4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

Baby Puppy	A dog 4 months up to 6 months on the day of the show
Junior Puppy	A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show
Senior Puppy	A dog between 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show
12-15 Month	Dogs 12 months of age and under 15 months of age on the day of the show.
15-18 Month	Dogs 15 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.
Canadian Bred	A dog which was born in Canada
Bred by Exhibitor	A dog owned and handled by the breeder.
Open Class	A dog 6 months of age or older
Specials Only	Dogs who are Canadian Champions
Altered Class	For sexually altered dogs only.
Veterans Class	Dogs seven (7) years of age and over on the day of the show.
Exhibition Only	Dogs 6 months and over not in competition. Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

ENTRY FEES

Payment by cash, cheque, or money order – payable to *South Shore Kennel Club*

\$18.00	Baby Puppy Class, Veteran Class, per Show
\$10.00	Exhibition Only, per dog, per event
\$11.50	CKC Listing Fee, per dog, per event
\$10.00	Catalogues (pre-order or limited availability at Show)

Listing Fees are payable with the entry fee for dogs that do not have their **Individual Registration Number** at closing date. **Full name and address of owner must be filled in and to whom the ID is to be sent.** A Litter Registration is not acceptable.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted. However, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation are appreciated. Thank you.

Entries must be submitted by mail, hand delivered or via the Entry Line. No other entry service is authorized to take entries for these events.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. All entries must be received by the closing date and time, accompanied by the proper fees and submitted on an OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORM. If more forms are required, please photocopy. Include postal code and telephone number. Please type or print clearly.
2. Post-dated cheques will NOT be accepted, and all "NSF" cheques will be subject to a charge of \$25.00. All fees must be paid before the show. The CNASA does not accept credit cards.
3. The CNASA reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC rules.
4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how the error was made or who made it.
5. Any overpayment of fees will be considered a contribution to our trophy fund.
6. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show/Trial Secretary after the closing time and date.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEES ARE IN EFFECT

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "nonmember" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members.

PRIZES: Suitable prizes will be offered for BOB, BOS, BOW, WD, WB, Select Dog, Select Bitch, AOM (1 for every 10 dogs competing for Best of Breed), Best Puppy, Best Baby Puppy, Best Altered, Best Veteran, Best Canadian Bred and Best Bred-by Exhibitor.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The building will be open at 7 a.m. with SSKC All Breed judging commencing at 8 a.m. unless entries warrant an earlier or later starting time. Specialty to start after SSKC Show 2, identified on Judging schedule. **Friday set-up is from 5-8 p.m.**
2. Only dogs entered in the Shows and Trials will be allowed in the building.
3. Dogs will not be allowed in the building overnight.
4. Prong or Spike collars will not be permitted at this venue.
5. **Judging will proceed without any dog that is not present when called by the Ring Steward. Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers should judging times conflict.**
6. BISS judging will begin on completion of class judging. Best In Specialty Show, Best Puppy In Specialty Show.
7. The Superintendent will be in full charge of the Shows and Trials. **To accommodate ALL exhibitors, the CNASA reserves the right to limit set-up space, size, and location of crates. Use of Ex-pens is not permitted. Your co-operation is greatly appreciated.**
8. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular Official Classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.
9. The CNASA will use all due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of, an accident or any misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons and will not be responsible for equipment left on premises.
10. The CNASA greatly appreciates your co-operation in cleaning up after your dogs.
11. Canteen facilities will be available.
12. Section 19.7 Dog Show Rules: It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the rules pertaining to these events. A copy of these Rules is available from the Canadian Kennel Club.
13. Non-Member Participation Fee: These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members. Information: <http://www.ckc.ca>

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing: *	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points allocated:	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded WINNERS also places in the Group.

A dog awarded Winners which also places Best In Show at an All Breed Conformation Show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the Breed and Group level. A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Dogs may still enter CKC events until without a registration number or ERN until March 2, 2020 by marking TCN on the entry form (or Listed if it is an older entry form). An email address is required on the entry form in this case. Before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

* If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. The CKC will update its records accordingly.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs which are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN number, simply do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership: for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed"; however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.
