It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to familiarize himself with C.K.C. rules and regulations. Rule books are available at nominal cost from the CKC

Dogs no longer can be entered as "listed". Please read the following new CKC rule.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBERS (TCN)

With the implementation of CKC's IT system, a new process requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number* (TCN). TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs" and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called *listing fees*) when entering events using this number.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign born & foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. Dogs may be entered with a TCN; however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 DAYS of the first event will result in the CANCELLATION of any wins, awards or scores. Any points or scores earned prior to January 1, 1992 are not subject to cancellation due to the lack of an ERN number. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred." (See Section 26.7)

CHAPTER 20 CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS SECTION 1.

A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5
*Included the dog awarded Winners.						

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the Dogs in the competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best Breed of Best of Opposite Sex and then consult schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded Winners also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited five points Inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. IN NO CASE MAY A DOG EARN MORE THAN FIVE POINTS AT ANY SINGLE SHOW.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate the dog must A: earn at least 10 Championship points under 3 different judges.

B: be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an ERN number.

C: have earned at least one 2 point win at either the breed or group level.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS DOG SHOW RULES. CHAPTER 13, SECTION 13, of the dog show rules has been amended to allow a dog which has been assigned and "individually C.K.C. OR ERN REGISTRATION NUMBER AT THE TIME OF CLOSING" By the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of a championship, after the date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW, by the Owner or Handler.

CLASSIFICATIONS

In all breeds recognized by C.K.C. the following classes will be provided for, divided by sex.

BABY PUPPY – 4 months and under 6 months

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months and under 9 months

SENIOR PUPPY - 9 months and under 12 months

12-18 MONTHS - dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN - for all dogs

SPECIALS ONLY - for Canadian Champions.

EXHIBITION ONLY - For all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with The Canadian Kennel Club.

NOTE: In breeds where classes are divided by colour, weight, or coat, indicate clearly in the class division (champions of any country excluded) on the entry form.

PRIZE LIST Rosettes are being presented for: BIS, RBIS, BPIS, BBPIS Group 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, BPIG, BBPIG

Junior Handling – Friday June 3rd and Saturday June 4th

Held under CKC Rules. Judge to be announced each day, Friday and Sunday. Junior handlers must compete in their age classification until they are old enough to move up to the next level. Sign up at Show Secretary Table.

Pee Wee 4 – 6 yrs. (non-competitive) Dogs will be examined while on the floor.

Junior 7 – 10 yrs. (Novice and Open)

Intermediate 11 – 14 yrs. (Novice and Open)

Senior 15 – up to but not incl. 18 yrs. (Novice and Open)

Best Overall (excluding Pee Wee)

All dogs must be entered in one of the Official Classes or Exhibition Only on the day of competition. Entry to be made at the show, there is no entry fee charged. Dogs being used in the competition must be of appropriate size and temperament for the Junior Handler.

Prizes and Ribbons

1st -4th ribbons for every class, a rosette presented for Best Overall

Exhibitors Notice
