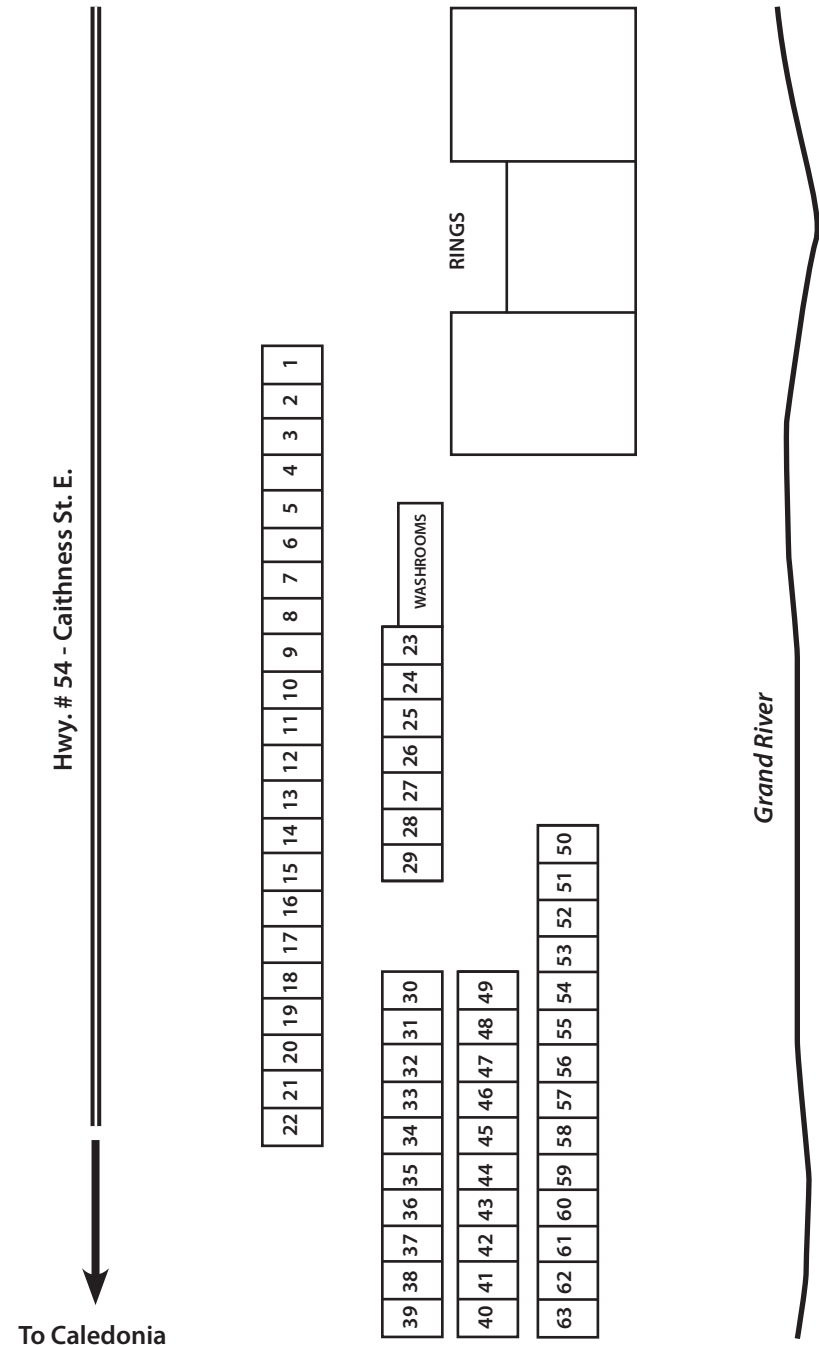

ALL SPECIALTY CONFORMATION CLASSES – BOTH SEXES

OFFICIAL CLASSES (ALL SPECIALTIES)

Baby Puppy – a dog between 3 months and under 6 months on day of show. Baby Puppies do not compete for points.

Junior Puppy – a dog between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.

Senior Puppy – a dog between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.

12 – 15 Months – a dog between 12 months and under 15 months on day of show.

15 – 18 Months – a dog between 15 months and under 18 months on day of show.

Canadian Bred – a dog which is born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

Bred By Exhibitor – dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner *and* breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The breeder/owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

Open Class – for all dogs.

