The following classes (divided by sex) will be provided in this Specialty:

**Regular Conformation Classes:** Junior Puppy, Senior Puppy, 12-18 Months, Canadian Bred, Bred by Exhibitor, Open, Specials Only, Veterans (all dogs 7 years old or older on the day of the show) first place male and female compete for Best of Breed, no Winners points (can be neutered/spayed), Exhibition Only.

### Unofficial Classes:

**Sire & Get** - Any sire and 2 or more of his offspring.

*Please attach list of Get/Progeny to the Sire's entry form or Dam's entry form.*

**Dam & Progeny** - Any dam and 2 or more of her offspring.

**Conformation Brace** - Any 2 dogs of either sex. Please attach the info for the second dog to the first dog's entry form.

\*Note: For all unofficial Class entrants, each dog must be entered in either a Regular class or as Exhibition Only.

**SPECIALTY SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES & PRIZES:** (M/F) Jr. Puppy, Sr. Puppy, 12-18 Mos. Prizes: Best in Sweeps (40% of entry fees), Best of Opposite (35% of entry fees), First in each class (Prize). 25% will be retained to cover administrative costs.

## **BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES**

**12.2.1 Regular Official Classes:** All of these classes must be divided by sex. Note: no dogs under the age of six months on the first day of the show shall be allowed within the Show precincts as defined in the Premium List. Every dog within these must be entered in one of the Regular Official Classes or in Exhibition Only.

**JUNIOR PUPPY:** shall be for dogs at least six months of age on the first day of the Show and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

**SENIOR PUPPY:** shall be for dogs nine months of age and under twelve months of age on the day of the show.

**12 - 18 MONTH:** for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months.

**CANADIAN BRED:** shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded.

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR:** shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/ breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

**OPEN CLASS:** for all dogs.

**VETERANS:** for dogs 7 years of age and over. Can be spayed or neutered.

**SPECIALS ONLY:** is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status including at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

### ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted.

Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks.

To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds.

Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

#### \*\*\*NEW TRACKING FEE FOR NON-MEMBERS\*\*\*

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC will be instituting a tracking fee for all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event, but are not CKC members. In order to cover the clerical costs of recording and tracking points and awards earned at a CKC event, a participating non-member can choose to purchase a CKC membership or pay a dog-specific tracking fee (\$55.00). This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it's important that non-members select one of the two options within 30 days of notification or, unfortunately, we will be forced to cancel any awards and titles.
