Eligible Entries

Open to any Afghan, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Greyhound, Ibizan, Italian Greyhound, Pharaoh Hound, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, Whippet, Irish Wolfhound or CKC Miscellaneous Sighthound that is one year or older the day of the trial. All entrants must be registered or eligible for registration, with the Canadian Kennel Club, have ERN # or PEN #. Hounds presently disqualified under CKC, ASFA, CSFA OR AKC rules cannot compete. Hounds with breed standard disqualifications or altered/neutered are eligible to enter the lure field trial. Hounds must pre-qualify prior to entering their first trial in Canada. See information elsewhere in this Premium List.

Stakes Offered

Open Stakes For all hounds including Field Champions.

Mixed Stake Combines breeds with entries of three or less with agreement of all owners.

Best in Field For all Best of Breed winners & 1st from Mixed Stake.

Non-competitive Singles See description below

Puppy Sweeps Puppies between 6 & 18 months on date of trial. Run individually Saturday only \$5 payable at the field. Limit 7.

Veteran Sweeps Dogs 7 years & older on date of trial. Run individually Saturday only \$5 payable at the field. Limit 7.

Breeder Stake Open to any 2 hounds in the official classes bred by the same person(s). Saturday only.

Kennel Stake Open to any 2 hounds in the official classes owned & kennelled by the same person(s). Sunday only.

*NOTE: Breeder & kennel stakes combinations must be declared prior to Roll Call.

Placements and Awards

Chapter 7, Section 1: Championship points are awarded in regular stakes only on the following basis:

1st: 4 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 40 points 2nd: 3 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 30 points 3rd: 2 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 20 points 4th: 1 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 10 points

NBQ: No points

No hound shall receive a placement or points if it does not score at least 50% of the total possible combined scores. If a hound has been excused in the preliminary run, that hound shall not count as having been in competition. Exhibitors please note: As per rule 9.6.1(b) of the CKC Lure Field Trial Rules and Regulations a dog must "Attain 1 first or 2 second placements by defeating dogs in head to head competition". No placements will be awarded towards CKC championships if all dogs in a breed run as singles, but the points will stand.

NON-COMPETITIVE SINGLES COMPETITION Limited to 8 dogs


Rolling Roll Call from when you arrive until 9:30 AM. Your dog is DQ'd or not ready for running in competition, but you would like your dog judged? This is the place to be! Dogs will be run individually and scored by both judges. Hounds will run after the open stake has



completed its preliminary round and then again after the open stake has completed its final round. Your dog will be only given ONE opportunity to chase the lure each time it comes to the line. Handlers will not be able to run/walk the course with their hounds. A random draw will determine the order of running of dogs in this stake. Dogs must wear a blanket. No points are awarded and all ties are settled by a coin toss. A trophy and ribbon will be awarded to 1st place and ribbons for 2nd to NBQ.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR FIELD TRIAL

- Overnight parking permitted on field. Please park in the designated areas. Port-a-potty on site.
- Stakes will be split if the entry is 20 or more hounds at roll call.
- Hounds will be run twice, in braces or trios (except single dog entries) unless excused, dismissed, or declared ineligible.
- Lame hounds or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to
 or during roll call.
- Hounds not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds. No Exceptions.
- All handlers must use a slip lead when releasing a hound. A Standing Start will be used on Tally-Ho.
- Leg wrappings must be of a neutral colour to comply with CKC rules. Muzzles & catch collars may be used at the handler's discretion. No Flexi-leads or shock collars allowed.
- A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after Best in Field.
- Bruce's Bistro will open for your eating pleasure.
- Bring your own water and shade.
- No catalogue will be published. Score sheets will be available.

You may enter any sighthound you own or have owned. Entry is \$2/dog. Sign up at Roll Call to 10 am. Breeds are not split into multiple stakes.

Two judges start with scores of 70. At signup two cards are drawn from a standard deck. These are your preliminary scores. Ace to ten are face value, Jacks-11, Queens-12, Kings-13 and a Joker is an excusal. For Example, drawing a 7 and King would equate to a 77 and an 83. During lunch break the second group of cards is drawn for the finals.

All scores are tallied to determine BoB winners. Any ties are determined by a "draw off". BoB winners will then draw for Best in Field

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

<u>Please note</u>: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list.

This may be done by telephone <u>but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.</u>

An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

To participate in the show a hound must have achieved a qualifying score in the Open or Mixed Stakes in the proceeding field trial without having been excused, dismissed, or declared ineligible. <u>You must PRE-ENTER both events prior to August 21, 2024.</u>

Veterans may be spayed or neutered.

Please complete both a show entry and a trial entry as they are separate events.

Exhibitors Please Note: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to any indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Show precincts shall be within 50 feet of the designated show ring

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these dog show rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0-5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder:

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more Points Awarded 0 1 2 3 4 5

*includes dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the number of championship points by a dog awarded WINNERS, total of all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex, and then consult the schedule set forth above. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at a breed or group level.

15.2 Grand Champion (GCh) (47-06-12)

Section 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

Section 15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after

the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

Section 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog

must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(a) Grand Champion Point System

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

(b) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) (48-06-12)

Section 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC grand championship title.

Section 15.3.2 Points for this title may be accumulated at any time after the completion of the CKC grand championship but does not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship or the grand championship.

Section 15.3.3 A minimum of 100 points, which must include one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) plus three (3) Group 1st or three (3) breed specialty wins.

Second in Group or Best of Opposite Single-Breed Specialty Show	4

Fourth in Group (Note: No points are acquired if no other dog is present in the group.)	2
Best of Breed (To earn the breed point, at least five (5) dogs must be shown at breed level.)	1
Best in Show or Best in National Specialty Show	10

Section 15.3.4 Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. For example, a dog that wins first in group and then wins Best in Show, earns 10 points, not 15.

Section 15.3.5 The title of Grand Champion Excellent shall not be awarded retroactively. However, dogs that have been awarded the Grand Champion title prior to January 1, 2013, will be awarded the Grand Champion Excellent title on application to the CKC.

Section 15.3.6 Additional Requirements

To attain a Grand Champion Excellent title, a dog must have been awarded a CKC performance title from any CKC event. A CGN, Herding Tested certificate or Chase Ability Program title are not considered performance titles for the awarding of this title.

- Grand Champion Bronze: Awarded after an additional 50 points are earned after completing a Grand Championship and other qualifiers.
- **Grand Champion Silver:** Awarded after an additional 100 points are earned after completing a Grand Championship Bronze and other qualifiers.
- Grand Champion Gold: Awarded after an additional 200 points are earned after completing a Grand Championship Silver and other qualifiers.

Competitors can begin to earn points for these new titles after July 1st, 2021.

Have you already earned additional Grand Champion Points? Those can be used towards your Grand Champion Bronze title; however, you must earn a minimum of 5 points towards this title after July 1st, 2021.

- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS (applies to both events)

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$62.40 + 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- Please check the Canada Border Services website for current travel requirements to enter Canada.
- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog, unless under the age of three months.
