**No post-dated cheques accepted.** A post-dated cheque is one that is dated after the receipt of the entry. All NSF cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action

and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the trial. Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes-It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules and Regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or copies of sent emails will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.

# Move Up:

The entry of a dog entered in an official obedience or rally obedience trial class in accordance with these rules may be changed to another official class within the same trial. The change must be on the appropriate form and submitted to the Trial Secretary by the owner or handler at least thirty (30) minutes before the start of the trial.

KOC accepts entries for mixed breed dogs that have a CCN (canine companion #) issued by the CKC as well as CKC registered breeds.

#### **NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE**

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is not a member of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (TCN) - \* Effective March 2, 2020 A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be

replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN. TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number. Dogs may still enter CKC events without a registration number or ERN until March 2, 2020 by marking TCN on the entry form (or Listed if it is an older entry form). An email address is required on the entry form in this case. Before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account. \* If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. The CKC will update its records accordingly.

**REFUND POLICY-COVID OR OTHERWISE:** If due to Covid, these trials are not able to be held-refunds will be issued to exhibitors minus 20% to go towards costs incurred by the KOC. Please see DogShow.ca for their service fee policy

# **EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)**

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN number simply do the following: 1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, e.g., AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN number. 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount of \$58.50 (plus GST or HST

where applicable) payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. 3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you. 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA / Mastercard number, expiry date, cardholder's name, and signature. This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores. #### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- \* The KOC will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators. The KOC will not be responsible for any equipment left on the event premises.
- \* The building will be open an hour before judging commences.
- \* Only dogs ENTERED in the Trials will be allowed within the trial precincts.
- \* Judging will not be delayed to accommodate an exhibitor or handler who fails to have their dog in the ring when required.

- \* The superintendent will be in complete charge of these trials.
- \* No dogs will be allowed in the building overnight. Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way will be removed to safety by the appropriate authorities.
- \* "Puppy/Dog for sale" signs will not be permitted within the precincts of the event.
- \* It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Obedience Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- \* It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to clean up after their dogs at all times and in all areas. Please make sure your area inside and outside is clean and all garbage is placed into the appropriate receptacle before you leave.
- \* Please note there will be no prong, spike collars, or non CKC sanctioned collars allowed at this event.
- \* Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their class (allowing for absentees). The club requests that the competitors vacate the trial grounds when class is complete and awards are presented. Competitors can opt to leave as soon as finished if they prefer, however ribbons will not be mailed out.
- \* EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS. RULE BOOKLETS FOR ALL EVENTS ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE C.K.C. IN PRINT AND ONLINE AT CKC.CA
