

<u>NOTE</u>: There will be a \$25.00 service charge for all NSF cheques and credit card declines. Tendering of an NSF cheque or declined credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the CKC.

Attention US Exhibitors: Current exchange rate favors the American dollar. To take full advantage of this, please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Personal cheques will be accepted, however they must be payable in US funds, and for the full amount of the entry. Please do no mark personal cheques payable in Canadian fund, or "at par" as such items are not readily cleared through the bank. Your co-operation is appreciated.

## **CLASSIFICATIONS**

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show
SENIOR PUPPY	dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show
12-18 MONTHS	dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show
CANADIAN BRED	dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle
	the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	for all dogs
VETERANS CLASS	for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular
	placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they
	do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed or neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number, ERN or MSC Number
	must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.

#### NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

In order for a dog to be entered in any Non-Regular or Unofficial class, dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

EXHIBITION ONLY	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud Dog and Get may be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.
BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Same stipulations as for Stud Dog and Get apply to this classification.

#### MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of closing of entries for show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the order/handler at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show.

When one or more all-breed championship shows and/or specialty shows are held on the same date in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

#### ATTENTION - ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$55.85 plus 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. ### CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

a)An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b)In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. c)"these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by <u>Canadian resident non-CKC members</u> and are not applicable to CKC members"

## JUNIOR HANDLING COMPETITION

Friday, November 16 – after PCA Best in Specialty

Held under CKC Rules.

<u>Classes Offered</u>: Pee Wee (non-competitive) / Junior Novice / Intermediate Novice / Senior Novice /

Junior Open / Intermediate Open / Senior Open.

Age Structure: Pee Wee (4-6 years), Junior (7-11 years), Senior (12-18 years).

<u>Entries:</u> \$2.00 payable at registration. Entries will be taken Saturday, 10:00 - 11:00 a.m. Dogs handled in the competition must be entered in the show/trial on that day. The Poodle Club of Alberta will offer a prize for Best Overall Junior Handler.

<u>Junior Handling</u> - Pre registration is preferred (online through Merchandise) - but entries will be accepted up to 4 p.m. on Friday, November 16<sup>th</sup> at Show Secretary's table.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy + 5% GST.
- 2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules
- 3. Entries will be acknowledged BY EMAIL after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- 4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" CKC rule book, Section 19.7.
- 5. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- 6. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. You are responsible for cleaning up if you permit your dog to relieve itself outside the show building. Failure to do so may result in being expelled from the building for one day's showing by the Superintendent.
- 7. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
- 8. SHOW PRECINCTS shall be the entire North & South Pavilions, Exhibition Park.
- 9. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.
