COURIER ENTRIES: Entries sent by Courier must be sent prepaid, no signature required. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing date and time will NOT be accepted. Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.

FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will NOT be accepted. Post-dated cheques will NOT be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please DO NOT mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

NOTE: No entry will be accepted without entry fees. Tendering of an NSF cheque shall be considered **NON-PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES** and is an offense punishable by action and cancellations of awards by the **CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB**. To comply with CKC, no entries will be accepted, altered, cancelled, or substituted after the official closing date and time for entries (except as provided for in Chapter 13, Section 13.4 of the Conformation Show Rules). Telephone entries cannot be accepted except in the event of a postal strike. Please contact the Red Deer and District Kennel Club in that event. There will be a \$50 service charge for all NSF cheques.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (TCN): All recognized breeds that are not individually registered with the Canadian Kennel Club but are eligible for registration **MUST** obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) **before** entering an event. Event Secretaries will not accept an entry for a dog that does not have a registration number, ERN or TCN. Once the dog is permanently registered or has obtained an Event Registration Number (ERN), the TCN will no longer be valid. While there is no fee for the Temporary Competition Number (TCN), exhibitors will be required to pay Temporary Competition Fees (formerly “listing” fees) of \$10.50 plus GST when entering events. Exhibitors can apply for a TCN two ways:

1. Go online to their CKC Portal (under “Applications”, then “Dog Registration” and select “Obtain a Dog Number for the Sole Purposes of Competing in CKC Events). Follow the instructions online. The TCN will be issued immediately online after the application is submitted (displayed under the “My Dogs” tab, then “List of My Dogs, TCN Dogs”).
2. Complete a printed application (available [HERE](#)) and submit it to the CKC by mail or by contacting the CKC Shows & Trials Division by telephone. The CKC form is available [HERE](#).

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN): All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN (application available [HERE](#)). An ERN **MUST** be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30-day extension to the CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC at: (416) 675-5511 or Fax (416) 675-6506. Current fee: \$64 plus GST (PEN/ERN/CCN).

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE: A Canadian Kennel Club *Non-Member Participation Fee* applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee of \$170.00 plus applicable taxes. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the CKC website, www.ckc.ca under “Events” and then “Event Forms” on the drop-down menu. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that the CKC is aware of the dogs involved. Contact the CKC directly if you have any questions or concerns.

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES: Should you wish to withdraw your entry between the time that you enter and the close of entries on September 20, 2023 you will receive a full refund of entry fees (including CKC recording fees + 5% GST). However, any payment made on dogshow.ca (Credit Card, Apple Pay, Interac or e-transfer), service charges **WILL NOT** be refunded as per dogshow.ca policy.

If the Red Deer and District Kennel Club and the Chow Chow Club of Canada, Inc. is required to **CANCEL** the show due to any Alberta Government, City of Red Deer, Westerner Park or Canadian Kennel Club guidelines, policies, or directives, a partial refund of entry fees (less our unrecoverable costs) will be offered. All DogShow.ca service fees are not refundable.

SPECIALTY CLASSES TO BE OFFERED

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

REGULAR CLASSES

<u>CLASS</u>	<u>ELIGIBILITY</u>
JUNIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on the day of the show
SENIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on the day of the show
12-18 MONTHS	Dogs between 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show
CANADIAN BRED	Dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class. The breeder does not need to handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	For all dogs - to be divided by color and coat type: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rough Red • Rough Black • Rough AOC (any other accepted color) • Smooth
VETERANS CLASS	For all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of each class in each sex will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed or neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	Dogs that have a Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) Registration Number or Event Registration Number (ERN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and have attained the required points for championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC championship. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

All dogs must be entered in the Regular classes noted above, or for Exhibition Only, in order to compete in the following non-regular classes.

<u>CLASS</u>	<u>ELIGIBILITY</u>
BABY PUPPY	Dogs between 4 months and under 6 months on the day of the show. These puppies are not eligible to compete for championship points. Puppies in this category may compete in Sweepstakes if a 4-6 month class is offered.
ALTERED	Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female. Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.
BRACE	Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair. Dogs may be spayed/neutered.
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his get. The stud dog may be neutered and must be entered in a regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a regular class.
BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. This class shall have the same requirements as the Stud Dog and Get class.
EXHIBITION ONLY	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular or Unofficial classes if provided for in this premium list.
EXHIBITION ONLY (4-6 MONTHS)	Puppies 4 to 6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 4-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Class. These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades - but they may compete in Sweepstakes if a 4-6 month class is offered.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

The following Unofficial Classes will be offered and will not be divided by sex. All dogs must be entered in the Regular official classes, or for Exhibition Only, in order to compete in the following Unofficial classes. Baby Puppies (4-6 months) may not enter these Unofficial Classes.

<u>CLASS</u>	<u>ELIGIBILITY</u>
BREEDERS CLASS	Three to five dogs bred by the same person, not necessarily owned by that person. The dogs are presented as one team and judged as one team. The name of the breeder(s) must be identical on each and every dog entered in this class. Dog ownership, gender and colour need not be identical. The breeder must handle one (or more) of the dogs throughout judging of the class. Each breeder's dogs will be presented to the judge as one unit, with the breeder (and any additional handlers) working as a team to gait the dogs simultaneously in the ring. Dogs will not be individually gaited. Ramp examination will be at the judge's discretion. No neutered dogs or spayed bitch may compete in the Breeders class. The class entries will be placed first to fourth based on overall excellence and quality.
HEAD CLASS	Judging is ONLY on Head. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.
GAIT CLASS	Judging is ONLY on Gait. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

