- ONLY APPROVED CKC collars will be allowed in the precincts of the Trials.
- ♦ SHOWING correct information on the entry form is the responsibility of the entrant. However, Exhibitors incorrectly entered in the "A" class are permitted to move the dog to the corresponding "B" class up to one hour before the start of the trial. The SKOC takes no responsibility for omissions or errors made on the entry forms. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to the CKC rules.
- ♦ BITCHES IN SEASON: Obedience entry fees WILL be gladly refunded to exhibitors whose females are in season during the trials (and must be withdrawn) IF: a dated veterinarian's certificate is produced prior to the trial.
- ◆ THE PRECINCTS of these trials shall be the Manhattan building & grounds. No dog will be allowed in the building unless entered in the Trials or Exhibition Only.

The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

NEW **** CANINE COMPANION NUMBER (CCN) Mixed breeds are now welcome to participate in CKC Licensed Performance Events.

A CCN allows mixed breeds and unrecognized breed dogs to participate in the CKC Performance Events: Agility, Obedience & Rally O. To enter any Trial, the dog MUST have a CC Number.
