## OUR JUDGES

#### Sandra Anderson -

**Wendy Anderson -** Wendy has been involved in the sport of purebred dogs since 1992 and has served on the executives of both All Breed and Specialty breed clubs. A breeder of Shih Tzu, she has bred several National BISS winners, multi BIS and BISS winners, the 2010 World Champion and the 2010 Top Shih Tzu in 2 countries as well as the Top Dog All Breeds in South Africa for 2011.

In 2011, Wendy started her judging career and is thoroughly enjoying the opportunity to see many quality dogs world-wide. Besides judging in Canada, she has judged in Mexico and Argentina.

**Marg Moran McQuinn -** Marg got her first purebred Scottish Terrier in 1973 and subsequently bred many BIS and national BISS winners including Canada's top terrier. Two home-breds (owner-handled) still hold the record for #1 and #2 all-time top winners in the breed. Marg has also owned and exhibited Standard Poodles.

**Richard Paquette** - Richard has been involved in purebred dogs since 1971. He began his career in dogs with primarily Shih Tzu, but along the way has owned and bred Samoyeds, Afghans, Salukis, Whippets, Brussels Griffon, Maltese, Pekingese, Lakeland Terriers and Wire Fox Terriers.

Shih Tzu and Lakelands are his main breeds and he has produced over 250 Canadian Champions, 60 American Champions, 16 different Best In Show winners and 10 National Specialty winning dogs.

Richard is now a retired professional dog handler, a profession he enjoyed for 15 years. During this time he finished over 500 champions in 80 different breeds and won over 150 All Breed Best in Shows on 16 different breeds. He also owned and piloted a Lakeland Terrier, "Danny", Am Can Bda Ch Jamelyn's Second Edition to #1 All Breeds in Canada in 1989. He has served on the executives of All Breed and Specialty breed clubs and is currently on the Board of Directors of the

Canadian Kennel Club. Richard has been honored with Life Memberships in the Canadian Kennel Club, the Sudbury & District Kennel Club and the Canadian Shih Tzu Club as well as being awarded an Honourary Membership in the Canadian Professional Handlers Association.

Richard is a CKC Licensed All Breed judge, a founding member of the Canadian Dog Judges Association (CDJA) and a member of the American Dog Judges Association (ADSJA). In addition to Canada and the USA, he has judged in Argentina, Australia, New Zealand, Bermuda, Brazil, Colombia, Chile, Peru, Uruguay, China, Japan, Mexico, Philippines, Taiwan, South Africa, Israel, Spain, Denmark, Italy, Finland, Sweden and Ireland.

**Michelle Scott** – I have been involved with purebred dogs my whole life. I grew up with Irish Setters and had the opportunity to work with Lakeland Terriers, Pointers, Weimaraners, English Springer Spaniels, and Afghans. I have bred or owned Akitas, Maltese, Lakeland Terriers, Silky Terriers, all 3 varieties of Poodles, and Sealyham Terriers. I now breed Standard Poodles under the Brielle prefix.

I was a Professional All-Breed Handler until 1998 when I retired to start judging. I am currently approved by the Canadian Kennel Club to judge All Breeds. I have judged in Canada, the United States, Denmark, Colombia, and Australia.

Vickie Umpleby - My passion for show dogs started as a junior handler in 1969 showing American Cocker spaniels. I started breeding them in 1980 under the "Nonnies" prefix adding English cockers in 1997. I have bred and owner handled 85 champions in these breeds including nationally ranked, Best In Show and Best In Specialty winners. Two of my English cockers are also BIS winners in the USA including two Best of Breed winners at the prestigious American Spaniel club show and a Westminster Best of Breed winner. Bulldogs also share a special place in my heart and my home, having bred and owned several nice champions .

In my personal life I have been married to my husband Dave for 34 years and have 2 grown children. I have been employed as an airline customer service agent for 35 years. In addition to my dogs I also enjoy my horses and birds and am passionate about running and fitness.

**Yvonne Savard -** Yvonne's start into the dog world was walking into the show ring as a Junior Handler with a big male Bouvier des Flandres at the 7 day benched Sportsman Show in Toronto Ontario in 1969. The love for bouviers and dog shows remained with her from that day forward. Breeding bouviers under the prefix "Barbu Perm Reg'd", she has also had the excitement of winning BOW at the American National Bouvier Specialty 5 times and being the owner of the Top Dog all Breeds in Canada in 1984. Yvonne has bred and shown multiple Best in Show winners both in Canada and the US. Although her main focus was Bouviers she has owned and shown Irish Setters, Doberman Pinchers, German Shepherds, and Pekingese. Yvonne handled and trained various breeds in her career with dogs. Yvonne's professional life has always involved animals in some way from Veterinary Medicine to Animal Welfare. Yvonne served on the ABdFC- Health Committee, is an approved Breed Mentor and is a 25+ year member ABdFC as well as President of the Canadian BdFC. She is one of the founding members of the Bouvier des Flandres Club of BC. Currently she is a Territory Manager for a Veterinary Pharmaceutical Company. She is approved to judge Sporting, Working, Terriers, Toys, Herding Groups as well as BIS and is on Permit for Hounds. She has had the great honor of judging both the American National Specialty and the Canadian National Bouvier Specialties. She has had the pleasure of adjudicating in Canada, USA, New Zealand and Australia. She is a member of the CKC, A Breeder of Merit with the AKC and is a member of each the CDJA, ADSJ and DJA. (Dog Judges Associations).

#### CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour BEFORE the start of the show.

#### SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Showing correct information on entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Entry forms must be the same size and format as those included or they will be rejected.

2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries WILL NOT be accepted. Email and Fax entries will be accepted. See instructions elsewhere in this premium list.

3. Post-dated cheques ARE NOT accepted. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered nonpayment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A \$25.00 SERVICE CHARGE WILL BE LEVIED ON ALL N.S.F. CHEQUES AND INVALID OR DECLINED CREDIT CARDS.

4. Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick, lame, excused by the veterinarian or judge, in season or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly.

5. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date may be made by telephone, but MUST BE FOLLOWED UP **IN WRITING** to the Show Secretary so as to be received no more than 7 days after closing.

6. The entry of any dog cannot be altered or canceled after entries close, except as provided in the Dog Show Rules.

7. After the closing of entries, an identification/receipt and judging schedule will be mailed or emailed to each exhibitor or agent. Owners making entries please include agent's address. All online and fax entries will receive a conformation email, this is your receipt for our shows. Please print your email address clearly.

#### 8. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.

9. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dog, exhibitor or patron. The Show Giving Club will not be liable for any loss or injury that may be sustained through the disappearance, loss, theft, and/or death of dogs entered in the show under any circumstances.

10. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

11. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: Chapter 24, Section 6, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules states "Any person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and the obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out."

12. ACCORDING TO CITY BYLAW, DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OFF LEAD WITHIN CITY LIMITS. Exercise dogs only in designated areas. Anyone not following stop and scoop policy will be excused from the shows and trials.

#### Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.
