IMPORTANT NOTICE

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011 - NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian Non-Member of CKC. The fee will march the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non member will have a choice of either

- 1) become a CKC member or
- 2) pay the Non-Member participation fee.

Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. This fee applies ONLY to dogs wholly owned by non CKC members and not applicable to CKC members.

<u>ATTENTION U.S. EXHIBITORS</u>: Current exchange rates favour the American dollar. To take advantage of this, please purchase bank drafts or money orders in Canadian dollars. Personal cheques will be accepted - however, they must be payable for the FULL AMOUNT OF THE ENTRY, payable in U.S. funds. Discounted cheques will not be honoured. Do not mark personal cheques payable in Canadian funds or "at par".

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

There will be no refunds on overpayments or duplicate entries. Such payments will be considered as a donation to our Trophy Fund

In case of a mail strike occurring, entries will be accepted in compliance with CKC Rules covering this event

CLASSIFICATION

Open for all dogs

Canadian Bred for all dogs born in Canada

Specials Only dogs which are registered individually, in the records of the Canadian Kennel

Club or have a CKC ERN number and have attained championship status may be entered in the "Specials Only" class. Entry of a dog in "Specials Only" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the CKC, but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be

cancelled. The entry of a 'listed' dog in Specials Only is not allowed.

Exhibition Only for all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian

Kennel Club. Exhibition Only 3 - 6 months available, but exhibitor must have

another dog entered in one of the regular classes.

Please note:

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone <u>but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than 7 days after the official closing.</u> If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

<u>ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS</u>

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.

Canadian Kennel Club schedule of Championship Points:

Section 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded Winners shall be as follows: (Includes the dog awarded Winners)

Dogs Competing

1 dog 2 dog 3 to 5 dogs 6 to 9 dogs 10 to 12 dogs 13 or more dogs 0 1 2 3 4 5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. **Note:** A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 151.12 © has been added that stated the dog must "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level.

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed hereunder

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show.

The following CKC OBEDIENCE classes will be provided:

Novice A	for dogs who do not have a "CD". Must be handled by owner or immediate family member
Novice B	for dogs who do not have a "CD" title in Canada. For trainers, multiple entries, or dogs who have earned titles in another country. May be handled by any person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
Open A	for dogs who have earned the title" CD" in Canada. Must be handled by owner or immediate family member.
Open B	for dogs who have earned the title "CD" in Canada. May be handled by any person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
Utility A	for dogs who have earned the title "CDX", but has not earned the title "UD". Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCh titles may not handle a dog in this class. Dogs must be handled by owner or immediate family member. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
Utility B	for dogs which have earned the title of CDX or UD Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class but the same person must handle the dog in all exercises.
Pre-Novice	for any dog which has not earned the title of PCD. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
Novice C	for dogs that have earned the title CD, CDX, UD or obedience trial championship. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Scores earned in this class are not eligible for High In Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title.
Novice Intermediate	for any dog which has earned the title of CD, CDX, UD or obedience trial championship. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Scores earned in this class are not eligible for High in Trial.

The following CKC RALLY OBEDIENCE classes will be provided

Rally Novice A	Dogs entered in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or member of their immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
Rally Novice B	Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced class has been earned. The owner or any person may handle dogs in this class.
Rally Advanced A	This class is for dogs that have won the RN title but have not won the RA title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate family.

Rally Advanced B This class shall be for dogs that have won the RN title. Upon completing the RA title a dog may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any

person may handle dogs in this class.

Rally Excellent A This class shall be for dogs that have won the RA title, but have not won the RE

title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. A dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class after official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title RE. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A & B at any one trial. The handler

of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their

immediate family.

Rally Excellent B. This class shall be for dogs that have won the RA title. A dog may compete in this

class indefinitely. Any person is allowed to handle a dog in this class.

To be eligible to compete in these trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN or a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked.

General Rules Governing This Show

 The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the of the above show and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules

Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show

The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be
responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors
or patrons

4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.

5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds

Dogs must be on the grounds one hour before the judging of the breeds, and may be removed when not required for further judging

7. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors and Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed

 The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made

9. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by applicable fee plus GST which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action

 Exhibitors and Handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds. The CKOC will assume NO responsibility in this matter.

11. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE TAKING IT TO THE Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only

12. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire and Acts of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause

beyond the control of the Club

13. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee

14. It will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitors to have their dogs at ringside