Veterans – for all dogs over seven years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs to compete for the regular placements and the 1st place Dog and Bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only – dogs who are Canadian Champions only.

Award of Merit – At the judge's discretion, Awards of Merit may be awarded up to one Award for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. Rosettes will be given for the Awards of Merit which will be presented following Best of Breed.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Limited to dogs and bitches over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinarian procedure.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Exhibition Only – all dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades.

Brace: Two dogs of same breed (not necessarily of the same sex) and must be handled by one person on one lead. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

Stud Dog & Get: Entry comprises the Stud Dog and two or more of his Get, ownership in this class need not be identical. Stud Dog may be neutered.

Brood Bitch & Progeny: Entry comprises the Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny, ownership in this class need not be identical. Brood Bitch may be spayed.

Each entrant for Brace, Stud Dog, or Brood Bitch must be entered in one of the Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only. All Get and Progeny must be entered in an Official Class.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Parade of Champions, Titleholders or Veterans: Champion dogs must have completed all requirements for Championship status. Titleholders must have titles recognized by the CKC and AKC. Veteran dogs must be over seven years of age as of the date of the show. Spayed & neutered dogs or dogs in unorthodox trim may be entered.

Field Trial Class: Shall be for dogs having Canadian WC or better (WCI, WCX) title, a CKC licensed Field Trial placement in an official class or a Junior Hunter (JH). Dogs must be at least 6 months of age or older and eligible for registration. Each entrant for Field Trial Class must be entered in one of Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only.

Obedience Trial Class: for dogs and bitches who have earned at least a C.D. degree.

Lure Coursing Class: for dogs and bitches that have either completed their CKC, AKC or ASFA lure coursing championship or have attained points for the same. (National Whippet Club of Canada)

Each entrant for these Unofficial Classes must be entered in one of Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only. Dogs entered in Obedience cannot be used as part of these classes.

OUR 2012 JUDGING PANEL

BO BENGTSON, Ojai, California

Bo Bengtson has been involved in show dogs since he was a teenager in Sweden. He moved to the U.S. in 1980. In spite of very limited numbers, his Bohem prefix is responsible for over 120 champions and 30 all-breed or specialty Best-in-Show winners in the U.S., Europe, Australia and Asia, primarily Whippets but earlier also Greyhounds and a few Afghan Hounds.

He is approved by FCI to judge 40 breeds/varieties in 5 groups, as well as All-Breed Best-in-Show; approved by AKC to judge all Sighthounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Basenjis, Dachshunds and Golden Retrievers, and has been approved by the Kennel Club (UK) to award Challenge Certificates for seven breeds in the Hound and Utility groups.

Shows judged include FCI World Show (four times, including Stockholm 2008), Crufts (twice, most recently 2007), Westminster (twice, most recently 2009), as well as other major assignments in Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Finland, England, Scotland, France, Germany, Holland, Italy, Austria, the U.S., Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Mexico, Puerto Rico, Brazil, Japan and China. He has judged Best in Show several times at all-breed shows in Europe, Scandinavia and Latin America.

Assignments include over 50 specialty shows in 15 different countries for Afghan Hounds, Borzois, Irish Wolfhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Whippets, Irish Setters, Golden Retrievers, Basenjis, Pekingese, Lhasa Apsos, Shetland Sheepdogs and Poodles.

Author of several dog books, including the award-winning *Best in Show: The World of Show Dogs and Dog Shows* (BowTie, Inc. 2007) and most recently *The Whippet – An Authoritative Look at the Breed's Past, Present and Future* (Kennel Club Books, 2010).

Publisher and editor of *Sighthound Review* (1984-1997), of which he is currently Editor-at-Large. Past editor of *The Afghan Hound Review* and *Poodle Variety*. Founder and past publisher, in partnership with Paul Lepiane, of the world's leading show dog magazine, *Dogs in Review*, of which he is currently Editor-at-Large.

JOHN BINK, Canberra, Australia

I am licensed to judge the Sporting group, the Hound group, and the Terrier group. I have had the privilege of judging these three groups all over Australia and New Zealand, including Hound Specialties, the Basset Speciality of New South Wales, the Basset Show in Christchurch, New Zealand, and the Basset Hound Club of Southern California in 2011. In America I have had the privilege of judging the Texas Cluster in 2007, and Best in Show on one of the days. In 2009 I judged at the Long Beach KC shows held in conjunction with the Eukanuba World Dog Show.

