IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND TEST RULES

ELIGIBILITY: This test is open to all C.K.C recognized breeds and CKC miscellaneous class dogs eighteen months of age or older on the day of the event. Entries in the Brace Draft Dog must have a DD title. The Judges must excuse a dog at any time during a test for lack of physical capacity.

ENTRY LIMIT: There will be an entry limit of 18 (combined individual and Brace) Draft Dog competitors with entries accepted on a first come, first served basis.

The Draft Dog Field Work may be performed using the Group option as stated in Appendix A using the recommended methodology.

- Bitches in Season will be able to compete.
- Re-qualifications are accepted pending “space available”. Re-Qualifications shall be judged as the last team in the section for which they are entered.

No entries accepted before August 22, 2012.

CLOSING DATE: September 28, 2012 at 6:00 p.m. (pacific standard time), or when the limit has been reached even if the official closing date for entries has not arrived. Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date. If the limit is reached prior to the closing date, a list of alternates will be kept to fill any vacancies created due to cancellations before the closing date.

ENTRY FEE: \$60.00 (Canadian) per dog or in the case of a brace, per brace entry (payable to the Newfoundland Dog Club of Canada – B.C. Region) which includes CKC recording fees. Mail entries or deliver entries to the Draft Test Secretary. **PLEASE NOTE: DO NOT** write “Canadian Funds” on US cheques as they are not accepted by Canadian banks. Entry fees must be paid in Canadian funds.

ENTRIES: Entries must be complete, signed and submitted on the official CKC entry form.

Please note: **No faxed entries please**

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY: After the closing date, all entrants will be notified by mail and/or telephone or email of their placement.

EQUIPMENT: Each entrant is to supply their own equipment. The freight load will be supplied by the test committee.

This test may offer group exercises according to the CKC Draft test rules.

FOREIGN BORN/OWNED DOGS: If a dog is not registered individually with the CKC, it may be entered at a test held under these regulations, as a “Listed” dog, provided that it has an event registration number (E.R.N), or obtains this from the CKC within 30 days of the first test entered, otherwise, scores will be cancelled. In order to enter Canada, a dog must have a Rabies certificate. The certificate must be dated at least 30 days prior to re-entry into the U.S.

The Draft Test will be held at CastaNewf Kennels, 26616 Ferguson Avenue, Maple Ridge, B.C. V2W 1R8. Directions will be provided with entry confirmation.
