Age Structure: Pee Wee (4-6 years), Junior (7-11 years), Senior (12-18 years).

Entry Fee: \$2.00 payable at registration. Entries will be taken Saturday, 10:00 - 11:00 AM. Dogs handled in the competition must be entered in the show/trial on that day. The dog need not be owned by the Junior Handler. The MHCA will be offering suitable prizes for all participating in Junior Handling.

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following **CKC CONFORMATION** classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Junior Puppy	for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age
Senior Puppy	for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age
12-18 Months	for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age
Canadian Bred	for dogs born in Canada; <u>champions in any country excluded</u>
Bred By Exhibitor	for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
Open	for all dogs.
Specials Only	for any dog who is a Canadian Champion. A CKC Registration, ERN or MSC number must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing. The entry of a "listed" dog in Specials Only is not allowed.
Exhibition Only	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
Exhibition Only	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in <u>Exhibition Only 3-6 Months</u> provided the Owner has also entered an eligible dog



ENTRY FORMS NOT THE SAME SIZE & IN THE SAME FORMAT AS THE OFFICIAL ENTRY FORM ENCLOSED, WILL BE REJECTED. PLEASE USE THE OFFICIAL ENTRY FORM ENCLOSED.

NOTE: There will be a \$25.00 service charge for all NSF cheques and credit card declines. Tendering of an NSF cheque or declined credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the CKC. The Show Secretary will not accept any entry from an exhibitor known to have tendered dishonored cheques or declined credit cards. Post-dated cheques for after the closing date are not acceptable and will be returned. Telephone entries (excluding electronic entries) are prohibited.

Attention US Exhibitors: Current exchange rate favors the American dollar. To take full advantage of this, please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Personal cheques will be accepted, however they must be payable in US funds, and for the full amount of the entry. Please do not mark personal cheques payable in Canadian fund, or "at par" as such items are not readily cleared through the bank. Your co-operation is appreciated.

***ATTENTION - ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS – EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER**

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$59.40 plus 5% GST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC website: <http://www.ckc.ca>

MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of closing of entries for show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the order/handler at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show. When one or more all-breed championship shows and/or specialty shows are held on the same date in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee - (24-12-3)

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) *"these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"*

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, <http://www.ckc.ca> under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

CHAPTER 4.1.3 – JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

CHAPTER 8 – ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEES

Section 8.3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

- a) It is not a Miscellaneous breed
- b) If born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration
- c) If foreign born and owned, an Even Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

A listing fee of \$8.95 must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

Section 8.2:

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being cancelled.

Section 8.6.2:

DISHONoured CHEQUE

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitor who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order, cash or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 14 – DISQUALIFICATION

Section 14.1.4:

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 14, Section 3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations

CHAPTER 5 – SHOW OFFICIALS

Section 5.1.5:

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship Show shall be credited with a number of Championship points (Ranging from 0 - 5) and the number of championship points to credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

*Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated"	0	1	2	3	4	5

* includes the dog awarded WINNERS

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **NOT** (effective 2012) be included in the calculation of points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED a the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded Best Of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same class competition shall be included in the total. The number of Championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 20.2. In addition to Championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

1. The Medicine Hat Canine Association will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be held responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
2. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
3. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and equipment left at the show grounds.
4. Dogs must be on the grounds 1 hour prior to the judging of their breed.
5. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules.
6. The Club reserves the right to remove any person/dog from the show.
7. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not compete in any class for any awards for the balance of the Show.
8. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
9. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. You are responsible for cleaning up if you permit your dog to relieve itself.
10. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.

Additional Show Information

11. Group judging will follow breed judging through to BIS whenever possible. No two groups will be judged simultaneously. Should a conflict arise, the Show Secretary shall determine which Group will be judged first.
12. Dogs are to be exercised in designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the rings.
13. **Exhibitors MUST pick up after their dogs. Any exhibitor not picking up after their dog shall be excused from the show by the Show Superintendent.**
14. **All recreational units will have buckets underneath for their sink drains.** Anyone found discharging water on the grounds will be removed by order of the Health Department and may be subject to a fine.