I have been involved in the dog world since 1978. I had much success with my first breed which was the Irish Setter. I owned Irish Setters for ten years, then decided to go into a different breed, so that's when I ventured into Basset hounds in 1988. I started with CH Chakrata's Oxford Bags, a tri-colour dog who took the dog world by storm. He became a multi best in show winner and was the foundation dog behind my breeding program at Earlingford Bassets, where many top winning bassets have been produced.

To enhance my breeding program I have imported bassets from America and from Sweden. These dogs have also been very successful in the show ring, all being multi best in show winners. I have now achieved over 90 Best in Show wins in both all breed and breed specialty shows.

Over the years I have been involved with many Kennel Clubs. I have been a Councillor on the Board of Dogs ACT, and have been a breed lecturer for Basset Hounds, PBGV's and Irish Setters. I have also been involved in a show training program for beginners to the show ring.

EUGENE BLAKE, Oklahoma, USA

Eugene started working with dogs in 1954 as a dog bather at a French Poodle Shop in Houston, Texas. He attended his first dog show in 1955 and then decided he wanted to show dogs and in 1968 became an All-Breed licensed handler. He showed dogs professionally for some 33 years, then, he retired, and became a judge. During that time, he bred Poodles, Cocker Spaniels, Italian Greyhounds, Maltese, Yorkshire Terriers, Salukis, and Afghan Hounds. He never bred more than four litters of any of one breed. As a handler he helped many of his clients with their breeding programs, including choosing studs, and picking puppies.

Eugene started judging in 1990, with the Hound Group. Since that time he has added the Sporting

Group, Toy Group, and Non-Sporting Group, Best in Show, Junior Showmanship, and Miscellaneous. He has judged in Australia, Canada, Finland, Indonesia, Japan, New Zealand, Sweden, Taiwan, and Thailand. Currently, he judges between 60 and 70 shows a year.

JEREMY BROWNE, Belmont, Ontario

I have owned, bred and shown Alaskan Malamutes under the Byeyo prefix since 1975. During this time I have produced many champions, multiple Best in Show winners, the top Malamute in Canada in 1980 and 1988, Westminster Breed Winner and the two time winner of the Top Twenty event at the US National Specialty.

I am a past president of the Forest City Kennel Club, a life member of the Canadian Kennel Club and the Alaskan Malamute Club of America. I'm also a member of the Australian Cattle Dog Club of Canada.

I have been judging the Working Group for over 10 years, having judged at All Breed shows and Specialty shows in Ontario, the United States and Spain. I am also licensed to judge half of the herding group and on permit for the remaining breeds.

I currently own Australian Cattle Dogs having won the Canadian National Specialty from the classes in 2009 with my first ACD. Last year found me showing my second ACD, a puppy bitch who finished quickly with Puppy Group wins, a Group 4th and an All Breed Sweepstakes. I own sheep and I am currently working towards obtaining herding titles.

I have owned registered Quarter Horses for over 25 years competing in halter and reining. I have owned and trained top Weanling All Ontario, and bred multiple Futurity winners in halter and riding events. I am the past director of the Ontario Reining Horse Association and past vice president of Area 2 Quarter Horse Association.

In my professional life I am self employed, manufacturing horse trailers and motorcycle trailers.

ESPEN ENGH, Vestsideveien 321, 3400 Lier, Norway

Espen was born into a family where greyhounds have been part of everyday life for more than 55 years. Espen was very actively involved in the dogs from a very early age. The first litter carrying the prefix Jet's was bred by Espen and his late mother Kari in 1975. Since then an average of one litter per year has been bred.

Jet's may be the top winning greyhound kennel of all time, having made up 171 individual homebred champions with more than 580 champion titles in 59 different countries, including 73 FCI International champions. Eight Jet greyhounds have become World Champions during the last nine years. Espen is still actively breeding and showing greyhounds.

Espen has imported several whippets from England, Australia, France and South Africa that have won their international champion titles, and has also co-owned champion Afghan Hounds and Brussels Griffons with his life partner Åge Gjetnes. Very interested in the functional aspects of the breeds, Espen has also made up lure coursing champions in Greyhounds and Afghan Hounds.

