front of the fire hydrants, in Handicapped parking (if an approved sign is not displayed) and on the south of floor 1 which is Concession Staff parking only. Effective October 30, 2006 Heritage Park will be working with a local towing company to patrol the lot and will have vehicles removed that are in violation of the no parking areas.

Additional signage has been put in place with the name and contact number of the towing company.

The accumulation of points began January 1, 2013. The dog must compete in the Specials Only class. Twenty points are needed for the title (the forms are available for download from the

CKC website and it is the responsibility of the owner to keep track and when they reach the 20 points, submit the form to CKC who will verify the wins, and if correct will issue a certificate). In the 20 points there needs to be a minimum of 1 Best of Breed and at least 2 - 2 point wins. The scale of points is the same as for regular championships.