SWEEPSTAKES

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

All dogs in the Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Official Class or, in the case of Baby Puppies, in the Baby Puppy class or in Baby Puppies 4-6 Months (Exhibition Only) at this Specialty. The following classes will be offered (divided by sex):

6-9 months

9-12 months

12-18 months

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

All dogs must be entered in a Regular Official Class or for Exhibition Only. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete in Veterans' Sweepstakes. The following classes will be offered (divided by sex):

7-9 years

9-12 years

12 years & older

The winners of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in both Sweepstakes. 25% of the entry fees shall be retained by the club for expenses, with the remaining entry money divided as follows:

First in each class - 50% of entry fee for that class

Best in Juvenile Sweepstakes - Rosette and 15% of total juvenile sweepstakes entry fees

Best of Opposite Sex in Juvenile Sweepstakes - Rosette and 10% of total juvenile sweepstakes entry fees

EXTRACTS FROM CKC CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

15 CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS & CANCELLATIONS

15.1 Championship Points

15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided here under.

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

*Dogs Competing	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 & More
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.3 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total.

15.1.4 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing in Specials Only shall be included in the total.

15.1.5 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification:

Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Dog shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

13 or more	5	4	3	2
10 to 12	4	3	2	1
6 to 9	3	2	1	1
5	2	1	1	1
4	2	1	1	0
3	2	1	0	0
2	1	0	0	0
1	0	0	0	0

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges;
- (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN);

(c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words “earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges” to mean:

- (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level;

(b) each of the three (3) judge’s awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing;

(c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

15.2 **Grand Champion (GCh) Point Schedule**

15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(a) Grand Champion Point System

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

(b) The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at Group level for all levels of GCh:

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

(d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.4 **Grand Champion Bronze (GChB)**

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

(a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.

(b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

15.2.5 **Grand Champion Silver (GChS)**

The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

(a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.

(b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold (GChG)

The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

- (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx)

15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed)
- (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins.
- (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

- NOTE:
1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above.
 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until December 31, 2022.

15.4 Cancellations

15.4.1 Any contravention of CKC rules may cause a win to be cancelled except as stated within these rules.

15.4.2 If the award of Winners Dog or Bitch is cancelled, the points at that level will be awarded to the Reserve Winners Dog or Bitch. No further points or awards acquired by the dog whose wins were cancelled will be awarded.

15.4.3 Where a violation of the Conformation Rules & Regulations has taken place in the opinion of the Discipline Committee, it shall have the authority to declare cancelled all awards earned by the dog at the show in which such violation occurred.

15.4.4 Where a protest is sustained by the show-giving club and/or the Discipline Committee as provided in these rules, the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to order cancelled all wins earned by the dogs concerned.

15.4.5 If the win of a dog is cancelled, the exhibitor or handler of the dog must return all ribbons, money or special prizes that have been received for its win to the secretary of the show-giving club within 21 days of the receipt of notice from the CKC of said cancellation. The show-giving club shall, in each instance of failure to comply with this rule, notify the CKC and the CKC may take such action as it deems advisable.

AMENDMENT TO THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS **EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY- JANUARY 1, 2023**

- A dog awarded Winners that also placed Reserve Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with four (4) championship points in addition to any points earned at the breed and group level, to the maximum allowed championship points in a single show.
- At a single breed National Specialty, the male designated Reserve Winners Dog will be awarded three (3) championship points, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes is sufficient for the Winners Dog to have received 5 points.
- At a single breed National Specialty, the female designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded three (3) Championship points, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes is sufficient for the Winners Bitch to have received 5 points.”

OTHER EXTRACTS FROM CKC CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

SHOW OFFICIALS - SECTION 5.1.6

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

JUDGES - SECTION 4.1

4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.

ENTRIES, GENERAL - SECTION 8.1

8.1.1 A dog may not be entered or exhibited at a show held under these rules if it has any communicable disease. Dogs entered in a show must have current immunization status.

8.1.2 No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of a show held under these rules if it:

- (a) is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- (b) has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days;
- (c) has been housed within 30 days prior to the show on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

8.1.3 Where it is found that these rules have been contravened, the dog in question shall be removed from the show premises and the exhibitor will be subject to disciplinary action.

ENTRIES, ENTRY FORMS - SECTION 8.2

8.2.2 A show-giving club must reject an incomplete entry form and return it immediately to the sender.

8.2.3 Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

8.2.5 An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3/8.4

8.3.1 Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- (a) registered with the CKC;
- (b) have an Event Registration Number (ERN);
- (c) have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), and must be eligible for registration with the CKC;

8.4.1 If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:

- (a) that if born in Canada, the dog has a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), and it is eligible for individual registration;
- (b) that if not born in Canada, the dog has a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), and it is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC;
- (c) that if it is foreign-born, the dog has a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). An Event Registration Number (ERN) or CKC registration number must be obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES - SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS - SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

INDIGNITIES - SECTION 19.7

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Conformation Show Rules & Regulations book is available for order from the Canadian Kennel Club and is available online [HERE](#).

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs, exhibitors and spectators, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune.
4. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
5. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** Dogs should be in the building at least one hour prior to ring time. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be aware of the posted schedule and be at ringside at the time of judging. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are **MOUNTAIN DAYLIGHT TIME**. Please remain at ringside until judging is completed.
6. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
7. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 14, Section 3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations.
8. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
9. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog **BEFORE** taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs must be exercised in the areas provided. Anyone exercising their dogs on the grounds outside the building and not cleaning up after them, will be excluded from the show or trial.
10. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
11. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
12. Exhibitors are reminded to respect hospitality facilities. The Red Deer & District Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse future entries from any exhibitor who creates excessive destructive or disruption to host facilities (Hotel, motel or campground).