A second generation all-breeds judge, Espen was first approved to judge at championship show level in 1987 and was approved to judge all breeds in 2011. Still in his forties, he has judged extensively all over the world with appointments in Argentina, Australia, Austria, Azerbaidjan, Belarus, Belgium, Bolivia, Bosnia-Hercegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, China, Colombia, Costa Rica, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Ecuador, England, Estonia, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Gibraltar, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Indonesia, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Macedonia, Malaysia, Malta, Mexico, Moldova, Monaco, Montenegro, Morocco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Northern Ireland, Norway, Panama, Peru, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Puerto Rico, Romania, Russia, San Marino, Scotland, Serbia, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Thailand, Ukraine, Uruguay, USA, Venezuela and Wales.

In 2011 Espen had the great honour of judging all the five major all-breed shows in the world; Westminster Kennel Club in New York, Crufts in the UK, the FCI World Show in Paris, the FCI European Show in Leeuwarden, Holland as well as the FCI Centenary Show in Dortmund, Germany. A veterinarian by education, Espen finished his Doctoral Thesis at the Norwegian College of Veterinary Medicine in Oslo.

As a family we have had Setters since 1973, firstly Irish Setters then we were joined by an Irish Red and White Setter in 1983. I began showing my dogs locally in 1978 but started taking it more seriously with the arrival of the Red and Whites.

Since then this small hobby kennel, Vanders has bred just 9 litters (one in partnership), and owned or bred 13 UK Show Champions accounting for 144 Challenge Certificates to date. There are also several Vanders Champions overseas.

Owned by Kath Griffin, the famous Sh Ch Vanders Veracity, is the current UK breed record holder with 42 CCs, and is to date the only IRWS to be awarded Best in Show at a UK General Championship Show, this from a total entry of over 10,000 dogs. He is still going strong in retirement at nearly 14 years old.

I am currently campaigning 2 IRWS, one of whom was top IRWS bitch in 2011 having been awarded 7 CCs during the year, and a young Irish Setter bitch who has delighted us by gaining her Junior Warrant and picking up 2 Reserve CCs and is still only 20 months old.

I have awarded CCs on 5 occasions to date and I feel honoured to be judging this, my favourite breed, at Crufts 2012.

I am extremely honoured to have been invited to judge in Canada at this prestigious event and I look forward to it with great anticipation.

RAYMOND LA RIVIERE, Ingersoll Ontario

I have been involved in the sport of purebred dogs since 1975. I have belonged to numerous clubs: Sault Ste Marie Kennel Club, Sudbury and District Kennel Club, Airedale Club of Canada, Blue Water Kennel Club. I have held positions of being a regular member to show chair and chief ring steward. am currently a member of the Brantford Kennel Club and President of the Forest City Kennel Club. Since 1975 I have been an owner/handler for the following breeds: Doberman Pinscher, Whippet, Pomeranian, Pembroke Welsh Corgi. I have bred Airedales and currently I am owned by several Norwich Terriers.

In the mid-seventies and throughout the eighties, Mr. Miller showed not only his Salukis, but dogs in several breeds for clients. In 1988, he applied to the American Kennel Club and was approved to judge Salukis. Since then, he is approved for the Hound Group, Non-Sporting Group, German Shorthaired Pointers, Gordon Setters, Norfolk and Norwich Terriers. He has held many offices in the Grand River Kennel Club, currently President, and is the show chairperson for their cluster weekend. Moreover, he is the Vice-President of the Cuyahoga Valley Hound Association.

Mr. Miller has officiated in the United States, Canada, France, Germany, Belgium, Italy, Sweden, Estonia, Hungary, Romania, Russia, Australia and South Korea. He has published in both English and French in professional periodicals as well as dog publications. Moreover, he has given seminars on the Saluki. He travels frequently to North Africa due to his association with sighthounds and conducts tours of Marrakech, Morocco and its surroundings. As an avid traveler, he has visited many kennels in India.

Professionally, Mr. Miller is the department coordinator of World Languages for a school system in the Cleveland, Ohio metropolitan area. I have had the honour to judge many specialty and all breed shows in the United States, South America, South Korea, Japan, Europe and proudly judged the Norfolk and Norwich Terriers in Surrey, England.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge **SHALL NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.8 A Dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show.

Section 15.1.11 A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. Every day of a 2 or 3 day show is a separate show. Please note that this rule is effective up to one hour prior to the opening of the show, NOT one hour prior to the judging of the breed.

CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. **Chapter 4 - Section 4.1.3** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show.
